LAST TIME OUT: Despite outhitting the Miracle, 10-3, the Tampa Tarpons were held scoreless as Fort Myers claimed the series-opener, 1-0, on Monday night at George M. Steinbrenner Field... Tampa left eight runners (five in scoring position) and finished 0-for-5 with RISP... Miracle catcher Ryan Jeffers drove in the lone run with a leadoff homer in the 2nd... **RHP Rony Garcia** (L, 0-2) logged a quality start, tossing a season-high 6.2IP (2H, 1ER, 1BB, 3K, HR, 98P/63S)... **Isiah Gilliam** (3-for-4) and **Estevan Florial** (2-for-4) had multi-hit games... **Dermis Garcia** (1-for-4) extended his hitting streak to five games... **Oswaldo Cabrera** (1-for-4) and **Diego Castillo** (1-for-4) both extended on-base streaks to six games... **RHP Hobie Harris** (1.1IP, 1H, 3K) and **RHP Matt Wivinis** (1.0IP, 1BB, 1K) logged scoreless outings.

STANTON RESUMES REHAB: The New York Yankees have announced that **OF/DH Giancarlo Stanton** is scheduled to begin a new minor league rehabilitation assignment with the Tampa Tarpons tonight. Stanton, 29, was placed on the 10-day injured list on April 1 with a left biceps strain. The Panorama, California native was 2-for-8 with seven walks, four strikeouts and a run scored in three games with New York prior to being sidelined. The 2017 National League MVP originally began a rehab assignment with the Tarpons on May 20, going 1-for-3 with a home run and a pair of strikeouts while playing seven innings in right field in Tampa's 9-2 win over the Florida Fire Frogs. Stanton was returned by the Yankees from his rehab assignment on May 22nd with left calf tightness.

FLORIAL RETURNS: **OF Estevan Florial** (2-for-4) has reached base in seven-straight games since returning from the 7-Day Injured List. The 21-year-old played in 13 games with the New York Yankees during Spring Training, batting .355 (11-for-31) with 7R, 2 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI, 4BB and 5SB(OCs), but sustained a non-displaced right wrist fracture on 3/16 vs. Toronto, landing awkwardly after crashing into the centerfield wall in pursuit of a fly ball. Florial enters this season ranked by *Baseball America* as the top prospect in the Yankees organization.

DERMIS DELIVERS: **Dermis Garcia** (3-for-3, HR, 2 2Bs, HBP, 2RBI, 2R) reached base four times on Sunday, notching his fifth three-hit game of the season, including three extra-base hits. The 21-year-old ranks first in the Florida State League in HR (14) and RBI (45), is tied for first in XBH (26), and ranks second in SLG (.530) and Total Bases (107).

BABY BOMBERS: The Tarpons are currently tied for second in the league with 46 home runs, trailing only Fort Myers (51HR). 18 different Tarpons have contributed to the total, led by **Dermis Garcia** (14HR).

RACKING UP THE Ks: Tampa pitchers tallied 12 more strikeouts on Sunday. Entering today, Tampa's pitching staff ranks third in the Florida State League with 558 strikeouts, trailing Clearwater (633) and Fort Myers (588).

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR! On Thursday, May 30, the Florida State League announced that **RHP Braden Bristo** and **C Jason Lopez** had been added as 2019 Mid-Season All-Stars. Along with **INF Dermis Garcia**, **OF Isiah Gilliam** and **RHP Brooks Kriske**, the Tampa Tarpons now have five players selected to represent the club at the 58th FSL All-Star Game, held at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium on Saturday, June 15, at 7:05 p.m.

STEINBRENNER FIELD REHAB CENTER: Yankees **SS Didi Gregorius** ("Tommy John" surgery) joined Tampa on May 25, becoming the sixth player to rehab with the Tarpons this season. **LHP CC Sabathia** made a rehab start on April 7th, recovering from offseason heart surgery. **3B Miguel Andújar** (right shoulder strain) and **SS Troy Tulowitzki** (strained left calf) joined the Tarpons on April 30. **OF Aaron Hicks** (left lower back strain) joined Tampa on May 6. **OF/DH Giancarlo Stanton** (left biceps strain) played a game with the Tarpons on May 20. Fun Fact: **Andújar, Tulowitzki, Stanton** and **Gregorius** have all homered with the Tarpons this season.

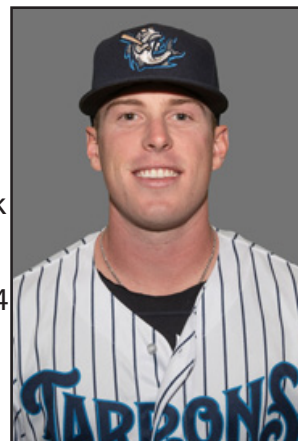

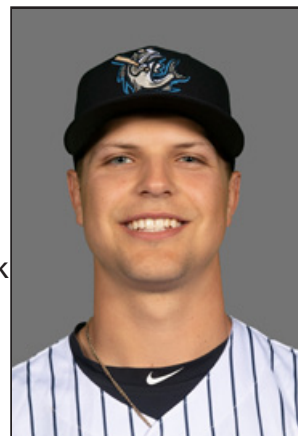
