TODAY'S GAME: Is the finale of a 4-game set vs. the Las Vegas 51s at Aces Ballpark (2-1) and the 4th of a 4-game homestand (2-1)...Reno is coming off a series split with the 51s at Cashman Field (2-2)...after tonight's game, the Aces will travel to Raley Field for a 4-game series against the Sacramento River Cats (6/25-28).

LAST NIGHT: Reno allowed 5 runs in the first and played catch-up most of the night before **INF Brandon Allen** slapped a 2-run single in the bottom of the 8th to flip a 1-run deficit into an 8-7 Aces victory over Las Vegas...**RHP Yhency Brazoban** earned the win in relief...**INF Sean Burroughs** collected 3 hits...4 players drove in 2 runs apiece.

ACES ALL TIME: The Aces are 192-169 (.532) all-time, entering today's contest...Reno is 101-78 (.564) all-time at Aces Ballpark...this marks the 14th season of Triple-A Baseball for the Arizona Diamondbacks organization...D-backs Triple-A affiliates are 961-969 (.498) all-time.

VS. LAS VEGAS: Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 44th all-time meeting between the Aces and Panic! at the Disco drummer Spencer Smith's Las Vegas 51s...Reno leads the all-time series 24-19 (.558), after taking 11-of-16 matchups last season...the 51s won 5 of the 1st 6 meetings between the 2 clubs this season before the Aces took 4 of the last 5...Reno and Las Vegas represent 1-of-3 intrastate rivalries in the Pacific Coast League (also, Memphis & Nashville; Fresno & Sacramento)...Reno and LVG were Pacific Southern Division rivals in 2009 & 2010 before Reno was transitioned to the Pacific North in 2011...Aces Ballpark and Cashman Field are separated by 448 miles.

ON THE HILL: Tonight, **RHP Matthew T. Torra** takes the rock for Reno, looking for his 1st victory since 6/4...tonight making his 15th start of the season (4-2, 5.60 ERA), 8th start at Aces Ballpark (1-1, 5.54 ERA) and 9th-career start vs. Las Vegas (3-1, 6.98 ERA)...has made 2 starts vs. the 51s this season, going 0-0 with an 11.70 ERA...Reno is 1-1 (.500) this season with Torra on the mound vs. LVG (both at Cashman Field)...took a no decision in his last start (6/19 at LVG), despite allowing a season-high 8 ER on a season-high 14 hits over a season-low-tying 4.0 IP...surrendered runs in all 4 frames...left the game with an 8-4 deficit before the Aces rallied late to win, 12-9...did not issue a base on balls for the 2nd time in 3 outings and 4th time overall this season...has now walked 3 batters or fewer in all 14 outings this season...his clubs are 4-4 (.500) in his career when he's on the mound vs. the 51s.

ONE FOR THE WIN: A win tonight would seal Reno's 10th series victory of the season...the Aces' last series victory came vs. Tucson (6/13-16)...Reno won 10 series all of last season...that club won its 10th series on 8/27 at Cashman Field...in 2009, the Aces won 15 series...the 2009 club won its 10th series on 8/11 at Omaha...Reno is 10-8 (.556) this season in series finales...the Aces are 5-0 (1.000) this season when the finale decides a series victory or series split...in the club's 8 series at Aces Ballpark this season, Reno has won 4 series and split 4 series.

CARDIAC KIDS: Last night's victory marked Reno's 21st come-from-behind win of the season...was the Aces' 4th win when trailing after 7 innings (4-15, .211)...marked Reno's 1st comeback win since 6/19 at LVG.

STARTER STRUGGLES: Over Reno's last 2 games, its starting pitchers (**LHP Tom Layne**, **LHP Zach Kroenke**) have combined to surrender 18 ER over 6.2 IP (24.30 ERA)...prior to this 2-game stretch, Aces starters allowed 3 ER or fewer in 3 of their last 4 outings.

TONY ON A TEAR: **INF Tony Abreu** doubled and tripled last night, pushing his hitting streak to 15 games (since 6/4)...is the longest active streak in the PCL...is batting .344 (22x64) over the stretch...has hit safely in 21-of-22 (since 5/26)...recorded 6 multi-hit efforts over the 15-game run...this string tops his previous season-high hitting streak of 14 (4/9-21)...this is the 6th 15+ game hitting streak in franchise history and the 4th this season...a hit today would mark the 4th 16+ game hitting streak in franchise history (4th this season)...in his career, has 2 career-best 16-game hitting streaks (7/23/04-8/13/04, Single-A Columbus; 7/30/09-8/18/09, Triple-A Albuquerque).

