IL WEST CHAMPS!

Sat. night, the Bats clinched their 2nd consecutive West Division Title & 4th overall since 2001 ('01, '03, '08, '09).

PLAYOFF HISTORY: The 2008 season was the 3d time since Louisville joined the IL in '98 that the Bats and Bulls met in the Governors' Cup playoffs. Durham defeated the Redbirds in 1998, 3-0, and the Bats in 2003, 3-1. The only IL Championship came in 2001 when the RiverBats were named champs after defeating Norfolk in the first round (3-2) & the SWB Red Barons (1-0) in the finals; the finals were shortened that year due to the terrorist attacks of 9/11.

Fifth Game of a Seven-Game Home/Road Series, First Game of a Six-Game Road Trip
Jim Kelch and Matt Andrews with tonight's play-by-play on 790 WKRD

- **TONIGHT:** The Bats take on the Columbus Clippers (13-5), Triple-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians, in the fifth game of a seven-game home/road series & the first game of a four-game road trip. The Bats are 5-2 at Huntington Park and 8-3 against the Clippers at Louisville Slugger Field. Since 1988, the Bats have a 120-99 record against Columbus and they are 112-96 in Columbus.
- **VERSUS THE WEST (35-20):** Louisville is playing their final eight games of the season against their West Division rivals; the Bats are 13-5 vs. Columbus (3g left), 11-6 vs. Indy (5g left) and 11-9 vs. Toledo. Last year, Louisville went 41-23 versus the West and the last time the Bats had a losing record against the West was in 2006 (20-28) – they were 29-19 in 2007.
- **VAZQUEZ ON THE HILL:** LHP Camilo Vazquez (0-0, 4.15) was transferred to Louisville today from Double-A Carolina & makes his first Bats start of the season tonight after three relief appearances in June (6/17, 6/20, 6/25). Vazquez began the season in the Mudcats' bullpen & became a full-time starter June 29. In 11 Carolina starts, the southpaw is 3-3 with a 5.19era and one quality start (8/20 at Jax); in 23 relief apps, he's 2-1 with a 5.46era. Overall on the season with Carolina, Vazquez is 5-4 with a 5.39era. He left Carolina on a 3g winning streak (8/15-pres) after ending his 3g skid (7/18-7/25).
- **TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS:** RHP Ramon Ramirez (6-7, 4.03era) is recalled by Cincinnati today for the second time this season. Ramirez was recalled on May 19 and made one app for the Reds (5/21 vs. Phi, 2.1ip, 1h, 2r-2er, 1bb-3k); he was optioned back to Lou May 23. Ramirez began the season as a starter, but moved to the Bats bullpen July 27 (made one start 7/31) and in 11 relief apps, went 1-0, 1.62era; as a starter, Ramirez was 5-7, 4.39era. LHP Camilo Vazquez is transferred to Louisville from Carolina (see above).
- **BARKER NAMED BATS MVP:** For the second consecutive season, IB Kevin Barker was named the Mary E. Barney MVP for the Louisville Bats. This season, Barker became the franchise leader in home runs (89), extra-base hits (198), doubles (97), multi-hr games (7) and grand slams (6) & is one shy of tying the runs record (record is 280). Barker shared the honor last season with RHP Jon Adkins.
- **RACE FOR BEST IN THE IL:** With Durham holding a 2.0g lead over Gwinnett in the South, Louisville is remains 1.0 game ahead of the Bulls in the race for the best record in the IL. If the Bats (78-56, .582) win the West, they will travel to face the South winner in the first round of the Governors' Cup playoffs for a best-of-five series. Gwinnett and Durham are slugging it out down the stretch and one of these teams will host games one & two (9/9-9/10) while Louisville will host games three through five (9/11-9/13), as necessary. Louisville is 4-4 against the Braves this season, splitting the four-game series at LSF & at Gwinnett Stadium. The Bats are 3-5 against the Bulls, splitting the four-game series at LSF and going 1-3 at DBAP. Sacramento has the best record in Triple-A (84-51, .622).
- **AUGUST HEAT:** With an 18-10 record so far in the month of August, the Bats have clinched another winning month. It's their third straight winning August and they have not had a losing August since 2005 when they went 11-18. It's also their 8th winning month out of the last 10. In the last two seasons, they Bats have only had two losing months: June of '08 they finished 13-15 and in May of this year they went 12-19. Last August they set a franchise record for wins in any month with 23.
