TEAM NOTES

SECOND IN THE WEST: Toledo (45-32) leads the International League's West Division, while Indianapolis (43-32, 1.0 GB), Louisville (39-37, 5.5 GB) and Columbus (34-42, 10.5 GB) trail the leader.

GIVING UP THE TOP SPOT: The Indians occupied first place in the IL's West Division for 69 consecutive days earlier this season (April 16-June 23) ... In 2006, the Tribe spent 119 days in either first place or tied for the top spot.

TALK ABOUT HEARTBREAKERS: Indianapolis has suffered three consecutive walk-off losses heading into Monday evening's series finale at Toledo ... The Tribe has not dropped four straight contests in the opponents' final at-bat since June 23-26, 1982 ... Louisville scored 11 runs in the eighth and ninth frames of that four-game series to win every tilt in come-from-behind fashion.

LET'S SNAP THE SKID: The Indians enter Monday night's contest with their first four-game skid of 2007 ... Indianapolis has not dropped five straight affairs since a six-game losing streak Aug. 27-Sept. 1, 2005.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

LEADING THE LOOP: Indianapolis leads the International League in team batting average (.276) and hits (699), while also ranking second in runs (370) ... Toledo leads the league in runs (388), places second in hits (693) and fifth in team BA (.262).

TURNING INTO A POWER TEAM: The Indians whacked just 16 roundtrippers in their first 42 games of the season (0.38 per game), but have nailed 36 long balls over their past 33 contests (1.10 per game) ... The Tribe is fourth in the IL with 23 homers during the month of June.

AMONG THE IL LEADERS: Indianapolis UTIL **Yurendell de Caster** is first in the IL with a .426 on-base percentage, places seventh with a .317 batting average and is tied for seventh with 40 walks ... INF **Brian Bixler** is tied for first with seven triples, is knotted for fourth with 48 runs, ranks fifth with 17 stolen bases and eighth with a .399 OBP.

SEVEN STRAIGHT FOR MATOS: Indians OF **Luis Matos** enters Monday night's showdown with a seven-game hitting streak (.357 BA, 10-for-28, 3 R, 3 RBI) ... The 28-year-old is batting .277 with two HR and 22 RBI in 61 contests this year.

RYAN NAMED IL HITTER OF THE WEEK: Indianapolis OF **Michael Ryan** has been named International League Hitter of the Week for the period of June 18-24 ... The 29-year-old led the IL with seven extra-base hits and a .926 slugging percentage during the stretch ... Ryan batted .481 (13-for-27) with two HR and five RBI while also collecting four doubles, one triple and seven runs ... He enters Monday evening's affair with a five-game hitting streak (.571 BA, 12-for-21, 6 R, 5 RBI).

DEFENSIVE NOTES

DEFENSE WINS GAMES: Indianapolis is tied for third in the IL with a .982 fielding percentage ... The Tribe has committed just 51 miscues in 2,885 total chances through 75 contests (1,996 PO, 838 A, 51 E) ... The Indians are 27-14 in 41 errorless games this season.

HOLDING ON TO THE LEAD: The Indians are 37-2 on the season when leading after seven innings and 40-2 when holding an advantage after eight frames.

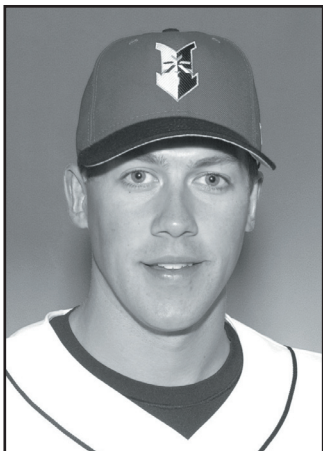

TONIGHT'S PROBABLE STARTER: Bryan Bullington is expected to take the hill for Indianapolis ... A 6-foot-4, 220-pound right-hander, Bullington is 9-3 with a 2.83 ERA in 13 starts this season ... He has allowed 63 hits and 30 walks while striking out 46 in 76.1 innings ... Bullington missed the 2006 season while recovering from right shoulder surgery ... He turned in an 9-5 record and 3.38 ERA in 18 appearances for the Indians in 2005 ... The 26-year-old was taken by Pittsburgh in the first round (first overall) of the 2002 draft ... Bullington came into the season with a 34-17 record and 3.33 ERA in 69 Minor League outings.

TOLEDO, Ohio -- Designated hitter Jack Hannahan roped a two-run single with two outs in the bottom of the ninth to finish off a three-run rally as Toledo recorded its third straight walk-off victory -- a 7-6 decision over Indianapolis -- before a sellout crowd of 10,300 Sunday night at Fifth Third Field.

The Mud Hens improve 45-32 overall and 23-14 at home, while the Indians fall to 43-32 on the season and 19-18 on the road. Toledo now leads the International League's West Division after the Tribe sat atop the standings for 69 consecutive days.

The Mud Hens scored three times in the ninth to snag another dramatic game. 2B Kevin Hooper (1-for-3, 2 R) got things rolling with a single to center and moved to second on a fielding error. 1B Chris Shelton (0-for-4, 1 R) was then hit by a pitch before 3B Mike Hessman (1-for-3, 1 R, 2 RBI) drew a bases-loaded walk to force home the first run. Hannahan followed with the game-winning base knock for his 38th and 39th RBI of the campaign.

The Tribe cracked the scoreboard with one run in the second when RF Michael Ryan (2-for-3, 1 R) and CF Luis Matos (1-for-4, 1 RBI) hit back-to-back doubles with two outs. Toledo knotted the contest in the bottom half as Hessman blasted his IL-leading 22nd homer over the left-field wall.

Indianapolis pulled ahead with three runs in its next at-bat. DH Carlos Maldonado (1-for-3, 1 R) led off with a walk before 3B Russ Johnson (1-for-4, 2 R, 2 RBI) smacked his fourth roudtripper of the season over the left-field wall. Indians RHP Franquelis Osoria (1.1 IP, 2 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 1 SO) was tagged with the loss, falling to 2-3. Mud Hens RHP Anthony Tomey (2.0 IP, 1 BB, 1 SO) earned the win, improving to 1-0.