MORE STREAKS: In addition to a 15-game overall hitting streak, **INF Tony Abreu** has hit in 18-straight at Aces Ballpark (since 5/13)...over the 18-game run at home, is batting .352 (25x71) with 3 HR and 17 RBIs...marks the 2nd-longest active home hitting streak in the PCL.

RANSOM NOTE: **INF Cody Ransom** collected 2 RBIs last night, increasing his season total to 63...is now in a 3-way tie for the Triple-A lead in the category...the other 2 Triple-A batters with 63 RBIs (**OF Wily Mo Peña**-RNO, **INF Anthony Rizzo**-TUC) are currently in the big leagues...Ransom is tied for 4th among all Minor League batters in the category...has driven in runs in 4-straight games (6 in the span)...last night marked his 18th multi-RBI effort of the season...he is already just 30 RBIs shy of matching a career-high (93 RBIs; Triple-A Round Rock & Houston; 2007).

CREATING SEPARATION: The Aces enter play today with a 10.0 game lead in the division for the 2nd time this season...marks the largest division lead in all of Triple-A Baseball...prior to this season, Reno had never held a divisional lead of more than one-half game...the latest the Aces had ever been in 1st place prior to this season was 4/17 (2009)...this season, Reno has spent 76 days in first place...the Aces' high-water mark of the season is 13--marking the club's most games over .500 since the final day of the 2009 season (15 games).

REHAB REPORT: **RHP Sam Demel** began his Major League Rehabilitation Assignment with Reno last night...tossed a perfect 7th inning...threw 12 pitches (7 strikes).

WHAT A RELIEF: Three Aces relievers combined to hold Las Vegas scoreless over the game's final 4.1 innings last night...allowed just 1 hit with 0 walks and 6 strikeouts...Reno improved to 22-3 (.880) on the season when the bullpen doesn't allow a run...**RHP Jason Urquidez** struck out 3 of the 4 batters he faced...**RHP Yhency Brazoban** threw 2.0 scoreless innings to earn the win--his 1st in an Aces uniform.

LEADERBOARD: The Aces have held a lead in 66-of-75 games played this season (88 percent).

WELCOME BACK: **INF Sean Burroughs** is batting .467 (7x15) in 3 games since being outrighted by the Diamondbacks.

AHEAD OF THE GAME: Tonight, Reno looks for its 45th victory of the 2011 season...last season, the Aces won their 45th game on 7/28...the 2009 club won its 45th game on 7/10...Reno needs just 3 more wins over its next 16 games to set a new franchise record for wins before the All-Star Break (2009, 46-45).

BIGGEST LITTLE NOTES IN THE WORLD: Today the Aces wish a happy birthday to team photographer **David Calvert**...the 1st 4 batters in the Aces lineup scored all 8 runs last night...7 of **C Konrad Schmidt's** last 9 hits have been doubles.

IT'S ALL MINE: Tossed a complete game on 7/1 last season vs. Las Vegas (at Cashman Field)...scattered 2 runs on 11 hits and just 1 walk... was his 6th-career complete game, lone complete game of the season and 1st at the Triple-A level...his clubs are 4-4 (.500) when he's on the mound vs. LVG.

HEAVY LIFTING: Threw 178.0 innings for Reno last season...led the Pacific Coast League and set a Diamondbacks Triple-A record...overall in 2010, recorded 183.0 IP—including 5.0 IP with Double-A Mobile...marked a new career-high for innings pitched in season (previously 180.0, 2009, Double-A Mobile)...made a team-high-tying 27 starts last season for the Aces (also, RHP Kevin Mulvey).

ON THE BOARD: In addition to leading the PCL in innings pitched, last season ranked 1st in hits allowed (224), at-bats against (716) and total batters faced (772)...ranked 5th in the league with 22 HR allowed.

SANDWICH ARTIST: Was selected by the Diamondbacks in the supplemental first round of the 2005 draft (31st overall) after leading the nation with a 1.14 ERA at the University of Massachusetts...OF Justin Upton was the 1st-overall selection in that draft...INF Tyler Greene was taken by St. Louis with the pick prior to Torra...RHP Chaz Roe was picked by Colorado immediately following.
