River Cats: RHP Bruce Billings (7-6, 4.03 ERA) • Sky Sox: RHP Rob Scahill (9-11, 5.98 ERA)

Last Night: Each River Cats starting position player reached base at least once, but the team lost to the Sky Sox, 14-6...Colorado Springs used two six-run innings to do most of their damage...RHP **Dan Straily** gave up six earned in 2.2 innings with eight hits and two strikeouts...RHP **Justin Souza** gave up the rest of the Sky Sox runs, allowing eight runs, seven earned, and eight hits in 1.1 innings...INF **Brandon Inge**, OF **Michael Taylor** and OF **Grant Green** each had two hits...INF **Jemile Weeks** and INF **Kila Ka'ahue** each had two RBIs...Weeks recorded Sacramento's only extra-base hit with his seventh-inning double.

Tonight's Starting Pitcher: River Cats RHP **Bruce Billings** will take the mound tonight...has 114 strikeouts and 38 walks in 127.1 innings with Sacramento spanning 24 starts...is allowing lefties to hit .249 and righties to hit .244...is 2-1 with a 5.21 ERA in eight road starts...ranks eighth in the PCL with a 4.03 ERA, second with a 1.23 WHIP and fourth with a .246 batting average against...has made two starts against the Sky Sox this season...is 1-1 with a 3.75 ERA, 13 strikeouts and one walk in 12.0 innings in those two starts...will be making his first start of the season in Colorado Springs...went 6-2 with a 4.47 ERA in 29 relief appearances and two saves with the Sky Sox last season.

Double Trouble: The River Cats gave up double-digit runs for the 14th time this season last night...Sacramento gave up 14 runs to the Sky Sox on 18 hits...the River Cats gave up seven doubles and two triples...the two triples are tied for a season-high for the River Cats pitching staff...the River Cats have scored double-digit runs 24 times this season...Sacramento is 1-13 when allowing their opponent to score 10 or more runs, and 22-2 when scoring 10 or more runs.

Jemile a Minute: River Cat INF **Jemile Weeks** he has a hit in every game since joining Sacramento...prior to last night's 1-for-4 performance, he had multiple hits in each game with the Cats...is 10-for-21 (.476) with three doubles, seven RBIs and five walks.

Personnel Matters: The River Cats have added **C Blake Lalli** and deleted **C Ryan Lipkin** from their roster...Lalli was acquired via trade from the Chicago Cubs for C Anthony Recker, who was designated for assignment on 8/20...Lalli was hitting .259 for the PCL's Iowa Cubs prior to the deal...had seven home runs and 40 RBIs in 301 at-bats...played in six games with the Chicago Cubs this year, hitting .133 with two RBIs in 15 at-bats...Lipkin was transferred to Single-A Stockton...did not record a hit in four games with Sacramento, spanning 11 at-bats...he had one RBI, one walk and one strikeout.

History Lesson: The River Cats magic number to clinch their sixth-straight division title remains at one...should Sacramento clinch tonight, it would become the first franchise in PCL history to have the best record in its division for more than five consecutive seasons...Albuquerque had the best record in the PCL Southern Division for five-straight seasons from 1987-1991...at that time, the PCL honored "half-season" champions...Albuquerque won at least one "half-season" division championship four-straight seasons from 1987-90, but did not claim either half in 1991, despite having the best overall record in the division...there have been numerous teams to win three-straight "true" division titles in the history of the PCL...the first team to win three-straight division titles was the Seattle Rainiers (1939-41), despite all eight PCL clubs playing in one division...Sacramento became the first team to win four-straight division titles with their Southern Division crown in 2010...since going to the four-division format in 1998, Nashville (2005-07) and Salt Lake (2006-08) are the only clubs other than Sacramento to win even three-straight division championships...the 2012 Southern Division title would be Sacramento's 11th in its 13-season history since moving to Sacramento in 2000.
