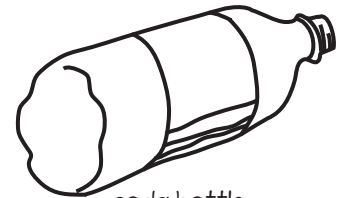
I can put my bin at the curb outside of my treehouse for the recycling truck to pick up. Can you?



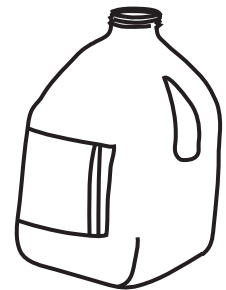

Follow the path and pick up as many items as you can to recycle, without crossing paths.



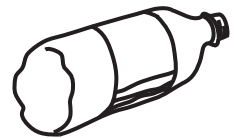
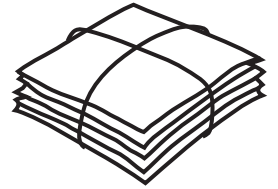
Many communities have recycling centers.
