**ACES AT A GLANCE:** Reno halted a short two-game losing skid with a 4-0 victory over the Sacramento River Cats last night at Raley Field...marked the first shutout thrown in Aces franchise history...was also Reno's first-ever win over its neighboring rival...**RHP Tony Barnette** earned his second-straight win after throwing 6.1 shutout frames...the last time he didn't allow a run in a start was 8/29/08, which was his last start of 2008 (5 IP, 0 R, 2 H, 5 SO, 0 BB)...**INF Ruben Gotay** broke a 0-0 tie in the sixth with a two-out, two-run triple...was Gotay's first triple of the season and the first in his career since 4/13/07 as a member of Triple-A New Orleans (vs Nashville, off Chris Oxspring)...**RHP Hector Ambriz** became the ninth Ace to make his Triple-A debut this season.

**ON THE HILL:** Tonight **RHP Seth Etherton** takes the ball in search of his third win in his sixth start of 2009...making his fourth daytime start of the season (2-0, 3.00 ERA)...split the 2005 season between Sacramento and Oakland...went 7-7 with a 2.72 ERA in 20 games—19 starts—for the River Cats...led Sacramento in strikeouts...today making his third-career start against the River Cats (0-0, 3.86 ERA)...both starts against Sacramento came in 2006 as a member of the Portland Beavers in the San Diego Padres chain...a win today would mark his first season with at least 3 victories at a single stop since 2005 (7-7, Sacramento)...combined for 4 wins in 2006 among 3 clubs (Portland, Omaha, Kansas City)...has reached the 85-pitch plateau in 3-straight starts...on 4/11/09 at SLC, made first start in affiliated baseball since June 29, 2007 for the Albuquerque Isotopes—then a Florida Marlins affiliate (3.1 IP, 7 H, 8 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 2 K)...earned the victory that day, his first victory in affiliated baseball since June 19, 2007 at Single-A Jupiter (Marlins organization)...also marked first win in Aces franchise history...was 18th overall pick in 1998 first-year player draft.

**WHITEY HEADED TO THE SHOW:** Prior to today's game, **INF Josh Whitesell** was recalled by the Arizona Diamondbacks...when he plays, will be appearing in his eighth-career Major League game...made his big league debut on 9/2/08 in a pinch-hitting role...collected his first Major League hit (1B, 7th inning, off Brad Hennessey) in his first Major League start (9/15/08 vs SF, 1B)...hit his first Major League home run on 9/21/08 (at COL, off Steven Register)...for Reno in 2009, Whitesell batted .356 with 3 homers and 20 RBI...he leaves the Pacific Coast League ranked in the top-10 in batting average and on-base percentage...taking Whitesell's place on the Aces roster is **INF Bryan Byrne**, who today was transferred to Reno from Double-A Mobile...in 23 games this season for the BayBears, Byrne batted .279 with a home run and 15 RBI...a year ago, Byrne led Mobile in average (.303), doubles (27), walks (66) and OBP (.405)...his batting average also ranked eighth among all Diamondbacks farmhands...when he plays, will be the 10th Ace this season to make his Triple-A debut...resides in nearby Danville, CA.

**BIGGEST LITTLE NOTES IN THE WORLD:** The Aces have amended their rotation, inserting **RHP Hector Ambriz** into the starting five...Ambriz takes the place of **LHP Travis Blackley**, who will now work out of the bullpen...Ambriz made 5 starts for Double-A Mobile before his promotion to Triple-A Reno on 5/1 (3-2, 2.17 ERA, 32 SO, 6 BB)...Ambriz made his Triple-A debut last night for Reno in a relief role (1 IP, Hold, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 SO)...in his last start (5/1 at JAX), Ambriz earned the victory for the BayBears after throwing 7 shutout innings...Blackley was 0-3 with an 8.31 ERA in 5 starts for Reno...as a team, Reno is 1 of only 2 clubs in the league with a batting average above the .300 mark (.303, 2nd in PCL).
