**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (20-30) fell to the Mississippi Braves (23-27) by a 10-2 score in the fifth and final game of the five-game series at Trustmark Park on Sunday afternoon. Miami Marlins right-handed starting pitcher Brett Graves (0-1), with Jacksonville on a major league rehab assignment, took the loss, allowing five runs on seven hits with a walk and three strikeouts in his four innings of work. Mississippi left-handed relief pitcher Adam McCreery (2-3) earned the win with two scoreless innings of relief work. The Braves led throughout the game, starting with an RBI double by Travis Demeritte in the bottom of the first 1-0. In the third, after an RBI groundout by Tyler Neslony, Demeritte hit a two-run homer down the left field line to give the Braves a 4-0 advantage. Graves walked the first batter in the fifth inning before Max Duval took over on the mound in his first relief outing of the season. Mississippi rallied for six runs in the fifth, with the big hits coming from Carlos Martinez with a two-run single, and then Neslony's two-RBI single ended the inning with a 10-0 advantage. In the ninth, Jacksonville was a strike away from being shutout before Eric Jagielo delivered a two-run double to left field to put the score at 10-2, which would be the final. Jagielo enjoyed a fine series in Mississippi, driving in eight runs during the five-game series. The win was Mississippi's third straight to take the series, and the loss was Jacksonville's first in a rubber match of the series in 2018.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Neidert One of League's Best:** Tonight's Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Nick Neidert has been among the Southern League's best starting pitchers in 2018. Entering tonight's start, Neidert has the league's ninth best ERA (3.11), and also has the fourth lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.75 among league starting pitchers. Among Marlins minor league pitchers, Neidert has the fourth-best ERA (3.11), is tied for third in wins (4), and is third in strikeouts (48).

**Harrison Homering:** Jumbo Shrimp center fielder Monte Harrison homered twice during Jacksonville's last series at Mississippi. Harrison leads Jacksonville with seven home runs, and that mark is also tied with Jonathan Rodriguez of Triple-A New Orleans for the Marlins MiLB organizational lead. Harrison last year between Single-A Wisconsin and High-A Carolina hitting 21 home runs which led the Brewers organization. On May 29 of last year, Harrison had hit eight home runs, so he is nearly at last year's home run pace. Most of his home runs have been hit on the road, with five homers in 30 road games, and two home runs in 20 home games in Jacksonville. Harrison is regarded as Miami's No. 1 prospect according to MLB.com, and was acquired by the Marlins as part of the Christian Yelich trade in Jan.

**Norwood Streaking:** Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood is having a hot stretch at the plate, having his safely in his last eight games for the Jumbo Shrimp. In his hitting streak, Norwood is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with six runs batted in and four runs scored. Norwood is approaching his longest hitting streak of the season, when he hit safely in 11 games from April 9-22, which was tied for the longest hitting streak for a Shrimp batter in 2018. The league's longest hitting streak so far this season is 15 games, belonging to Birmingham's Eloy Jimenez from April 26 to May 11.

**Florida's AA Baseball Rivalry AWAKENS:** Tonight's game begins the second series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and their in-state rivals, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. This is the final trip for the Blue Wahoos to Jacksonville in 2018, and earlier this season Jacksonville enjoyed a dominant homestand by winning four of five games against Pensacola from April 26-30. The Jumbo Shrimp will make two trips to Pensacola in the second half, facing the Blue Wahoos from July 18-22, and August 14-18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Last year the Jumbo Shrimp went 7-13 against the Wahoos, yet split the 10 meetings 5-5 at the Baseball Grounds. Pensacola won the first half South Division title, while Jacksonville took the second half South Division crown, and the clubs met in the Southern League playoffs, with all games played in Pensacola due to Hurricane Irma. The Wahoos swept the South Division Championship Series 3-0 to earn a share of the Southern League championship with Chattanooga. All three games have been decided by one run in the first series between the clubs since their meeting in the 2017 Southern League South Division Championship Series.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by MLB.com as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30).

