Ogden Raptors (2-2, 43-37) vs. Great Falls Voyagers (3-1, 43-34)

Pioneer League Championship Series Game 2 (Great Falls Leads 1-0)



The Game

The Ogden Raptors (Los Angeles Dodgers) play the second game of a best-of-three series with the Great Falls Voyagers (Chicago White Sox). Ogden won the first half of the Southern Division with a 22-16 record and Great Falls won the second half of the Northern Division with a 24-14 record. Ogden defeated Orem two games to one, and Great Falls defeated Missoula two games to one to advance to the Championship. Great Falls won the season series 4-3.

The Raptors

Ogden will send Derek Cone to the mound Thursday. The right-hander received a no decision in Game 1 against Orem in the Divisional Round. The Mesa Community College product pitched 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on six hits, striking out five. The Raptors stole 121 bases this season, 32 more than any other team. The Raptors are playing in the Championship Round for the second straight year. Ogden hasn't won the Pioneer League since winning four straight titles 1966-69.

The Voyagers

Orem will give the ball to Blair Walters. The lefty was named the Pioneer League Pitcher of the Year this season. The former Hawai'i Warrior was fourth with a 4.03 ERA and led the league with nine wins. The 11th-round pick was third with a 1.21 WHIP and fifth among starters holding hitters to a .272 batting average. In his Game 1 win over Missoula in the Divisional Round, the 6-0, 200-pounder pitched 5.2 shutout innings and allowed just one hit, striking out seven and walking four. The Voyagers had the best team ERA in the league at 4.45. The Voyagers are making their first appearance in the Championship Round since winning the Pioneer League in 2008 against Orem.

Last Time Out

The Raptors lost to the Voyagers in Game 1 9-7. The Raptors had 15 hits but only one went for extra bases, an eighth inning double by Scott Wingo. The Voyagers, however, hit four home runs, two by Martin Medina, and scored in six different innings. Starter Ryan O'Sullivan gave up seven hits and five runs in the first three innings. Then, Juan Noriega allowed a home run and two runs. Jason West and Yimi Garcia finished the game with two innings each and gave up a run while striking out three. Noel Cuevas went 4-for-5 and Scott Schebler had three hits, but neither drove in a run. Joc Pederson and O'Koyea Dickson had two singles and an RBI each, and catcher Chris O'Brien drove in three in the loss.

Familiar Faces

The Raptors return two players from last year. Pitchers Gustavo Gomez and Derek Cone pitched for the Raptors last season.

Players of the Week

Each week, the Pioneer League names a pitcher and player of the week. James Baldwin III was named Player of the Week for the first week of the season. Baldwin hit three home runs and drove in 12 RBI. He also led the league in stolen bases with five and hit .433 for the week.

Pioneer League All-Stars

The Pioneer League announced the Ogden Raptors had one player named to the All-Star team in 2011. Outfielder Joc Pederson was the lone Raptor named to the All-Star Team. At the time of the announcement, Pederson was fifth with a .341 batting average. The Palo Alto, Calif. native hit 10 home runs and drove in 56 runs. The former 11th-round pick also stole 21 bases.

The Raptors also had three All-Star Honorable Mentions. Outfielder Scott Schebler hit .278 with nine home runs and 47 RBIs. First baseman O'Koyea Dickson hit .339 with 10 home runs and 32 RBIs. Lastly, pitcher Yimi Garcia was 4-2 with a 3.28 ERA. The right-hander struck out 65 batters in 49.1 innings. Pederson and Dickson also got voters for Most Valuable Player but did not win.

Playoff Format

The season is split into two halves, with 38 games in the each half. The first half ends Monday July 30 in Idaho Falls. The division leader of the first half gets a bid into the playoffs and hosts Games 2 and 3 (if necessary) of the first round of the playoffs. Teams from the same division play a best-of-three series in the first round starting on Sept. 9. The championship round will also be best-of-three and will start on Sept. 13.

Manager Damon Berryhill

Damon Berryhill is in his third season as the field manager of the Raptors. Berryhill led the Raptors to their first appearance in the Pioneer League Championship since 1996 last season by winning both halves and a 44-31 overall record. Berryhill managed the Texas Rangers' Single-A Bakersfield club before coming to Ogden and served as the Rangers' catching coordinator for three seasons. He has also coached in the Diamondbacks' and Angels' systems. The Laguna Beach, Calif. native enjoyed a 10-year Major League career with the Cubs, Braves, Red Sox, Reds and Giants. The former catcher appeared in three playoffs, 1992-93 Braves and 1997 Giants.

Pitching Coach Bill Simas

Bill Simas begins his affiliated coaching career in Ogden. Simas played six seasons in the Major Leagues with the Chicago White Sox from 1995-2001. Simas spent the 2003 season in the Dodgers' system, posting a 4-0 record between Triple-A Albuquerque and the GCL Dodgers. Simas replaces Kremlin Martinez, who is now the pitching coach for the Great Lakes Loons.

Hitting Coach Jay Washington

Jay Washington returns to the Raptors for his third season as the hitting coach. "J-Wash" led Ogden to a league-best .298 batting average and 494 runs. Washington was a shortstop in the Texas Rangers' system from 2003-07. The Los Angeles native also spent time playing in the independent South Coast, Northern and Frontier Leagues. In 2009, Washington was signed by the Dodgers but was released in June of that year and started his coaching career in Ogden.
