### Home Cookin'...

With a 4-2 victory in Tuesday's series opener with the BayBears, the Stars improved to 21-15 at Joe Davis Stadium this season. In comparison, the Stars are currently 17-23 away from Huntsville this season.

### Saving Sanchez...

By recording the last four outs of Tuesday's game, Stars RHP Jesus Sanchez notched his 10<sup>th</sup> save of the season. In his last four appearances, Sanchez has four saves. In addition to his save total, the 24-year-old former catcher is 3-2 with a 1.22 ERA this season in 31 appearances (leads the Stars).

### By The Numbers...

As a team, the Stars are tied with the Jackson Generals for the Southern League lead in batting average (.264). Individually, Stars second baseman **Scotter Gennett** leads the league in hits (89) and is tied for the lead in games played (76) while first baseman **Hunter Morris** is top three in the league in doubles (25, 1<sup>st</sup>), extra-base hits (36, 1<sup>st</sup>), total hits (80, 2<sup>nd</sup>), RBIs (53, 2<sup>nd</sup>) and total bases (136, 2<sup>nd</sup>).

### Payback Is A...

After being swept in a five-game series by Mobile down at Hank Aaron Stadium earlier this month, the Stars first attempt at payback was successful with a 4-2 victory against the BayBears on Tuesday. The series in Mobile featured two postponed games, two double-headers, and not one regulation nine-inning game.

### Who's Hot...

With a 3-for-3 night at the plate on Tuesday, **OF Lee Haydel** is now hitting .429 (6-for-14) over his last five games. The only player hotter at the plate is **OF Scott Krieger**, who is hitting .500 (7-for-14) over his last five. As a team, the Stars are hitting .274 over their last 10 games.

### Who's Not...

Since coming to the Stars from Triple-A Nashville, INF **Hainley Statia** is 2-for-14 at the plate in his first three games. Both INF **Juan Sanchez** (2-for-14) and C **Adam Weisenburger** (3-for-18) are hitting under .200 over their last 10 games.

### Roster Moves...

On Tuesday, the Stars place RHP **Santo Manzanillo** on the disabled list (retroactive to 6/23). This is Manzanillo's second stint this season on the DL. In a corresponding move, LHP **Philippe Valiquette** was transferred from High-A Brevard County to Huntsville. Additionally, OF **Brock Kjeldgaard** was taken off the disabled list and transferred to High-A Brevard County.

### **The BayBears...**

The Mobile BayBears have been the Double-A Affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks since 2007. Before that, they were the San Diego Padres Double-A affiliate from 1997-2006. The BayBears are the reigning Southern League Champions, beating the Tennessee Smokies in four games in the SL Championship. The Stars are 1-5 against Mobile this season.

### **Stars playing their 28<sup>th</sup> season...**

The Stars are playing their 28<sup>th</sup> season in the Southern League (14<sup>th</sup> as a Brewers affiliate). Before becoming part of the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1999, the Stars were the Double-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics for 14 seasons. Prior to the start of the 2012 season, the Stars have won three Southern League Championships ('85, '94, '01).

### **First Half In Review....**

With a 35-35 record, the Stars finished off the first half of the Southern League season tied for second place in the North division with the Tennessee Smokies. Behind the Jackson Generals for the majority of the first half, the Stars had at least a share of the divisional lead for just three days (May 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup>) over that span. Overall, the Stars lead the entire Southern League in hitting with a .264 batting average. Individually, second baseman **Scooter Gennett** led the league in hits (83) and games played (70), first baseman **Hunter Morris** led the SL in doubles (23), pitcher **Tyler Thornburg** was tied for the league lead in wins (8), and center fielder **Josh Prince** was tied for the league lead in stolen bases with (23). The Stars longest winning streak of 2012 has been six games so far while their longest losing streak has been nine games.

### **Burning Burgos...**

Since being promoted from High-A Brevard County last month, Stars P **Hiram Burgos** has taken the Southern League by storm. In eight starts, Burgos is 2-1 with a 2.42 ERA. Over his last five games, Burgos has given up just three earned runs in 31 innings pitched. At one point, the 24-year-old had not given up an earned run in 17 straight innings.

### **Back To The Future...**

On Thursday, Stars 2B **Scooter Gennett** was selected to participate in the 2012 Futures Game during the MLB All-Star Weekend at Kaufmann Stadium in Kansas City. The 6<sup>th</sup> ranked prospect in the Brewers minor league system has started all 73 games for the Stars. Overall, Gennett is hitting .295 with 3 HR and 26 RBI and leads the SL in hits (89) so far this season.

