

Daily Fee-Based Services for Montgomery County Residents

Appliances

The disposal fee for appliances is charged per pound.

Accepted Appliances:

- ✦ Air conditioners
- ✦ Refrigerators/Freezers
- ✦ Dishwashers
- ✦ Hot water heaters
- ✦ Washers/Dryers
- ✦ Water softener tanks
- ✦ Ranges/Stoves/Ovens
- ✦ Dehumidifiers

In addition to the per-pound disposal rate, a freon removal fee will be charged per appliance to residents bringing in more than five (5) appliances with freon per year.

Waste/Trash Disposal

Residential waste can be disposed of at both the North and South facilities. The in-district disposal fee is charged per pound.

Yard Waste

Clean, separated organic material in loose/bulk form or in paper yard bags.*

Accepted Materials:

- ✦ Grass clippings
- ✦ Brush/Branches
- ✦ Leaves
- ✦ Other organic materials

*Any yard waste in plastic bags or mixed with trash will be charged a higher disposal fee.

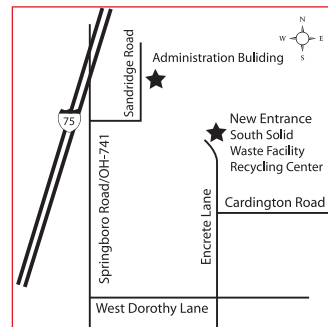

Free Daily Services for Montgomery County Residents

Post-Consumer Recyclables*

Containers are available for the following:

Bottles, Jars and Cans:

- ✦ Aluminum cans
- ✦ Glass bottles and jars
- ✦ Plastic bottles and containers (#1-6)
- ✦ Steel cans (including empty aerosol cans)

Mixed Paper:

- ✦ Newspaper
- ✦ Magazines
- ✦ Telephone books
- ✦ Paperboard boxes (i.e., tissue and cereal boxes)
- ✦ Newspaper ads and inserts
- ✦ Junk mail
- ✦ Office paper and envelopes
- ✦ Shredded paper

- ✦ Paper egg cartons
- ✦ Paper grocery bags

Corrugated Cardboard Boxes:

- ✦ Moving/shipping/package/storage boxes
- *Please do not bag recyclables

Items Not Accepted:

Plastic bags
Buckets
Ceramic
Styrofoam
Plastic deli trays
Window glass

Automotive Fluids

- ✦ Motor oil
- ✦ Transmission fluid
- ✦ Antifreeze

Free Daily Services *continued*

Electronics/Computers

Households can bring nonworking electronics for recycling.

Accepted Items:

- ✦ Computers (whole systems or parts)
- ✦ Radios, televisions, VCRs
- ✦ Speakers, CD/DVD players, receivers
- ✦ Telephones/cell phones, answering machines
- ✦ Scanners, 2-way radios

Items Not Accepted:

Vacuums, small appliances

Accepted in household plastics program or if it still works, call (937) 496-6639 (McMRF) to donate it.

Residential Tires

Up to 10 tires per year can be disposed of at no cost, (max. 10 tires per trip) with proof of residency. Tires should not be larger than 9" x 20". Any tires in excess of 20" are charged by weight. Tires are accepted with or without rims. Call (937) 225-4999 for pricing.



Household Plastics Recycling Program

Residents of Montgomery County are encouraged to take advantage of this free service to recycle their larger plastic items and reduce their solid waste.

Accepted Items:

- ✦ Plastic toys of any type (incl. remote control cars, dolls, etc.)

- ✦ Plastic swimming pools (not vinyl and must be clean of algae)
- ✦ Plastic sandboxes
- ✦ Slides
- ✦ Toy boxes
- ✦ Plastic lawn furniture (chairs, tables, etc.)
- ✦ Plastic fence and decking
- ✦ Basketball backboards

- ✦ Play houses

- ✦ Plastic appliances

Items Not Accepted:

Post-consumer plastic and bottles (See post-consumer recyclables)

Used plastic trash containers

Plastic bags

Household Hazardous Waste

Collection Days/Times:

Tuesdays: North Solid Waste Facility
8:00 am to 2:00 pm
Saturdays: South Solid Waste Facility
8:00 am to 2:00 pm

Proof of residency required

Accepted Items:

- ✦ Household and vehicle batteries
- ✦ Paints (latex & oil-based)
- Please throw away dried out latex paint in your regular trash.
- ✦ Aerosol cans

- ✦ Varnishes, stains, thinners, strippers
- ✦ Fluorescent lights
- ✦ Pool chemicals
- ✦ Household cleaners
- ✦ Gasoline, kerosene
- ✦ Pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers
- ✦ Gas/propane cans
- ✦ Fire extinguishers
- ✦ Other (call with questions)

Items Not Accepted:

Asbestos, explosives, radioactives and items over 25 pounds or 15 gallons.
