Fritz Maisel was a speedy shortstop/third baseman who spent three years in Baltimore on his way to the New York Yankees. After his Major League career ended, Maisel returned to the Orioles in 1919 and sparked the team to seven straight pennants. Maisel led the IL in steals just once (44 in 1913), but over his 13-year career he amassed more stolen bases than any man in League history. Maisel was hired as Baltimore's manager after his playing career ended, leading the club to a 374-294 record in four seasons at the helm.