### **Prospect Lists...**

As the 26<sup>th</sup> ranked Minor League system according to MLB.com, the Stars currently have three of the Brewers top-10 prospects on their roster, and seven players that fall into the top 20. With the departure of fourth-ranked prospect Tyler Thornburg, 2B **Scooter Gennett** tops the list (6<sup>th</sup>), followed by OF **Kentrail Davis** (9<sup>th</sup>), 1B **Hunter Morris** (10<sup>th</sup>), OF **Khris Davis** (13<sup>th</sup>), RHP **Cody Scarpetta** (17<sup>th</sup>), and rounding out the list is RHP **Santo Manzanillo** (18<sup>th</sup>). RHP **Jimmy Nelson**, who was recently added to the Stars roster, ranks eighth on the list.

### **New Sheriff In Town...**

The 2012 season will be the first for **Darnell Coles** as the Huntsville Stars manager. Coles, in addition to a 14-year big league playing career with 10 teams, has been coaching for the past five seasons. The 50-year old has been a hitting instructor for the Washington Nationals, hitting coach for the Syracuse Chiefs (Triple-A Affiliate of the Washington Nationals), and has been the manager for both the Vermont Lake Monsters (Short-Season A Affiliate for the Oakland Athletics) and the Hagerstown Suns (Single-A Affiliate of the Washington Nationals). Most recently, he was the minor league hitting coordinator for the Milwaukee Brewers. Coles was also an analyst for ESPN from 2001-2006.

### **One-Run Games...**

While the Stars finished the 2011 season under .500, they performed very well in close games, finishing with a 23-19 record (.548) in games decided by one run. So far, Huntsville is 17-12 in one-run games, good for second best in the Southern League behind Mobile.

### **Huntsville's Hometown Kid...**

Local Grissom area high school product and Stars 1B **Hunter Morris** has been absolutely tearing the cover off the ball during the 2012 season. Overall, the Huntsville native is hitting .289 with 9 HR and 53 RBI. Morris also leads the Southern League with 25 doubles and has scored 35 runs. Morris had also previously started the first 35 games of the season before missing three games with a hand contusion, but has started every game since. Morris leads the Southern League in RBI's in the month of June with 23.

### **Farm It Out...**

There are ten players currently on the Brewers 25-man roster that spent time in Huntsville. That list includes John Axford (2009), Tim Lillard (2006), Yovanni Gallardo (2006), Manny Parra (2004-07), Taylor Green (2009-11), Rickie Weeks (2004), Ryan Braun (2006), Corey Hart (2002-2003) and the newly added Martin Maldonado (2008, '10-11) and Michael Fiers (2010-11).

### **Last Time Out...**

**HUNTSVILLE, Ala.** – After being swept in a five-game series by the Mobile BayBears down at Hank Aaron Stadium two weeks ago, the Huntsville Stars beat the first half Southern League South champs by a score of 4-2 on Tuesday night at Joe Davis Stadium.

With both teams being held scoreless through the first three innings, the BayBears got the scoring started in the fourth inning. Right

fielder Mark Krauss and second baseman David Nick led off the inning with singles against Stars starter Josh Stinson. A throwing error by Stars third baseman **Hainley Statia** scored Krauss to make the score 1-0. Later in the inning, another error by Statia on a groundball by left fielder Dan Kaczowski plated Nick to give Mobile a 2-0 lead. Unlike during their past series in Mobile, the Stars were able to return the favor in the fifth inning. To begin the rally, left fielder **Lee Haydel** singled and center fielder **Josh Prince** walked against BayBears starter Gaby Hernandez. With both runners in scoring position after a sacrifice bunt, a wild pitch from Hernandez allowed Haydel to score to cut the Stars deficit in half. The same at-bat, first baseman **Hunter Morris** crushed a two-run home run over the right field wall to give Huntsville a 3-2 lead. That would be all the run support the Stars pitching staff needed. Josh Stinson improved to 8-4 on the season after giving up those two runs (one earned) on five hits in six innings of work. After Stinson's exit, Stars RHP **Darren Byrd** and LHP **Mitch Stetter** followed with a combined 1.2 innings of scoreless relief. To end the game, RHP **Jesus Sanchez** notched down his 10<sup>th</sup> save of the year by recording the final four outs. From an offensive perspective, the Stars got their final run in the seventh inning on a RBI single by Morris. Overall, the Huntsville native was 2-for-4 with 3 RBIs on the night. His home run in the fifth inning was his second round-tripper in as many games and team-leading ninth on the season. Huntsville also got three hits from Haydel and two hits from shortstop **Domnit Bolivar**. Huntsville will continue a five-game series with Mobile with game two on Wednesday. The Stars will send RHP **Evan Anundsen** (4-3, 3.61 ERA) to the mound to square off against BayBears RHP Chase Anderson (2-1, 2.47 ERA). First pitch is at 6:43 PM.