- **ON THE ROAD (34-30):** Lou is batting .262 (573-2,183) with 57 HR & 289 runs scored (4.52 runs/game) and a 3.82era. The Bats are the only team in its division with a winning record on the road and with six road games remaining, need to go 2-4 to finish the season with a winning road record (36-35). It would be just the fifth time the franchise would have a winning record away from their friendly confines (1983, 1987, 2001, 2008). Louisville had an extremely successful '08 road season & led the IL with a franchise record 44 wins last year, breaking the mark of 38 set during the '01 championship year.
- **22 OVER:** With last night's win, the Bats tied their high-water mark & are now 22g over .500 (78-56) for the third second time this season; they first reached the 22g over mark on Aug. 25 (76-54). The 2008 team, that set a franchise record with 88 wins, reached 22g over Aug. 5 (70-48), hit 23g over Aug. 6 (71-48) and were 24g over on Aug. 7; the Bats were in the middle of an 8-game winning streak (8/1-8/8) and won 15 of 16 games during that stretch (8/1-8/17). The '08 team finished the season 32g over .500 (88-56).
- **CRAZY EIGHTS:** Lou is on pace for another 80+ win season (83-59) which would give the franchise their first back-to-back 80-win seasons & just their third since '82. The '01 RiverBats went 84-60 & won the Governors' Cup Championship while last year's 88-56 team lost in the first round of the playoffs to Dur. The Bats had 2g cancelled this season (6/5 at Paw, 8/26 at Tol) & will only play 142g.
- **SAVE-A-LOT:** For the 2nd straight season, the Bats look to lead the IL in saves after setting a franchise record with 56 in '08; Jon Adkins recorded 30 of Lou's 56 saves which also led the IL. This year the Bats are leading the IL with 48 saves & are on pace to finish with 51 which will be the 2nd-best mark in history behind last year's 56; it will be just the 2nd time in history that a Lou team earns at least 50 saves in a season. Eight different pitchers have recorded a save this season with RHP Josh Roenicke (to Tor in the Scott Rolen deal) earning the most with 12. LHP Pedro Viola & RHP Logan Ondrusek are the leaders on the active roster with eight.
- **SOME QUALITY TIME:** Louisville starting pitchers have 73 quality starts in 134 games this season (54%) and the Bats are 52-21 when a pitcher throws a quality start. The team had eight in April (6-2), 18 in May (9-9), 19 in June (15-4), 15 in July (10-5) and 13 so far in August (12-1). In 2008, Bats starters had 68 quality starts out of 144 games (47%).
- **RUNS EQUAL WINS:** The Bats are 64-15 when scoring four or more runs in a game & 14-41 when scoring three or fewer.
- **TACKLING THE ERROR ISSUE:** Louisville committed three errors last night; it was the first time they had at least three errors in a game since 8/12 at LHV. The Bats are T-10th in the IL with 117 errors & have committed at least one error in 73 of 134g. They're last in the IL in double plays (106), 12th in assists (1,295) & T-10th in fielding % (.976). After going five straight games without an error (8/1-8/6), Louisville committed 11 in eight games (8/7-8/14). The '08 team committed 105 errors & this year's team is on pace for 124. The 1983 Redbirds hold the franchise record for most errors in a season with 170 (135g).
- **THIS & THAT:** Louisville's 3.48 team ERA is 2nd best in the IL and if the pitching staff holds form, it will be the lowest team ERA in franchise history. The 1985 Redbirds hold the record (3.51) and last season's West Division winning team had an ERA of 3.96. The staff's 940 total strikeouts is on pace for 996 which would be fifth most in franchise history; the '08 team set the record with 1,027. And if Bats hitters stay on pace in striking out, it will be the first time since 2006 and the second time since 2003 that the team does not strikeout at least 1,000 times; at 919 strikeouts, they're currently on pace for 974 k's.
- **AFL:** RHP Logan Ondrusek & OF Chris Heisey will play for the Peoria Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League this fall. Other Reds org. members in the AFL this year are LHP Phillippe Valiquette, RHP Sean Watson, IB Yonder Alonso & IF Zach Cozart.
- **JUKICH WINS MONTHLY AWARD:** LHP Ben Jukich was named Cincinnati's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July (5gs, 3-0, 1.62era). It's the second time a Bats pitcher has won the award, LHP Matt Maloney won for April (3gs, 2-0, 1.86era).
- **4'S GALORE:** Last night IF Wes Bankston and IF Todd Frazier each had four hits which tied their career highs. Last night was Bankston's 2nd four-hit game of the season (7/21 vs. BUF) and the 7th of his career. Frazier has three four-hit games this season, two with Double-A Carolina (5/30 vs. MTG, 4/11 at MIS). He now has six in his career.
