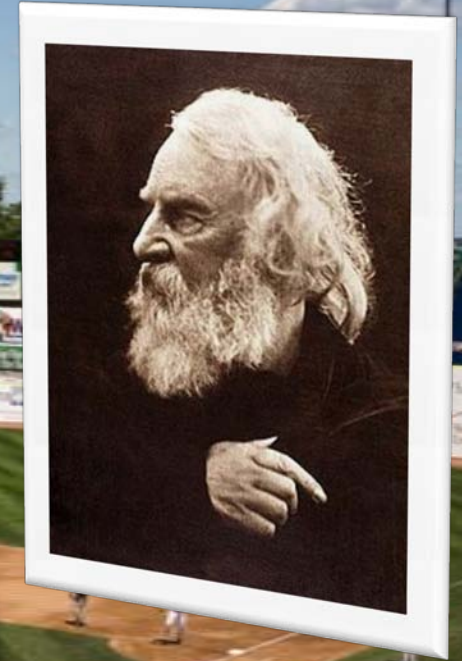
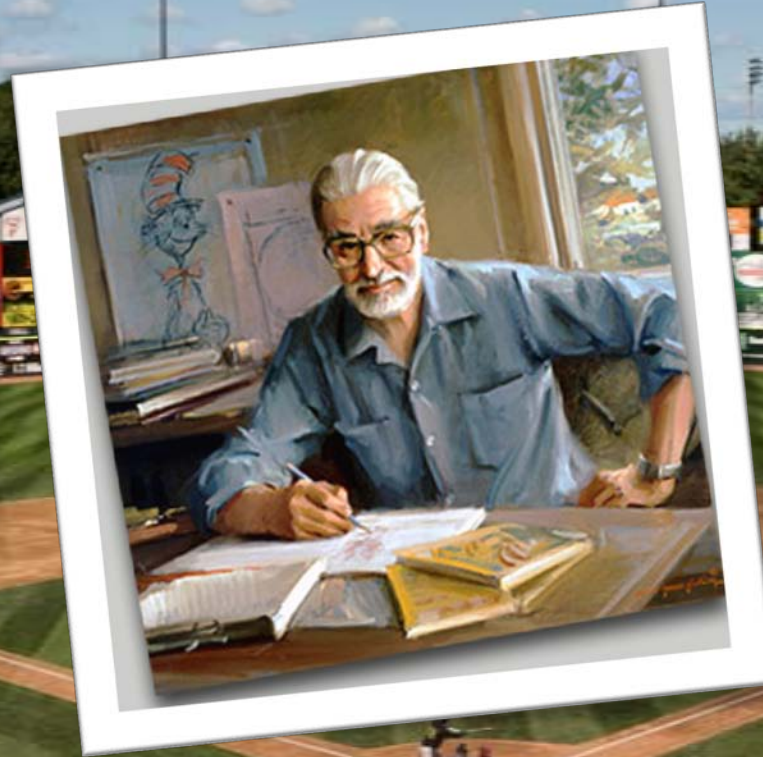
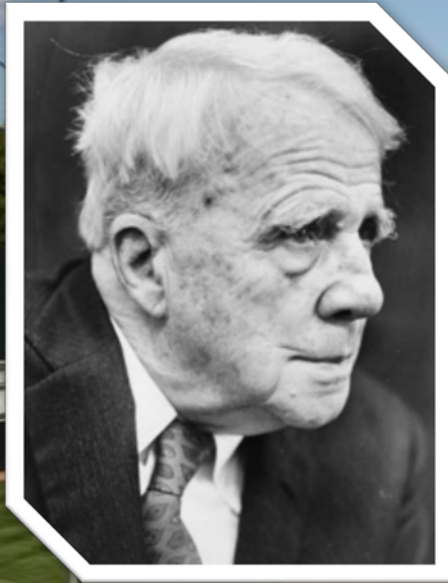


# *The Portland Sea Dogs* First Annual Poetry Contest



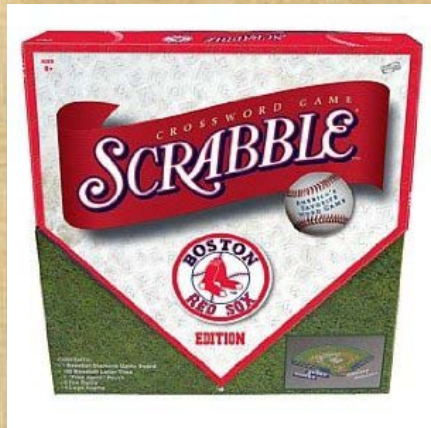


# *The Contest*



- Students will be asked to write a poem, choosing one of two topics:
  - “Your Favorite Summer Memory”
  - “Your Favorite Ballpark Food”
- Poems will be submitted directly to the Portland Sea Dogs between February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012 and April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2012.
- Each student submitting a poem will be given one General Admission Ticket to the game on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012 at 6pm.
- All participating students are encouraged to attend that game and participate in a pre-game parade around the warning track of Hadlock Field.
- In addition to prizes, the First, Second and Third place winners chosen by the Sea Dogs Poetry Committee will receive the chance to read their poems before the crowd on May 1<sup>st</sup> *and* throw out a first pitch before that game.
- In addition to the top three poems, there will be honorable mentions for each grades represented, six through twelve.
