**'DOGS GET IT DONE LATE:** **Mark Wagner** clubbed a two-out, RBI double in the seventh inning, snapping a 5-5 tie and giving Portland a 6-5 win over the Fisher Cats in the series opener...**Mitch Dening** highlighted a four-run second inning with a three-run shot off **Chad Jenkins**...**Ronald Bermudez** added an RBI triple and **Jeff Howell** drove in the first run with a single...**Kyle Fernandes** earned the win, allowing 3 hits, 3 runs (one earned) over 1.2 IP...**Blake Maxwell** worked two perfect innings for his 15<sup>th</sup> save of the season.

**MAXWELL NEARS MILESTONE:** Maxwell has compiled 597.1 career innings as a professional and 213.1 with Portland...The righty has converted three straight save opportunities and 14 in his Double-A career.

**NEW MEMBER ENSHRINED:** The Portland Sea Dogs in conjunction with Unum named **Josh Beckett** the 2011 inductee into the Unum/Portland Sea Dogs Hall of Fame...The announcement was made prior to last night's game.

**HOW ACQUIRED:** 47<sup>th</sup> Round pick by the Red Sox in the 2008 draft.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Earned his 3<sup>rd</sup> win of the season, defeating the Harrisburg Senators on August 29<sup>th</sup> at Metro Bank Park...Kehrt worked 5.1 innings on 6 hits, 2 runs.

**FACING NEW HAMPSHIRE:** Makes his second appearance of the year against, is 0-0, 4.50 ERA (ER/2 IP) in one relief outing.

**QUICK HITS:** 0-0, 5.93 ERA (9 ER/13.2 IP) in April (5 games/1 save)...0-0, 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19 IP) in May (6 games/1 start)...1-0, 6.00 ERA (12 ER/25 IP) in June (5 games/1 start)...**Went 1-0, 3.45 ERA (6 ER/15.2 IP) in 7 \*games/2 starts with Pawtucket from July 3-30...**2-1, 3.68 ERA (9 ER/22 IP) in August (5 games/3 starts).
