SNAPPER SNIPPETS

ROAD RECAP: Beloit traveled to Wisconsin & Burlington over the last week with the final off-day of the First Half in between stops. The Snappers took 2-of-3 in Appleton while the Bees defended their hive with 2 wins over the Snappers in 3 games.

HOME COOKIN': The Snappers are looking to open up with another home win on Friday night. They are 3-6 overall in the opening game of home series, but have won their last 2 series openers at Pohlman Field. The Snappers have won 7 of their last 9 games at home with 7 home games left in the First Half.

FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS: Tonight's contest with Quad Cities is the first weekend home game since the first weekend in May. The Snappers have won their last 4 Friday games, all on the road.

NAIL BITERS: After 3 more one-run games in Burlington, the Snappers have played in 22 one-run ball-games this season. That total is the most in the Midwest League while West Michigan is the only team with more one-run wins (14). Beloit's 22 one-run games are the 6th-highest total across all of A-ball with High-A Tampa (Florida State League) leading the pack with 26 games decided by one run.

TAKE 5: Beloit has scored 5 runs or more in a game 27 times this season & are 23-4 when they reach that plateau. Both the Snappers & their opponent have reached that total in 12 games with Beloit holding an 8-4 mark when that happens. Additionally, Beloit has a 12-1 record when they hit more than one homer.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: The Midwest League revealed the rosters for the 2017 All-Star Game on Wednesday. The Snappers will send 3 representatives to Midland, MI in with INF **Nate Mondou** making his 2nd career all-star game as the West's starting second basemen. LHP **Dalton Sawyer** & OF **Luke Persico** are also off to the Dow Diamond on June 20 to play in the 53rd Midwest League All-Star Game.

TODAY'S PITCHERS: For the first time this year, **Matt Milburn** & **Seth Martinez** will team up as the piggy-back tandem. Milburn last worked in relief when the Snappers game on June 3 was suspended after 3 innings of play in Appleton. He worked 5 frames when the game continued & struck out 6. The last
