Castillo, 22, is scheduled to enter the game after the rehabing Joe Blanton...Castillo threw a 1-2-3 inning against Hickory on Tuesday and last started a game last Friday against Hickory, when he allowed one run over four innings...This is his 21st appearance and 3rd start...His other start was June 29th in Hagerstown and he lasted just .2 innings, allowing a walk, two hit batsman and two unearned runs...Castillo...He has allowed just seven runs in his last 33 innings, three of them on August 6th against West Virginia...Castillo was a hitter for three seasons with the Phillies (.237) but was converted to a pitcher prior to the 2010 season, which he split between three levels...He joined the BlueClaws on June 9th from extended spring training.

Ray, who turns 20 on October 1st, makes his 20th start for Hagerstown and comes of a 3.1 inning, seven run outing at Asheville on Saturday...For Ray, it was a career-high run total...He is 0-3, 4.20 in the second half after he went 2-0, 1.13 in the first half...Ray allowed one run in his first 30 innings with Hagerstown after joining the Suns on May 9th...He has allowed three earned runs in 17 innings against the BlueClaws this year... Ray had a commitment to the University of Arkansas before signing with the Nationals last year at the August 15th deadline for \$799,000.

Last Game Recap...The BlueClaws scored four times in the first inning and every starter had a hit in a 10-1 win over Hagerstown on Thursday night at Municipal Stadium...Garett Claypool threw six scoreless innings to win his fifth game of the year for Lakewood...Jeff Lanning added his fifth home run in his first game at first base.

Joe Blanton Rehab Today...Phillies RHP Joe Blanton, who has not pitched since May 15th with an elbow injury, will start tonight's game for Lakewood...This is Blanton's second rehab appearance with the BlueClaws, as he threw two perfect innings with Lakewood on April 20, 2010...Blanton was acquired by the Phillies at the trading deadline in 2008 and went 9-6, 4.82 with the Phillies last year...This year, he is 1-2, 5.60.

Winner Winner...With last night's win, the BlueClaws have clinched a winning record for the 11th half in the last 12...They had a winning record for 10 straight halves snapped in the first half this year, when they went 33-35...The BlueClaws have had a winning record in each of the last five seasons and will extend that to six with one win in their final four games.

BlueClaws Rehab Assignments...The BlueClaws are 6-0 this year when a Phillies player rehabs...1-0 with JC Romero, 2-0 with Shane Victorino and 3-0 with Brad Lidge...Lidge made three appearances in July with Lakewood, July 4th, 7th, and 20th...All-time, the BlueClaws are 21-10 with a Phillies player in the lineup, and this is the first time a Phillies player has rehabbed while the BlueClaws are on the road.

Getting a Chance...With Jim Murphy sidelined (hand), Jeff Lanning made his first career start at first base (he played one game at third base with Beloit-Twins, Midwest League in 2009) and went 3-5 with his fifth home run of the season on Thursday night...Entering this series, Murphy had played first base in all but four BlueClaws games this year.

Carlos Crushing...Since starting 2-15 with the BlueClaws, Carlos Alonso is 45-128 (.351) and is 7-13 in his last four games...Since July 20th, he is batting .352 with an OPS of .952...In that stretch, he has walked 25 times and struck out just 11, while driving in 21 runs...Alonso was a 35th round pick last year from the University of Delaware.

Could Be It...The BlueClaws have an elimination number of one, trailing Hickory by four games with five games to play...While Lakewood could tie the Crawdads by going 5-0 with Hickory going 1-4, the BlueClaws cannot break a tie with Hickory, having gone 1-7 against them this year, so the BlueClaws would be eliminated from post-season contention with one loss or one Hickory win...Hickory finishes with a five game series against Greenville, while Kannapolis finishes with five games against Greensboro, who has won six straight games to move ahead of Lakewood and into third place.

The Hagerstown Series...The BlueClaws continue a five-game series tonight in Hagerstown...Lakewood is 9-11 against the Suns this year, 4-4 in the second half, losing three of four between June 27th and 30th at Municipal Stadium and taking two of three in Lakewood from July 4-6...Zach Collier is hitting .367 (.22-60) against Hagerstown this year...Hagerstown's Blake Kelso is 22-67 (.328).

State of the Clubs...Hagerstown has lost eight straight games, including five straight in Asheville, and they gave up 21, 15, and 12 runs on three straight days (Saturday through Monday)...In those eight games, the Suns have combined to allow 81 runs...The BlueClaws have won two straight after dropping the first four games to Hickory...They won game two of the double-header on Tuesday and Thursday's game 10-1.

Roster Moves...BlueClaws 1B Jim Murphy has been placed on the disabled list (hand) and RHP Garett Claypool has been activated off the disabled list to start today...SS Edgar Duran was placed on the disabled list on Tuesday (broken finger) and IF Kenny Miramontes was transferred to Lakewood from Williamsport...Miramontes, who hit .226 with the Crosscutters, was signed as a non-drafted free agent from Faulkner University (AL).

