HENRY'S TURN ON SATURDAY: The Portland Sea Dogs had their four-game winning streak snapped on Friday night, but have won 12 of their last 18 games...LHP **Henry Owens**, who made his Double-A debut in Bowie back in 2013, takes the mound for the 'Dogs....Portland swept a three-game set from Richmond to start the trip, and is 9-5 during a 19-game stretch against the Western Division...*The Sea Dogs have hit a league-high 54 homers since July 1st.*

THIS ONE CALLED EARLY: RF **Jeremy Barfield** hit a two-run homer in the first inning, but Bowie scored four unanswered runs, and grabbed the series opener, 4-2 in a rain-shortened, five-inning contest...RHP **Yefry Ramirez** (12-3) went the distance, allowing six hits, two runs, no walks and fanned six....CF **Austin Hays** went 3-for-3 with a game-winning, two-run homer in the third...1B **Aderlin Rodriguez** hit a solo-homer in the fifth off losing pitcher **Trey Ball** (5-10)

WHERE HE RANKS: Nashville's **Renato Nunez** and Reno's **Christian Walker** (Reno) leads the minors with 30 homers...Portland's **Michael Chavis** has 29 homers between Portland and High-A Salem...Barfield has 30 homers between Portland and the Sugar Land Skeeters (Atlantic League).

JOINING THE 20-CLUB: Barfield is the first Sea Dog to reach 21 homers since **Jeremy Owens** hit 21 in 2003, the most as a Red Sox affiliate...**Chris Norton** holds the All-Time mark, hitting 38 in 1999...Portland has 111 homers as a team, the 2011 team has the most homers (129) as a Red Sox affiliate...The 1997 Sea Dogs hit a franchise record 191 homers.

TOP 5 IN THE PARK: Bowie's **Garabez Rosa** leads the Eastern League in hitting at .319 (145-for-454)...**Danny Mars** leads Portland with a .311 average, tied for the fourth best mark in the league...Mars and Rosa did not play last night...Bowie leads the league in hitting at .289, Portland is second at .268.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland and Bowie play two series this season, totaling six games...The Sea Dogs are 8-12-3 all-time in season series against the Baysox...Portland has not won a season-series from the Baysox since 2010, winning four of six games.

WHAT A START: LHP **Bobby Poyner** worked a scoreless ninth on Wednesday and has not allowed an earned run in 18 of 20 appearances with Portland...The lefty has retired 23 of the last 24 batters faced.

SEASON-HIGH FOR DANNY: Mars extended his hitting streak to a season-high 12 straight games, going 1-for-5 on Thursday in Richmond...The first-year Sea Dog is hitting .385 (20-for-52) during the streak.

CATCHING ON: C **Jordan Procyshen** has three of his four homers since July 20th and hitting .261 (6-for-23), 2 HR, 2 RBI in August.

ON FIRE: RHP **Jake Cosart** has posted a 1.22 ERA (2 ER/14.2 IP) since July 1st, covering 10 appearances...Cosart is scoreless in nine of his last 11 outings.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP **Kevin McAvoy** took a no-hitter into the eighth inning in the roadtrip opener at Richmond, and worked eight scoreless on two hits, earning the win...McAvoy is 4-1 in his last 5 starts.

2017 SEASON: Went 2-0, 1.66 ERA in 4 starts in April...Was 3-0 in his first 5 starts of the season...Fanned a season-high 10 batters on April 14th vs. Lehigh Valley...Overall between Portland and Pawtucket: 5-8, 4.29 ERA (47 ER/98.2 IP), 82 H, 94 BB, 100 SO

FACING BOWIE: 1-0, 3.60 ERA in 3 career starts against the Baysox.

DID YOU KNOW: Went 14-4, 2.60 ERA (35 ER/121.0 IP) in 20 starts with Portland in 2014 and named Eastern League Pitcher of the Year...Named to Baseball America's Minor League All-Star First Team and Red Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Year...Named Mid and Post-Season All-Star...14 wins were a franchise record.

CAREER WITH PORTLAND (2013-14, 17): 19-8, 2.88 ERA (61 ER/181.0 IP), 132 H, 96 BB, 200 SO in 33 starts.

LOOK BACK AT 2016: Made five starts over three stints with the Boston Red Sox...Also made 24 starts for Triple-A Pawtucket, finishing among International League leaders with a 3.53 ERA (6th), 10 wins (T-6th), 135 SO (4th), and a .217 opponent AVG (2nd)...Earned the win for Pawtucket on Opening Day vs. Buffalo, tossing 6.0 1-hit frames and striking out 8.

CAREER/PERSONAL NOTES: Entering 6th professional season...Was Boston's 3rd pick in the 2011 June Draft (36th overall), the supplemental selection for the loss of 1B/C **Victor Martinez** to the Tigers...Named the Cal-Hi Sports Mr. Baseball State Player of the Year after going 12-1 with 3 saves, a 1.15 ERA, and 140 SO over 91.2 IP as a senior at Edison (CA) High School in 2011...Earned 2011 Sunset League Pitcher of the Year honors, his 2nd straight year garnering the award.
