FAQ'S

- **What time should I get there?**

Scouts will begin lining up for the parade at 6:15 pm. Any troop or pack member that would like to participate in the parade will need to be here before 6:15 pm.

- **Where will I pick up our tickets?**

Tickets will be available for pickup at our exclusive Scout Ticket Pick-Up Table conveniently located just outside the front gate. All materials (tickets, meal vouchers, patches) will be enclosed in your envelope.

- **Where are our seats located?**

Reserved seats will be green chair-backs located in the main grandstand between 1st & 3rd base. These seats are covered by the overhang and have a protective netting in front of them.

- **Who can participate in the parade?**

Any member in any capacity affiliated with the Boy Scouts of America and in Class A uniform (Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Scout Leaders). All troops & packs are encouraged to bring their troop/pack flags and patrol flags.

- **What should the Scouts wear for the parade?**

Scouts should wear their Class A Uniform for the parade to showcase the wide range of packs & troops in the local area. After the conclusion of the parade, many scouts will change into regular clothes so they don't get their uniform dirty.

- **How does the camping work?**

All camping gear should be left in your vehicle until the conclusion of the game. We will have fireworks approximately 15 minutes after the last pitch. Campers will leave the stadium and re-enter through the main gates with their camping gear but be advised that admission onto the field will be after clearance from the head groundskeeper. The Down East Wood Ducks recommend moving all vehicles to the parking lot closest to the ticket booth and visiting the 1st base concession stand that will be open for approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of the fireworks for snacks & drinks. Admittance onto the field is through either the 1st or 3rd base gate. Tents are allowed on the field, but can not be staked down. **Tent Stakes CAN NOT be used.** Also no fires of any kind are permitted on the field (campfire, fireworks, sparklers). The movie will start approximately 30 minutes following admission onto the field. The field lights will go out at the start of the movie.

- **Will someone on staff be on site for the campout?**

A Wood Ducks Staff Member will be on site for the entire night for any problems that may arise. You will be provided with their cell phone number upon arrival.

- **What happens in the event of rain?**

We do everything possible to try to play games as they are scheduled. If bad weather is forecasted for the game, keep up with the status of the game on our social media pages (@gowoodducks) and at woodducksbaseball.com.