Strike Three...Garett Claypool, who has 151 strikeouts after six Ks over six shutout innings on Thursday night, will likely lead the lead in strikeouts for the BlueClaws, becoming just the second BlueClaw to do so, following Matt Maloney (180) in 2006...Maloney, Josh Outman, and Carlos Carrasco went 1-2-3 in the Sally League in 2006 in helping the BlueClaws to their first championship.

The Wright Stuff...BlueClaws LHP Austin Wright has allowed just five runs in 30 innings with the BlueClaws and struck out a career high 10 over five shutout innings, on just two hits, on Tuesday against Hickory...Wright has fanned 8, 9, and 10 in three of his last four starts, and in the other start in there, he was cut short after three innings due to a one-hour rain delay...Wright was an 8th round pick this year from Ole Miss and spent two years at Chipola Junior College.

South of the Border...BlueClaws LHP Jesse Biddle finished his season with an ERA of 2.98, after he had an ERA of 7.16 in April...Biddle went 4-2, 1.91 in the second half, the best second-half in the South Atlantic League, and was the All-Star team left-handed pitcher.

Two All-Stars...BlueClaws Jesse Biddle (left-handed pitcher) and Jim Murphy (designated hitter) were named to the South Atlantic League post-season All-Star team on Monday...This marks the sixth straight year the BlueClaws have been represented on this team after not having a representative in their first five years of play (2001-2005)...The BlueClaws were represented by four last year (1B Jonathan Singleton, SS Jonathan Villar, C Sebastian Valle, and manager Mark Parent)...Hickory SS Jurickson Profar was named the league's MVP while Hagerstown's Bryce Harper was named the league's Most Outstanding Prospect...Voting was done by the league's coaches, managers, and broadcasters.

Since August 1st...The BlueClaws have the league's best team ERA since August 1st at 2.81 and have thrown two shutouts, both against Delmarva...They have allowed three runs or less in 16 of their 29 games in August/Sept (15-14) and have not allowed more than four runs since August 11th (18 straight games)...Austin Wright has allowed 5 ER in 30 IP...Hector Neris has allowed one run in 13 innings...Tyler Knigge has given up two earned runs in 19.2 innings and Ryan Duke has not allowed a run in 8 innings.

Dead-Heat...BlueClaws 1B Jim Murphy hit his 22nd home run of the year August 8th against West Virginia and tied Juan Richardson's single-season franchise record set in the team's inaugural season of 2001...Murphy has 36 home runs as a BlueClaw, the most in franchise history and a record he originally broke here in Greensboro on May 11th...Murphy has now hit 47 home runs as a pro...He has gone 60 at bats since his last home run and has one HR in his last 97 at bats dating to July 29th...Murphy's season ended when he was placed on the DL Thursday.

Good Friends and a Strong Bullpen...Since July 30th, the BlueClaws bullpen has allowed just 28 earned runs in 114 innings pitched, covering 27 games (2.21 ERA).

Running 'Claws...The BlueClaws are 5th in the league with 159 stolen bases this year...Anthony Hewitt (2nd in SAL) leads the team with 36 and has only been caught five times...Zach Collier is 32-45 and Miguel Alvarez is also 15-19 in steals for the BlueClaws this year...As a team, Lakewood is 159-208 (.764), best percentage in the league.

K Man...Since allowing runs in back to back outings on July 18th and 28th, Tyler Knigge has given up just two earned runs in 21.2 innings pitched covering nine outings and has 16 strikeouts over that stretch...He gave up one run in 4.1 innings against West Virginia on August 5th and earned the win with three shutout innings on August 17th against Delmarva...Knigge then threw three perfect innings against Greensboro on August 20th...He threw a scoreless inning for his fourth save (first since May 26th) on August 23rd at Delmarva and threw two shutout innings against Hickory on Monday.

Close Calls...The BlueClaws are 26-23 in one-run games this year and have played the most in the league, tied with both Greenville and Rome...The BlueClaws second in the league in extra-inning games having played 15 (6-9), trailing 7-9 Lexington...The BlueClaws also led the league last year, having played 23 (13-10).

Current Year Draft Picks...The BlueClaws have had current year draft picks in each of the last few seasons...2007: RHP Brian Schlitter (17th round), 2008: RHP Vance Worley (3rd) and RHP Mike Stutes (10th), 2009: LHP Matt Way (5th), 2010: RHP Eric Pettis (35th), 2011: RHP Ryan Duke (25th), LHP Austin Wright (8th), Drew Hillman (18th).

Tomorrow's Pitcher...RHP Lisalberto Bonilla (4-5, 2.94) starts for Lakewood on Saturday against Hagerstown...Bonilla gave up three runs on seven hits in 5.2 innings in his last start, against Hickory on Monday in game one of a double-header...He allowed just one run over six and seven innings in his two previous starts, both against Delmarva...Bonilla joined the BlueClaws on May 3rd from extended spring training and allowed three runs in 25 innings as a reliever before being moved into the rotation...He was one of five BlueClaws All-Stars this year.
