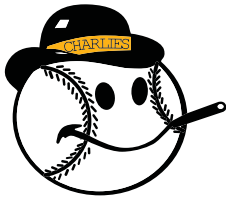

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

-  Owner of the Charleston Charlies from 1971 to 1981
-  Credited for bringing baseball back to Charleston after purchasing the Columbus Jets in 1970 & relocating them to the capital city
-  Known as the main contributor for the renovation of Watt Powell Park which would lead to Charleston being legitimized as a baseball city, thus making Charleston an attractive candidate to join the South Atlantic League in 1987
-  The Charleston Charlies logo was crafted after his father "Poor Charlie" who wore a bowler cap & always had a cigar
