ACES AT A GLANCE: Last night, the Aces salvaged a series split with first-place Sacramento, taking a 10-4 win in the series finale at Aces Ballpark...**RHP Bryan Augenstein** earned his 2nd Triple-A victory of the season...tonight's game kicks-off the final series before the Triple-A All-Star Break (7/13-15) and continues the venerated Silver State Diamond Challenge, affectionately referred to by most as the SSDC.

ALL-TIME SERIES: Tonight marks the 7th-ever meeting between the Aces and 51s...the season series is tied at 3-3...after this 5-game series, the Aces will make a return trip to Cashman Field in August for 5 games (8/26-8/30).

ON THE HILL: Tonight, **RHP Billy Buckner** takes the ball for Reno, looking for his 3rd-straight Triple-A victory...tonight making his 7th start and 9th appearance for Reno (3-2, 3.41 ERA), 2nd start and 4th appearance at Aces Ballpark (0-0, 5.63 ERA) and 7th-career start vs LVG (3-3, 5.24 ERA)...optioned by the Diamondbacks on 6/27...went 2-5, 8.63 in 10 games—7 starts—for Arizona...allowed 8 ER on 7 hits over 1.2 IP in his last Major League start (6/26 vs LAA)...won 2-straight Triple-A starts and 3 of his last 4...has allowed just 4 ER over his last 4 Triple-A starts (22.1 IP, 1.61 ERA)...beat LVG in his last start (7/3, 6.0 IP, 1 ER)...tonight's start marks the second-straight season he has made consecutive starts vs LVG.

GETTING EM IN: INF Ryan Roberts led Reno's offensive attack last night, collecting 4 RBIs...was his first 4-plus-RBI game since 7/26/08, when he knocked in 7 at CSP while playing for OKC...marked his 9th-career 4-plus-RBI game...was just the second time in his career he collected 4-plus RBIs without the benefit of a home run...dating back to last season in OKC, Roberts has hit in 10 of his last 11 Triple-A games (20x47, .426)...has 7 runs and 12 RBIs in that 11-game span.

TURNING HIS (DEFENSIVE) SWAG ON: In the 9th inning last night, **OF Brandon Watson** ended the ballgame with an assist (Denorfia, at 2nd base)...marked Watson's 12th OF assist of the season...now tied for first among all Pacific Coast League outfielders (also Aaron Mathews, LVG)...Watson has the same number or more OF assists than 5 PCL teams...the Aces have combined for 27 OF assists on the season, most of any PCL club (2nd-POR, 25).

TODAY'S MOVES: Prior to today's game, **LHP Doug Slaten** was recalled by the Diamondbacks...for Reno, Slaten had allowed just 1 ER over his last 12 appearances (12.1 IP, 0.73 ERA)...also vacating the Reno roster was RHP Bobby Korecky, who was placed on the 7-day Disabled List...Reno's closer left Monday's game after 19 pitches...also Wednesday, RHP Reid Mahon (pronounced MAY-hen) was transferred to Reno from Mobile (AA)...in 19 relief appearances for Mobile, went 5-1-1, 3.21 ERA.

ALL-STAR ACES: Reno's **RHP Bobby Korecky** and **INF Rusty Ryal** have been selected to represent the Pacific Coast League in the 2009 Triple-A All-Star Game...Korecky will not participate, due to injury...marks the second time Korecky has been selected to participate (also 2007, Albuquerque, N.M., playing for Rochester (Minnesota))...will be Ryal's first-career Triple-A All-Star Game...the 2009 Triple-A All-Star Game will be played at PGE Park in Portland, Ore., at 7 p.m. on July 15...the game can be seen live on ESPN2 and heard on Fox Sports Radio 1450 AM.

CLIMBING THE LEADER BOARD: OF Trent Oeltjen is tied for the lead among all Minor League batters with 12 triples this season...has recorded 3 more triples than any other player in the Pacific Coast League (Eric Patterson-SAC (9))...INF Ruben Gotay leads the Pacific Coast League with 64 walks...Gotay ranks 3rd among all Minor League hitters in walks (1st—Logan Forsythe, San Antonio, 68).

SILVER STATE DIAMOND CHALLENGE: Tonight is the 6th of 16 scheduled games between the Aces and 51s in 2009...winner of the season series will hold the Silver State Diamond Challenge plaque...**Reno Mayor Bob Cashell** and **Las Vegas Mayor Oscar Goodman** have made a wager on the season series...the losing city's mayor will wear the winning club's jersey for full day of business, including a city council meeting...additionally, the losing city's mayor will donate \$100 to the winning city's mayor's charity of choice for the difference in wins on the season series...Aces and 51s represent one of 3 in-state rivalries currently in the PCL (also, California—Fresno & Sacramento, Tennessee—Memphis & Nashville).

BIGGEST LITTLE NOTES IN THE WORLD: Tonight's game begins Reno's 4th-straight series against an American League affiliated club...marks the 6th-straight series against an American League affiliate at Aces Ballpark.
