TEAM NOTES

BIXLER NAMED 2007 MVP: INF **Brian Bixler** has been named the Tribe's 2007 Most Valuable Player ... As part of the award, he will receive a custom-made ring courtesy of Windsor Jewelers ... The Triple-A rookie is hitting .274 with five long balls and 51 RBI in 126 games this season ... Bixler represented Indianapolis in this year's Triple-A All-Star Game and was the only Indian to pick up International League Postseason All-Star honors.

OTHER 2007 AWARD WINNERS: Five other individuals will be recognized prior to Saturday night's game -- RHP **Bryan Bullington** (Comeback Player of the Year), INF **Luis Ordaz** (Defensive Player of the Year), OF **Michael Ryan** (Sluggger of the Year), LHP **Michael Tejera** (Left-Handed Pitcher of the Year) and RHP **John Van Benschoten** (Right-Handed Pitcher of the Year).

A GREAT RUN ABOVE .500: Indianapolis heads into Saturday night's contest with a 70-70 overall record ... In three seasons as a Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate, the Tribe has spent 442 of 450 days (98%) at .500 or better ... The streak includes 281 consecutive in-season days from April 22, 2006 to Aug. 28, 2007.

A TIGHT RACE: Richmond (75-63) leads Buffalo (74-65, 1.5 GB) and Rochester (75-66, 1.5 GB) in the International League's Wild Card race ... Indianapolis has been mathematically eliminated from playoff contention, but still has a chance to register its third straight winning season.

FACING THE WEST: Indianapolis will play its final three games against IL West Division opponents ... The Tribe is 6-7 against Louisville this season, 8-8 vs. Columbus and 5-11 against Toledo.

BIG GAMES, BIG CROWDS: The Indians have averaged 9,762 fans per game over their last 33 home dates ... The Tribe ranks sixth in the 14-team International League with an attendance average of 8,293 through 69 openings this season.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

ROOKIE CALL-UPS: 1B/RF **Steven Pearce** and OF **Nyjer Morgan** received their first Major League promotions after Friday evening's contest ... Pearce ranks among the Minor League leader in total bases (3rd - 303), RBI (3rd - 113), extra-base hits (T-3rd - 75), slugging percentage (4th - .622) and home runs (T-6th - 31) ... Morgan was hitting .305 with 10 RBI in 44 tilts ... He also tied for seventh in the IL with 26 thefts despite missing more than three months due to a dislocated left thumb.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Tribe INF **Brian Bixler** places among IL leaders in triples (T-1st - 10), runs (T-1st - 77) and stolen bases (T-4th - 27) ... OF **Michael Ryan** is tied for eighth in slugging (.482) and 10th in homers (16), while UTIL **Yurendell de Caster** is tied for eighth in on-base percentage (.380).

DEFENSIVE NOTES

DUKE MAKES A SPOT START: Pirates LHP **Zach Duke** will make a Major League rehabilitation start for Indianapolis on Saturday night ... Duke posted a 3-7 record and 5.79 ERA in 17 big league starts from April 2-June 28 ... The 24-year-old was placed on the disabled list July 1 with tendonitis in his left elbow.

DEFENSE WINS GAMES: Indianapolis is tied for first in the IL with a .982 fielding percentage ... The Tribe has committed just 95 miscues in 5,288 total chances through 141 games (3,694 PO, 1,499 A, 95 E) ... The Indians are 49-28 in 77 errorless contests this season.

TONIGHT'S PROBABLE STARTER: Zach Duke is expected to make a Major League rehabilitation start for Indianapolis ... A 6-foot-2, 220-pound left-hander, Duke went 3-7 with a 5.79 ERA in 17 big league appearances before being placed on the disabled list July 1 with left elbow tendonitis ... He allowed 141 hits and 22 walks while striking out 33 in 93.1 innings for the Pirates ... Duke was selected by Pittsburgh in the 20th round of the 2001 draft ... The 24-year-old came into the season with a 18-17 record and 3.72 ERA in 48 Major League starts.

INDIANAPOLIS -- First baseman Joey Votto collected a pair of RBI doubles, while right-hander Justin Mallett scattered just four hits over five frames as Louisville posted a 4-2 win over Indianapolis in front of 12,635 Friday night at Victory Field.

The Bats improve to 71-70 overall and 34-37 on the road, while the Indians fall to 70-70 on the season and 39-32 at home. The Tribe has been mathematically eliminated from playoff contention, but still has a chance to register its third straight winning season.

Mallett (5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 SO) picked up the win in the first Triple-A start of his five-year professional career.
