- Tours are approximately 90 minutes in length
- Tours include an approximately one hour behind the scenes tour of the ballpark and a half-hour of educational content.
- The educational component of the tour is where our guides spend time with each class for a more interactive learning experience.
- Learning activities are based on curriculum for appropriate grade level. The tour group can download a FREE curriculum packet from our web site.
- Students are encouraged to bring their bag lunch and eat at the ballpark.
