Giants Conclude Series At Lancaster... The San Jose Giants wrap-up a three-game series against the Lancaster JetHawks this afternoon at The Hangar. The Giants have won the first two games of the series earning victories of 7-6 (in 10 innings) on Friday and 10-5 yesterday. San Jose is attempting to sweep a series for the first time this season. Melvin Adon (0-2, 3.98 ERA) is slated to start on the mound for the Giants today.

Winning Ways... The Giants have won five out of their last seven games. Last night's victory moved San Jose (18-12) to a season-high six games above .500. The Giants are in a three-way tie with Stockton and Visalia atop the North Division standings.

On The Mound... The Giants enter today's contest with a 3.24 team ERA – second in the California League (Visalia leads at 3.15). The San Jose pitching staff has allowed only 11 home runs in 30 games this season – fewest in the league (next-closest: Modesto with 20 HR's allowed). The Giants have given up only four home runs in their last 14 games.

Rock The Hawk... San Jose is 4-1 against Lancaster this season with all five games having been played at The Hangar. The Giants are batting .319 as a team and averaging 8.4 runs per game versus the JetHawks this year. The San Jose pitching staff also owns a 3.80 ERA against Lancaster. The Giants are now 3-0-1 in their last four series' at The Hangar dating back to last season. Prior to taking two of three in a series in Lancaster last May, San Jose hadn't won a series at The Hangar since the 2011 season. The Giants last swept a series in Lancaster from August 11-14, 2011.

Winn Hit Streak At 11 Games... Matt Winn brings an 11-game hitting streak into this afternoon's action – the longest hit streak by a Giants player this season. Winn is batting at a .349 clip (15-for-43) during the hit streak with three doubles, two triples and three home runs. He's homered in each of his last two games.

Close Calls... The Giants own league-best records in one-run games (7-4) and extra-inning games (5-0).

Franco Heating Up... Since moving into the third spot in the lineup on April 29, Wander Franco is batting .419 (13-for-31) with seven doubles, one home run and eight RBI's spanning seven games. Franco's 11 doubles this season are tied for the league lead. He's also batting a team-best .353 with runners in scoring position.

On Deck... Following an off day tomorrow, the Giants continue their road trip with a three-game series in Modesto beginning on Tuesday night. San Jose will play Lancaster again in five days when the JetHawks travel to the South Bay for a four-game series.

Cycle x2... April 11 was an historic night for the San Jose Giants as both Gio Brusa and Jalen Miller hit for the cycle in an 18-6 victory at Lancaster. Brusa (4-for-6, 2B, 3B, HR, 6 RBI) completed his cycle with a triple in the top of the eighth. Miller (5-for-7, 2B, 3B, HR, 4 RBI, SB), who tied a Giants single-game team record with five hits, tripled in the ninth inning for San Jose's second cycle of the night. The duo became the fourth and fifth players in the 31-year history of the San Jose Giants to hit for the cycle. Prior to Brusa and Miller, the last SJ Giant to hit for the cycle was Thomas Neal on April 28, 2009 at Lancaster.

- * Is in his fourth professional season ... Originally signed with the San Francisco Giants in 2015 out of the Dominican Republic at age 20.
- * Rated the #14 prospect in the San Francisco Giants organization according to *Baseball America* entering the 2018 season ... Is the fifth-highest ranked pitcher on the list.
- * Rated as having the "best fastball" currently in the Giants system by Baseball America.
- * Also currently ranked as the #19 prospect in the organization by MLB.com.
- * Today marks his sixth start and seventh overall appearance with San Jose this season ... Still looking for his first win (0-2 record) ... Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in four out of his five starts ... Owns a 2.33-to-1 groundout-to-flyout ratio the highest groundout rate on the Giants staff.
- * Most recent start came on May 1 against Visalia ... Pitched a season-high seven innings with two runs (one earned) and six hits allowed ... Walked four and struck out five ... Took a shutout into the seventh, but suffered the loss after surrendering two runs in the top of the seventh (Giants lost game 2-1).
- * Struck out a career-high nine batters over six innings in his previous start on April 25 against Lake Elsinore (two runs allowed).
- * Has one previous start against Lancaster on April 10 at The Hangar ... Received a nodecision after pitching 5 2/3 innings with three runs (two earned) and eight hits allowed ... Walked two and struck out two ... Left the game with the score tied 3-3 (Giants eventually lost 5-3).
- * Has fared better against right-handed hitters (.254 AVG) compared to versus left-handed batters (.327 AVG) this season.
- * Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2017 ... Was 3-11 with a 4.35 ERA in 23 games (19 starts) ... Struck out 89 and walked 35 over 99 1/3 innings.
- * Allowed one or no earned runs in 10 out of his 19 starts last season ... Fared better at home (2.90 ERA) compared to on the road (5.80 ERA) ... Allowed only five home runs for the entire season ... Had a .253 opponents batting average against right-handed hitters compared to a .299 AVG versus left-handed batters.
- * Pitched for Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) in 2016 ... Was 5-5 with a 5.48 ERA over 14 starts ... Led the Volcanoes staff in wins, innings pitched (67 1/3) and strikeouts (55).
- * Began his professional career with the Giants' Dominican Summer League affiliate in 2015 ... Was 4-0 with a 2.48 ERA in 14 starts.
