Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (27-25, 57-65) fell to the Mobile BayBears (27-26, 57-65) by a 10-4 score in the third game of the five-game series at Hank Aaron Stadium on Friday night. BayBears relief pitcher Justin Anderson (3-2) earned the victory with his scoreless inning and a third of work after Mobile starter Jake Jewell worked the first four and two-thirds innings. Jacksonville starter Trevor Richards (4-5) took the loss, allowing five runs on five hits with two walks and two strikeouts in his two-third innings of work in the bottom of the first. The BayBears struck quickly, scoring five runs in the bottom of the first inning off Richards. Jose Rojas and Forrestt Allday started the scoring with RBI singles before a wild pitch brought home Rojas to make it 3-0. The BayBears added their final two runs of the inning on a two RBI single by Alberto Triunfel that put the lead at 5-0. The BayBears added a homer by Jose Rojas in the second inning to grow the lead to 6-0. Jacksonville struck back with three runs in the top of the third. A wild pitch brought home David Vidal from third base before Braxton Lee hit an RBI single to make it a 6-2 game. Jacksonville's last run of the inning came on an RBI groundout by Austin Dean that cut the lead to 6-3. The Shrimp got a run closer in the top of the fourth, when after a single by Rodrigo Vigil, a throwing error by BayBears first baseman Zach Houchins on the play scored Vidal to cut Mobile's lead to 6-4. The BayBears got a run back in the bottom of the fourth with a solo homer by Taylor Ward that put the Mobile lead at 7-4. The BayBears added their final runs in the bottom of the seventh. With two outs Triunfel delivered a two-run triple before an RBI single by Tim Arakawa grew the lead to 10-4, which would be the final score. Triunfel went 2-for-4 with four runs batted in. Despite the loss, Jacksonville remains in first place in the second half South Division standings, now a half game ahead of both the BayBears and the Biloxi Shuckers with 18 games left in the season.

NEWS AND NOTES

Where We Stand: There are 18 games left to go in the 2017 regular season, and the Jumbo Shrimp are still alive and well in the Southern League playoff picture. Coming into today, the Jumbo Shrimp would be in the Southern League postseason, as the Jumbo Shrimp are in first place in the second half South Division standings. As of Saturday August 19, the Jumbo Shrimp are a half game ahead of both the Biloxi Shuckers and the Mobile BayBears for first place. Jacksonville hasn't appeared in the Southern League playoffs since 2014 when the club won the second half crown and then league title.

Lee at the Top: Braxton Lee continues to lead the Southern League in hitting with his .322 batting average. Lee is also the Southern League hit king with 135 this season, tied for the league lead in runs scored with 73, and is fourth in the league with a .403 on-base percentage. Lee was honored as a Southern League Midseason All-Star for his work with the Montgomery Biscuits in the first half of the season, and he joined the Jumbo Shrimp on June 27 after being traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the Marlins in exchange for Adeiny Hechavarría.

Peters on a Roll: Tonight's Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Dillon Peters has been shining lately for the Jumbo Shrimp. During the last homestand, Peters earned victories against the Birmingham Barons and the Mississippi Braves and is 4-2 with a 2.73 ERA in his seven starts for Jacksonville this season. Peters missed three months with a left thumb fracture from mid-April to late July, and is the Miami Marlins No. 4 prospect according to MLB.com.

LAST START: Peters earned his second straight win on Sunday August 13 against the Mississippi Braves at the Baseball Grounds. Peters worked five innings where he allowed a run on two hits with no walks and four strikeouts in a 9-3 Jacksonville win.

BARONS START: Peters earned his first win since before his injury by defeating the Birmingham Barons on Sunday August 6 at the Baseball Grounds. Peters worked five innings allowing three runs on seven hits with three walks and two strikeouts in a game Jacksonville won 12-6.

SHUCKERS LOSS: Peters had his first loss in his second stint with the Shrimp, as he took the loss on Tuesday August 1 at Biloxi. Peters worked six innings where he allowed a pair of runs on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 3-1.

BRAVES START AND RETURN: Peters had a no decision in his return to the Jumbo Shrimp on Thursday July 27 at Mississippi. Peters turned in five innings where he allowed a run on six hits with a walk and two strikeouts. Jacksonville won late 2-1 thanks to a David Vidal RBI single in the eighth inning.

REHAB: Peters with the Hammerheads was 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA, pitching 10 and two-thirds scoreless innings in two starts. This is after Peters made a pair of rehab starts with the GCL Marlins in early July, going 0-1 with a 1.35 ERA in six and two-third innings.

WAHOOS START & INJURY: Peters took a loss in his start on April 17 at Pensacola. He worked an inning and two thirds where he allowed a run on three hits when he had to leave after he was struck on the hand by a line drive off the bat of Pensacola's Blake Trahan, and Jacksonville lost 3-1. Peters had been on Jacksonville's disabled list since April 18 with a left thumb injury before returning July 27 at Mississippi.

2017 MARLINS SPRING TRAINING: Dillon Peters was a non-roster invitee to Miami Marlins spring training in 2017. Peters made four appearances and one start, going 0-0 with a 2.00 ERA, striking out four batters in his nine innings of work. In his start on March 9 against the Washington Nationals and their regular lineup, Peters walked the leadoff batter (Trea Turner) before setting down the next nine batters (Adam Eaton, Bryce Harper, Anthony Rendon, Jayson Werth, Ryan Zimmerman, Jose Lobaton, Grant Green, Stephen Drew, then Turner to end his day.

PROSPECT: Peters is listed by Baseball America as the Marlins No. 5 prospect for the 2017 season and MLB.com has him as Miami's No. 4 for this year. Additionally, Peters is regarded as having the "Best Control" of any Marlins farmhand. Peters is regarded as the second-best left-handed pitching prospect in the Marlins organization behind No. 1 prospect Braxton Garrett, whom was drafted just last season and has not pitched professionally.

#26 DILLON PETERS LHP | 5-10, 200 lbs | Born: Indianapolis, Indiana. Age: 24

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 10th round of the 2014 draft out of the University of Texas.

2016 Highlights: Peters started the season with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads was 11-6 with a 2.46 ERA in 20 starts. In the Florida State League, Peters was sixth in ERA (2.46), and tied for second in wins (11). Following the season, Peters was named a 2016 Florida State League Postseason All-Star. Peters finished the season with Jacksonville where he went 3-0 with a 1.99 ERA in four starts. Peters earned wins in his first three Suns starts, with victories against Chattanooga, Mississippi, and Tennessee. Peters struck out 16 batters in his 22 and two-thirds innings of work with Jacksonville.

2015 Highlights: Peters went 1-1 with a 0.68 ERA in four starts for the GCL Marlins. He also went 0-3 with a 4.83 ERA in seven starts with rookie level Batavia.

2014 Highlights: Did not pitch, injured.

Personal: Was selected by the Marlins after he already had missed time with an elbow injury and had to undergo Tommy John surgery following the 2014 Big XII Tournament. Agreed to a \$175,000 signing bonus with Marlins. Was 7-3 with a 2.31 ERA in final season with Texas Longhorns. Tossed seven innings in a combined no-hitter against Kansas State on May 16, 2014. Was Indiana All-State in 2009 and 2010, and was the 2010 Indiana Super Team Player of the Year. His grandfather pitched semipro ball, and his father Mark pitched in college and coached Peters in travel ball. Was originally drafted by the Cleveland Indians in the 20th round in 2011 before he signed with Texas.