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

**23 – NICK NEIDERT, RHP**

**4-3, 3.11 ERA, 9 games and 9 starts**

**2018:** 4-3, 3.11 ERA (16 ER/46.1 IP) in 9 G and 9 GS.  
**CAREER:** 22-14, 2.91 ERA (97 ER/300.1 IP) in 64 G and 64 GS.

**LAST START:** Neidert had a no decision in his start on Wednesday May 23 at Mississippi. He only worked two innings that night where he retired all six batters he faced in order and struck out the side in the second inning. However after that inning the game was suspended due to rain, and completed the next day with Jacksonville winning 8-1. Neidert also contributed an RBI single at the plate.

**BAYBEARS WIN:** Neidert earned his second straight victory on Thursday May 22 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Neidert worked six and two-third scorless innings where he struck out a season-high 11 batters, allowing just two hits with two walks. He retired 11 straight batters in one stretch and 17 of the final 18 he faced, becoming Jacksonville's first four-game winner this season as Jacksonville won 7-3.

**BISCUITS WIN:** Neidert earned a victory in his start on Saturday May 12 against the Montgomery Biscuits at Riverwalk Stadium. Neidert worked six innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on six hits with no walks and a season-high eight strikeouts as Jacksonville won the first game of the series 6-3.

**SMOKIES START:** Neidert suffered his second straight loss, falling to the Tennessee Smokies on Monday May 7 at the Baseball Grounds. Neidert worked five innings where he allowed three runs (all earned) on six hits with a walk and seven strikeouts. Neidert received no run support, as the Shrimp lost 3-0.

**DENBO ON NEIDERT:** "He's another starting pitcher candidate for us," Marlins vice president of player development and scouting Gary Denbo said. "We believe he will have a chance in the future to join our starting rotation. He's only 21 years old. He has the ability to command his fastball," Denbo said. "His changeup is plus. We like the movement he has on the fastball because it's different than what you normally see. He's got deception, which makes it very difficult for batters to pick up the ball, and he's a good athlete. There's a lot of qualities there that make us believe he will help us in our starting rotation in Miami."

**PROSPECT:** Neidert enters the 2018 season as the Marlins No. 5 prospect according to Baseball America and the No. 8 prospect according to MLB.com.

**#23 NICK NEIDERT RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: Nov. 20, 1996 in Atlanta, Ga. 21 Years Old.**

Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Seattle Mariners with RHP Robert Duggar, INF Chris Torres in exchange for Dee Gordon on Dec. 7, 2017.

**2017 Highlights:** Named the California League Pitcher of the Year after going 10-3 with a 2.76 ERA in 19 starts for Single-A Modesto in Seattle's system. Was a California League Midseason and Postseason All-Star, going 5-3 with a 3.31 ERA in 14 starts before the break, then 5-0 with a 1.45 ERA in five starts after the break. Earned California League Pitcher of the Week honors for July 3-9 after tossing seven shutout innings on July 6 at Visalia. Finished the season at Double-A Arkansas, making Travelers debut on July 22. With Arkansas he was 1-3 with a 6.56 ERA in six starts. Lost first three starts for Arkansas, snapped skid with a win in his fifth start on August 12 against Midland.

**2016 Highlights:** Spent all of 2016 with Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League, going 7-3 with a 2.57 ERA in 19 starts. Went 6-1 with a 2.22 ERA over his first eight starts. Factored in just three decisions (1-2) over final 11 starts, despite allowing one-or-zero runs in eight of those outings. Won four consecutive starts from June 15-July 3, posting 2.67 ERA during that span, setting a career high with 12 strikeouts on June 23 vs. Kane County, and also had 11 on July 3 at Peoria.

**2015 Highlights:** After he was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the second round of the 2015 draft, made 11 starts for the AZL Mariners, going 0-2 with a 1.53 ERA. There he held opponents scoreless in six of 11 starts.

**Personal:** Attended Peachtree Ridge High School in Suwanee, Georgia. Selected as a First Team All-American and Southeastern All-Region First Team by Perfect Game in 2015. Had signed to pitch at the University of South Carolina before signing with Mariners.
