Wright, 22, makes his first start with the BlueClaws and 9th as a pro...Wright, drafted this year in the 8th round out of Ole Miss, opened his career with Williamsport, where he was 2-1, 3.38...He gave up one run in five innings against Vermont on Thursday in his last start and was added to the Lakewood roster on Monday...He has only allowed more than two runs in a start once, on 7/22 at Auburn...His longest outing is six innings, on 7/17 at State College...Wright spent two years at Chipola Junior College (where in 2009 he was a teammate of BlueClaws RHP David Buchanan, promoted to Clearwater on Monday)...Drafted in the 23rd round in 2008 by the Pirates and again in the 23rd round of the 2010 draft by the Red Sox before moving up to the 8th round this year...Originally from Schaumburg, Illinois.

Martin, who turns 22 on August 14th, makes his 26th appearance and 12th start of the year, second against Lakewood...Martin threw six shutout innings on one hit in the first game of the second half at FirstEnergy Park, matching zeros with Jesse Biddle and getting a no-decision...After pitching to a 5.36 ERA in the first half, he has a 3.93 ERA in the second half...He snapped a four-start winless streak last time in allowing two runs over six innings against Hagerstown on Thursday...Was drafted out of high school in 2008 by the Orioles in the 19th round but did not sign.

Last Game Recap... David Baker threw 6.1 scoreless innings as Delmarva blanked Lakewood 4-0 on Monday night in the first of their four-game series...Ty Kelly and Garabez Rosa each had two hits for the Shorebirds while Miguel Alvarez added two hits for Lakewood...Jesse Biddle started for the BlueClaws and gave up two runs over five innings and took the loss.

The Delmarva Series... The BlueClaws continue their four-game series with Delmarva tonight...Lakewood took three of four from Delmarva to open the second half and two of three at Perdue Stadium in early July...They will still play 11 more games against Delmarva in the second half and have taken 9 of 14 from the Shorebirds this year...Miguel Alvarez is 13-35 and Jim Murphy is 16-43 against Delmarva this year.

BlueClaws Transaction... 3B Maikel Franco has been transferred to Lakewood from Williamsport...Franco, who turns 19 on August 26th and is now the youngest BlueClaw (three weeks younger than Domingo Santana) was hitting .274 with 2 HRs and 28 RBIs with Williamsport...Franco was 19-56 (.339) since July 16th and hit .222 with the GCL Phillies after he signed as an amateur free agent last year (from Azua, Dominican Republic)...3B Steve Singleton, who was 8-43 with Lakewood after signing as a free agent from the Twins on July 21st, was sent to Reading.

One to Go... Jim Murphy homered on Friday and now with 21 home runs on the season, is just one away from tying the single-season franchise record set in 2001 by Juan Richardson...His total is the second highest in franchise history, breaking a tie with Ryan Howard, who hit 19 home runs in the 2002 season...Murphy has now hit 35 home runs as a BlueClaw (also the most in franchise history), including 14 in 2009...He is one off the league lead behind Asheville's Corey Dickerson.

Three Out... The BlueClaws are now games behind first place Hickory after losing last night and Hickory's come-from-behind 14-13 win over Hagerstown (in which they tied the game with three runs in the bottom of the ninth inning)...Hickory was the first half champion as well...Lakewood started the current road trip two games back.

Shooting Blanks... The BlueClaws were shutout on Monday for the seventh time this year and the second time in the second half...Both shutouts have come at the hands of Delmarva.

Buchanan Promoted... BlueClaws RHP David Buchanan, who leads the South Atlantic League in wins with 11, was promoted to Clearwater on Monday...He will make his Threshers debut on Tuesday night...Buchanan threw eight shutout innings in his last Lakewood start on Monday...He was a 7th round pick last year from Georgia State University...LHP Austin Wright joins Lakewood from Williamsport to take Buchanan's place...Wright will start today.

Close Calls... The BlueClaws are 22-17 in one-run games this year and have played the second most in the league, behind Greenville (19-21).

