LAST NIGHT...

Scott Munter and Ronnie Ray combined to open the game with five perfect innings, as the Grizzlies pitching staff shut down Reno in a 4-1 victory to wrap up the series Thursday night ... Fresno earned not just a split of the series, but also a season split of the 16-game slate with the playoff-bound Aces ... the two teams have also split the all-time series 24-24 ... with the victory, Fresno remains in fourth place in the PCL South Division, holding at 23.0 games back of first-place Sacramento, which won its seventh straight game, a 7-1 home victory over second-place Las Vegas ... the 51s fall a full 17.0 games back of the River Cats, also falling back within 6.0 games ahead of Fresno ... with Tucson's 7-3 loss at Tacoma, the Padres fall within 1.0 game of the Grizzlies in third place, now 22.0 games behind Sacramento.

MY MAN J.C.

Justin Christian went 2-for-4 with a home run, two runs scored, an RBI and a stolen base ... the outfielder is batting at a .333 clip for the season with Fresno, coupled with a .423 on-base percentage ... those numbers get even better with runners in scoring position, where he is batting .422 (19-for-45) ... Christian has also stolen 34 bases in 37 attempts despite playing in just 60 games for Fresno this season, and now ranks fourth in the Pacific Coast League in steals.

GREAT SCOTT

Scott Munter came through with a huge spot start, retiring all nine batters he faced over 3.0 perfect innings of work, striking out four ... after posting a 7.04 ERA (36 ER/46.0 IP) in 37 appearances with Tucson, Munter has been vastly better as a Grizzly, going 1-0 with a 1.80 mark (3 ER/15.0 IP), striking out 18 over that span.

STAY PUFT, E-GON

Edgar Gonzalez went 1-for-4 with two RBI, extending his career-high RBI mark to 80 ... Gonzalez has been the most consistently productive offensive force for the Grizzlies this season, batting .327 or better in every month except May ... he is batting .343 since June 1, and his 114 hits since that point are the most in the Pacific Coast League.

MAKING IT RAIN

The Grizzlies and Rainiers wrap up their season series—and the entire 2011 season—beginning tonight at Cheney Stadium ... Fresno dropped three-of-four in their other visit this year, and is 82-107 all-time against the Rainiers.

MEN OF STEAL

The Grizzlies pulled off a pair of double steals last night, as they have already smashed their single-season franchise steals record, which now sits at 199 ... Fresno surpassed the previous mark of 145 on July 23, set in just the second year of the franchise's existence back in 1999 ... the Grizzlies hold a 47 steal advantage over the next closest team in the league this season (Omaha, 148) ... if they can reach 200 steals for the season, the Grizzlies will be the first PCL team in 23 years to do so (Tucson, 1988 - 202).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER

The Grizzlies bullpen allowed a single earned run over 6.0 innings of work last night, as Ronnie Ray earned the victory ... Dan Otero tossed a single scoreless frame for the second straight night to earn his 11th save ... Fresno relievers have combined to yield just five earned runs over the team's last 12 games, a span of 36.1 IP (1.24 ERA).

CON-AIR

Conor Gillaspie reached base three times in his final game with the Grizzlies this year, going 2-for-3 with a walk, a home run, a run scored, an RBI and a stolen base ... the infielder finished his 124-game Triple-A season with a .297/.389/.453 slash line, contributing 22 doubles, 11 home runs, nine stolen bases and 33 multi-hit games.

GETTING THE CALL

Four more Grizzlies joined the San Francisco Giants today, as infielders Emmanuel Burriss, Brandon Crawford and Conor Gillaspie, as well as right-handed pitcher Waldis Joaquin were all recalled ... outfielder Darren Ford, who began the year in Fresno, was also recalled from Double-A Richmond.
