The Lake Monsters are 3 games over .500 for the 2nd time this season (17-14) and with win tonight would be 4 over .500 for 1st time since 18-14 in 2008.

**YESTERDAY:** The Lake Monsters scored 4 unearned runs in the 3rd inning for a 5-0 and then used the relief pitching of Clayton Dill for a 5-2 win at Lowell ... Jack Walker and Sandy Leon both had RBI doubles during the 4-run 3rd inning ... Starter Jack McGearly (2-1) allowed 1 unearned run on 3 hits over 5.0 innings for the win ... With the score 5-2, Dill came on with the bases loaded and 1 out in the 7th inning and got out of the jam with a strikeout and popout ... After a leadoff triple in 8th, Dill struckout 6 of final 7 batters faced for 6th save ... Brian Pruitt and Justin Bloxom 2 hits.

**HERE'S THE SITUATION:** Neither team had much success with runners in scoring position last night as Vermont was 1-for-11, while Lowell was 0-for-13 with RISP and 0-for-3 with a runner on 3rd and less than 2 outs ... Vermont opponents are just 2-for-36 (.056) with runners in scoring position over last 5 games and are hitting just .210 with RISP overall this year.

**IF THEY CAN'T SCORE:** During 4-1 stretch in the last 5 games, Lake Monsters have allowed 2 runs or less 4 times (11 total runs) after 5 or more runs in 4 straight (22 runs) ... Vermont has allowed 2 runs or less in 16 of 33 games (14-2 record).

**BUT YOU CAN SCORE:** With 5 runs last night, Vermont has scored 5 or more runs in 13 of 33 games (10-3 record) ... The Lake Monsters 2 or less runs in 12 games with a 4-8 record.

**INJURY REPORT:** The Lake Monsters put 1 player on the disabled list and activated 2 players from disabled list Thursday ... Infielder Jeff Kobernus was placed on the DL, while Pat Lehman, tonight's starting pitcher, and outfielder Yhonson Lopez activated ... Lopez has been on DL since start of season.

**STEDLER DIVISION SHOWDOWN:** Last night was the start of 12 straight games for Vermont against Stedler Division rivals Lowell and Oneonta ... The Lake Monsters play 8 games vs. Spinners and 4 vs. Oneonta between July 23rd and August 3rd ... After August 3rd, and with 32 games remaining, Vermont does not play Lowell or Oneonta again.

**GETTING OFF TO A GOOD START:** With the win in the series opener on Thursday, the Lake Monsters are now 8-3 in the 1st game of a series ... Vermont 3-7 in 2nd game, 6-3 in 3rd.