Bonus Baseball... The BlueClaws lead the league in extra-inning games, having played 13 (6-7)...They also led the league last year, having played 23 (13-10).

Team Speed... Anthony Hewitt stole his 28th base on Sunday and has a two SB lead on Zach Collier for the team lead...Hewitt has been caught just four times and is 3rd in the league, 16 behind Greenville's Felix Sanchez...Collier has been caught 12 times...Miguel Alvarez is also 12-15 in steals for the BlueClaws this year...As a team, Lakewood is 129-168 (.768).

Pitching Depth... When BlueClaws starting pitchers finish five innings, the team is 46-32 compared to 6-20 when the starter doesn't finish five innings...They are 30-16 when the starting pitcher finishes six innings.

The Duke... Ryan Duke, a 25th round pick of the Phillies this year from Oklahoma, where he is the all-time saves leader, picked up his fourth Lakewood save on Sunday at West Virginia...He threw seven shutout innings with Williamsport before joining the BlueClaws, where he has allowed two runs in 7.1 innings...Only Juan Sosa (10) has saved more games with Lakewood this year.

Colby Throwing Cheese... BlueClaws RHP Colby Shreve has not allowed an earned run in 17 innings in July...He threw three scoreless innings on Tuesday to earn the win against Augusta and three more on Saturday to beat West Virginia...He has allowed just seven earned runs in his last 40 innings pitched dating to May 20th...A 6th round pick in 2008, Shreve made his pro debut last year after having Tommy John Surgery and went 7-5, 3.95 with Lakewood...His brother Chasen pitches for Rome in the South Atlantic League.

From the Side... BlueClaws LHP Jay Johnson has allowed two earned runs in his last 27.1 innings...Johnson, a side-armed, earned his second save with two shutout innings against Augusta on July 24th and has given up just one earned run in 17.2 innings during the second half of the season...Johnson, from Canada, played at a junior college in Canada and Texas Tech University...He signed with the Phillies during spring training.

The Fourth Run... The BlueClaws are just 15-37 this year when they give up four runs but they are 39-14 when they score at least four runs.

Former BlueClaws Traded... Three 2010 BlueClaws were traded yesterday to the Astros (with a player to be named) for OF Hunter Pence...1B Jonathan Singleton, RHP Jarred Cosart, and RHP Josh Zeid were sent to Houston and all are expected to report to Double-A Corpus Christi...Singleton and Cosart were with Hi-A Clearwater and Zeid was with Double-A Reading...It's the third straight year the Phillies have made a deadline deal involving current or former BlueClaws...In 2009, the team sent then-BlueClaw Jason Knapp with former Claws Jason Donald, Carlos Carrasco and Lou Marson to Cleveland for Cliff Lee and last year they sent then-BlueClaw Jonathan Villar with former BlueClaws JA Happ and Anthony Gose to Houston for Roy Oswalt.

Leading the Way... 2010 BlueClaws pitcher Julio Rodriguez won all six of his starts in July and has 14 wins on the season, most in all of Minor League Baseball...Rodriguez has a decision in 20 of his 21 starts, all but the first one...Rodriguez went 5-1, 1.44 with Lakewood last year including 90 strikeouts in 56.1 innings.

Current Year Draft Picks... The BlueClaws have had current year draft picks in each of the last few seasons...2007: RHP Brian Schlitter (17th round), 2008: RHP Vance Worley (3rd) and RHP Mike Stutes (10th), 2009: LHP Matt Way (5th), 2010: RHP Eric Pettis (35th), 2011: RHP Ryan Duke (25th) and LHP Austin Wright (8th).

Next Starting Pitcher... RHP Garrett Claypool (3-7, 3.70) starts for Lakewood on Wednesday night, his fourth start against Delmarva...He has allowed one run in 19 innings against the Shorebirds...Last time out, Claypool gave up seven runs, six earned in 5.1 innings on Thursday at West Virginia...Claypool has lost four starts in a row and is winless in his last six starts...His last win was 6/25 against Delmarva at FirstEnergy Park...He was an 11th round pick in 2010 from UCLA.
