**Last Game:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Cody Poteet pitched a season-long seven innings, and right fielder John Norwood hit a go-ahead home run leading off the seventh inning in a 2-1 win over the Pensacola Blue Wahoos before Saturday Night Fireworks in front of 7,894 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. In the second game of his rehab assignment with Jacksonville (10-12), Miami Marlins shortstop JT Riddle – a 2016 Southern League Postseason All-Star – played the entire game at shortstop and went 1-for-4 with a sixth-inning single. Poteet (2-1) won his second straight start by outdueling Blue Wahoos right-hander Vladimir Gutierrez (0-4). Poteet only allowed a second-inning, two-out solo home run by right fielder Aristides Aquino to the Budweiser Tiki Terrace. Following the home run, Poteet allowed two walks and a single the rest of his outing, retiring 14 of the final 15 batters he faced. Gutierrez set down the first six batters of the game before third baseman Brian Schales led off the bottom of the third inning with a solo home run to the bleachers in right-center field. Gutierrez worked around leadoff doubles in the fourth and fifth innings by center fielder Monte Harrison and Norwood, respectively. With a 1-1 tie entering the bottom of the seventh inning, Norwood drove a 2-2 offering from Gutierrez down the right-field line for his third home run this season and first at home. Since the start of the 2017 season, Norwood has hit 22 home runs in the Southern League, including 13 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Following Poteet, Jacksonville right-hander Zech Lemond pitched a perfect eighth inning with two strikeouts in his Southern League debut. Left-hander Jose Quijada pitched a perfect ninth inning for his first save of the season, securing Jacksonville's second win in the first three games against Pensacola (10-13). All three games have been decided by one run in the first series between the clubs since their meeting in the 2017 Southern League South Division Championship Series.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Hernandez Joins Shrimp on MLB Rehab Assignment:** Today Miami Marlins right-handed pitcher Eliaser Hernandez makes his first start for the Jumbo Shrimp, as he joins Jacksonville on a transfer of a major league rehab assignment from the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. Hernandez is on Miami's disabled list after dental surgery this spring. Hernandez made two rehab starts for Jupiter, going 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA, with starts on April 6 and April 24. Hernandez was acquired by the Marlins from the Houston Astros in the Major League phase of the 2017 Rule 5 draft on December 14, 2017. Today marks the first time that Hernandez has pitched as high as the Double-A level in his career.

**Dean Southern League Hitter of the Week:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp outfielder Austin Dean has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for April 16-22, announced by the league office on Monday morning. Over that past week in seven games, Dean hit .520 (13-for-25) with two home runs, six runs batted in, three doubles, and six runs scored. Dean in 22 games is hitting .420 (34-for-81), which is the fourth-best batting average in all of Minor League Baseball entering Sunday's games, and the best batting average in the Southern League and second-best in Double-A. He also is second in MiLB lead behind Triple-A Albuquerque's Daniel Castro with 34 hits, Castro has 36. In 22 games played, Dean has hits in 18 of them (one game no official at-bat), with 11 of those games being multi-hit games.

**Norwood Gets On Base:** Last night's home run hero John Norwood went 2-for-3 at the plate, and continued what is now the longest active consecutive game on-base streak in the Southern League. Norwood dating back to April 9 has reached base safely in his last 17 games entering Sunday's games, hitting .338 in that stretch with three home runs and seven runs batted in, and his on-base percentage in that time is .356. In 21 total games, Norwood has been on base in 20 of them, with the lone exception being his game on Sunday April 8 at Jackson when he went 0-for-4 at the plate. Norwood carries a five-game hitting streak into today's game, and he is 9-for-20 during that stretch that began on April 24.

**Florida's AA Baseball Rivalry Resumes:** This is the first of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and their in-state rivals, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. The Shrimp will also host the Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds from May 29 to June 2. The Jumbo Shrimp will make two trips to Pensacola in the second half, facing the Blue Wahoos from July 18-22, and August 14-18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Last year the Jumbo Shrimp went 7-13 against the Wahoos, yet split the 10 meetings 5-5 at the Baseball Grounds. Pensacola won the first half South Division title, while Jacksonville took the second half South Division crown, and the clubs met in the Southern League playoffs, with all games played in Pensacola due to Hurricane Irma. The Wahoos swept the South Division Championship Series 3-0 to earn a share of the Southern League championship with Chattanooga. All three games have been decided by one run in the first series between the clubs since their meeting in the 2017 Southern League South Division Championship Series.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the Opening Day roster, the Jumbo Shrimp had five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (2), Isan Diaz (8), RHP Nick Neidert (10), RHP Merandy Gonzalez (16) (recalled April 19 by the Marlins to Miami), and RHP Pablo Lopez (24), who began the year on Jacksonville's disabled list. All five of these prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

**TONIGHT-JOINS JUMBO SHRIMP ON REHAB ASSIGNMENT:** Today Miami Marlins right-handed pitcher Elieser Hernandez makes his first start for the Jumbo Shrimp, as he joins Jacksonville on a transfer of a major league rehab assignment from the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. Hernandez is on Miami's disabled list after dental surgery this spring. Hernandez made two rehab starts for Jupiter, going 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA, with starts on April 6 and April 24. He missed time in mid-April with a broken finger nail in his first rehab start on April 6. In his last start on Tuesday April 24, Hernandez pitched four innings where he allowed three runs (all earned) on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts as the Hammerheads fell to the Palm Beach Cardinals 5-4.

**RULE 5 DRAFT PICK-UP:** Hernandez was acquired by the Marlins from the Houston Astros in the Major League phase of the 2017 Rule 5 draft on December 14, 2017. A team that selects a player in the Rule 5 Draft pays \$50,000 to the team from which he was selected. The receiving team must then keep the player on the Major League 25-man roster for the entirety of the next season, and the selected player must remain active (not on the disabled list) for a minimum of 90 days. If the player does not remain on the Major League roster, he is offered back to the team from which he was selected for \$25,000. If his original team declines, the receiving team may waive the player.

**2017 WITH BUIES CREEK:** Hernandez posted a 4-5 record and a 3.98 ERA over 15 appearances and 11 starts with High-A Buies Creek in the Astros organization. He missed two months due to a back injury suffered midseason.

Acquired by the Marlins from the Houston Astros in the Major League phase of the 2017 Rule 5 draft on December 14, 2017

**2017 Highlights:** Hernandez posted a 4-5 record and a 3.98 ERA over 15 appearances and 11 starts with High-A Buies Creek in the Astros organization. He missed two months due to a back injury suffered midseason. Made seven appearances, five starts, before landing on disabled list with right back strain on May 19, in that time went 2-3 with a 5.46 ERA. Made three rehab appearances with the GCL Astros, going 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA with 14 strikeouts in 10 innings. Following reinstatement, went 2-2 with a 2.67 ERA in eight appearances and six starts. As starter: 2-5, 4.17 ERA in 11 starts, and as reliever: 2-0, 3.29 ERA in four games in relief. After the season made five starts with Aguilas del Zulia in Venezuelan Winter League, going 2-1 with a 2.11 ERA.

**2016 Highlights:** Combined to go 6-8 with a 4.51 ERA in 24 appearances (19 starts) between Single-A Quad Cities and High-A Lancaster. With Quad Cities went 4-3 with a 2.37 ERA in 11 appearances and nine starts. With Lancaster, 2-5 with a 6.93 ERA in 13 appearances and 10 starts.
