## GUYER & HUFF MAKE CASE FOR ALL-STAR GAME; EARN IL PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

The International League announced today that Durham outfielder Brandon Guyer and Columbus pitcher David Huff have been named the League's Batter and Pitcher of the Week for the period from June 13-19. Guyer is the fourth member of the Bulls to win an IL weekly award this season (Alexander Torres, April 11-17; Justin Ruggiano, May 2-8; Felipe Lopez, May 16-22), while Huff becomes the third Clipper to be so honored in 2011 (Chad Huffman, April 18-24; Jeanmar Gomez, June 6-12).

### IL BATTER OF THE WEEK

Durham's Brandon Guyer didn't dominate any one category this week, but he turned in very solid numbers across the board to help the Bulls stay atop the IL South Division. Over the six games played this week, Guyer hit .409 with a double, a triple, a homer, 7 RBI (3rd in the IL), six runs scored (T-1st), and a pair of stolen bases (T-2nd). Guyer produced two three-hit games during the week, including a 3-for-5, 4-RBI, 3-run effort Friday night at Gwinnett. Guyer has been one of the League's best hitters this season, as evidenced by his .323 average (5th in the IL), .540 slugging percentage (4th), and 47 runs scored (T-4th).

25-year-old Brandon Guyer was the Chicago Cubs Minor League Player of the Year in 2010 with Double-A Tennessee. The Southern League All-Star was traded to Tampa Bay in the offseason as part of the deal for Matt Garza. Guyer is a native of West Chester, Pennsylvania.

### IL PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Columbus lefty David Huff won twice this week with a couple of 7-inning gems, leading the circuit with 14 strikeouts along the way. 10 of those 14 whiffs came Monday night at Buffalo as Huff stymied Bisons hitting to the tune of just one run on four hits with no walks. The Clippers won comfortably, 8-2. Huff took the hill again Sunday afternoon at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Once he again, he scattered four hits over 7 inning without walking a batter. This time he didn't allow a run, and Columbus took the game 2-0. The victory was Huff's sixth of the season, which is tied for 3rd in the International League.

25-year-old David Huff is a former first round draft choice of the Cleveland Indians. Though he has spent the entire 2011 season thus far at the Triple-A level, Huff does have 38 starts under his belt in the majors with the Indians since 2009. Huff is a native of San Diego, California.
