SNAPPER SNIPPETS

ROAD DAWGS: Carrying a 5-2 record on the road to start the Second Half, the Snappers are already guaranteed their first winning road trip since early May when they were 4-2 through Lake County & Fort Wayne. Beloit will wrap up their 4th multi-city trip on Thursday in Peoria & have two more remaining.

JAVON'S BIG NIGHT: JaVon Shelby was showing signs of promise at the plate leading into last night's 2 homer game & has now recorded 7 hits in 7 games to start the Second Half of the season. He also has delivered 5 RBI in those 7 games. Shelby is the 2nd different player to have a 2 home run game this season for the Snappers. Collin Theroux has had 2 games with a pair of homers on April 14 vs. Peoria & June 1 vs. Clinton.

MORE HITS FOR MARINEZ: Eric Marinez used his final at-bat to extend his hitting streak to 10 games, the longest of his professional career. He is now the 4th Snappers with a hitting streak to reach double digits along with Edwin Diaz, Miguel Mercedes, & Nate Mondou.

PERSICO PROVIDING: Luke Persico played in back-to-back games for the first time in the Second Half last night. He came through with an RBI in the 3rd to give him 6 RBIs over his last 3 games on 5 total hits. Persico's 2-hit game last night is the 17th multi-hit game of the year for the outfielder, 2nd-most on the active roster behind 22 games with multiple hits by **Luis Barrera**.

PREMIUM PUNCH OUTS: 8 strikeouts by **Matt Milburn** & 2 from **Heath Bowers** gave the Snappers their 36th game with double-digit strikeouts this season & the staff is now tied for the most in the MWL.

CLOSE GAMES: 49 of the Snappers 76 games have been decided by 3 runs or less. The Snappers are 24-25 in those games while they have also played the most one-run games in the Midwest League (27). Beloit has also used their final at-bat to take the lead & win 13 times.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: When the Snappers offense reached the 5-run plateau in the scoring column, they are 26-6 this season. When both the Snappers & their opponent score 5 runs in a game, Beloit is 9-6.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Xavier Altamirano gets his 2nd turn in the rotation after winning his first official starting nod on Saturday in Clinton. Altamirano had rain delay spot-start on May 22 vs. Wisconsin. He had an impressive run of 27.1 scoreless IP snapped in his last outing with 2 runs scoring in the first inning before he locked in. His 0.93 ERA in June leads the Snappers pitching staff.

FACING THE CHIEFS: Seven of 10 games between Beloit & Peoria have been decided in the final at-bat of the game. The Snappers will play their next 7 road games at Dozer Park with 4 games to begin the work week & 3 more next week over the 4th of July. Beloit's offense sputtered during their last visit to Peoria with just 4 runs over the first 3 games & lost a 7-6 contest in game 4. Peoria currently employs 4 of the Cardinals top-30 prospects. Those players include pitchers Jordan Hicks (#18) & Ronnie Williams (#24) along with outfielders Dylan Carlson (#16) & Nick Plummber (#22).
