Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood hit a walk-off home run on the first pitch of the bottom of the 11th inning in a 3-2 win over the Mobile BayBears in front of 6,260 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville on a Baptist Health Sunday Family FUNday afternoon. After kids played catch in the outfield before the game, the Jumbo Shrimp and BayBears dueled to a scoreless tie until the sixth inning. Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Joe Gunkel, a former Red Sox, Orioles and Dodgers minor league right-hander making his Miami Marlins organizational debut, started with four scoreless innings, holding the BayBears (11-13) to two outs and striking out one batter. BayBears right-hander Jordan Kipper, who had not allowed a run his last 15 innings pitched, kept Jacksonville (10-14) off the scoreboard until the bottom of the sixth inning. In a scoreless game, Jumbo Shrimp center fielder Yefri Perez doubled to left field, went to third base on right fielder Isaac Galloway's single and scored on left fielder Jeremias Pineda's RBI fielder's choice. The BayBears rallied in the next half inning, with two runs scoring on left fielder Alberto Triunfel's fly ball against right-hander Tyler Higgins that went off Pineda's glove. Left-hander James Buckelew was charged with the two unearned runs in 2 2/3 innings. In the bottom of the seventh inning, Mobile right-hander Eduardo Paredes allowed singles to Jumbo Shrimp first baseman Taylor Ard and shortstop Alex Yarbrough, walked Perez and hit Galloway with a bases-loaded, two-out pitch to force home Ard and tie the game, 2-2. Jumbo Shrimp left-hander Greg Nappo and right-hander Ryan Beckman (1-0) each worked two scoreless innings to keep the tie into the bottom of the 11th. BayBears right-hander Eric Karch (2-2) pitched scoreless eighth, ninth and 10th innings, before Norwood launched his second home run in as many days to the left-field berm, capping a team-best three-hit day.

NEWS AND NOTES

Vidal's Streak Ends, Galloway's Continues: Yesterday was a significant day in terms of streaks for the Jumbo Shrimp. David Vidal went 0-3 in the game, and that put an end to what had been a 14-game streak, the longest of the season in the Southern League or for the Jumbo Shrimp. In his hitting streak, Vidal hit .375 (21-for-56) with two home runs and seven RBI. Vidal is also hitting .319, which is the ninth best batting average in the Southern League, his 29 hits also tied for third in the league, and his 41 total bases are tied for third in the Southern League. Vidal was named the Southern League Player of the Week for the week of April 17-23. While Vidal's streak ended, Isaac Galloway extended his hitting streak to nine games, as he has collected a base hit in each game since he joined the Jumbo Shrimp on April 22 from Triple-A New Orleans. Galloway is hitting .472 (17-for-36) with 3 RBI and five multi-hit games since his streak began. Galloway's nine-game hitting streak is the second longest active in the league behind Montgomery's Granden Goetzman, who has hit safely in the last 10 games.

Homers at the Baseball Grounds: While the Jumbo Shrimp have only played nine home games, eight of their 12 home runs in 2017 have been hit at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. In the past three games, Jacksonville has hit four homers, including a two-home run game Saturday with John Norwood and Taylor Ard both hitting home runs in the bottom of the fourth inning. Norwood also provided the first walk-off home run of the season with his blast on Sunday in the bottom of the 11th inning. Both of Biran Anderson's home runs have been hit at the Baseball Grounds this year. This has already been the most prolific home run series of the season for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting five home runs over the past three games against the Mobile BayBears.

Attendance Kings: After playing 15 of the first 20 games of the season on the road, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp are thrilled to be back at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. The last three games the Jumbo Shrimp have welcomed in over 6,000 fans, despite a hectic sports and entertainment schedule in downtown Jacksonville. Currently the Jumbo Shrimp lead the Southern League in attendance average, by welcoming in an average of 7,534 which is more than 900 fans more than the next closest team (Birmingham – 6,645). Saturday's crowd of 7,341 fans was also the only Saturday Southern League crowd over 5,000 fans. Sunday's crowd of 6,260 was the largest Sunday crowd of any Southern League team yesterday. The first home series of the year was from April 12-16 against Chattanooga, and it saw record crowds as the Baseball Grounds. With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville.

LAST START: Kickham took his third straight loss at Birmingham on Tuesday April 25 at Regions Field. Kickham worked six innings where he allowed two runs on six hits with no walks and nine strikeouts. Jacksonville lost the game 3-2.

WAHOOS LOSS: Kickham took his second straight loss at Pensacola on Thursday April 20. Kickham worked five innings where he allowed seven runs on eight hits with no walks and four strikeouts. Most of the damage by the Blue Wahoos was done with a five-run bottom of the second, then the Wahoos also scored a pair of runs against him in the sixth inning where he did not record an out. Jacksonville lost the game 8-5.

LOOKOUTS LOSS: Kickham took fist first loss of the year on Saturday April 15 against the Chattanooga Lookouts at the Baseball Grounds. Kickham worked five innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on four hits with a walk and six strikeouts, in a game that Jacksonville would lose 10-1.

BRAVES START: Kickham had a no decision in his 2017 and Marlins organization debut on Sunday April 9 at Mississippi. Kickham worked five innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on four hits with no walks and four strikeouts. He left the game with Jacksonville trailing 2-0, only to tie the game with a pair of runs in the top of the sixth. The game went 13 innings, where Mississippi won 4-3.

2016 with RICHMOND: Kickham's time in affiliated baseball last season was spent with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he went 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA in six relief appearances before he was released by the Giants on May 20, 2016. Kickham then spent time in independent baseball last year with the Kansas City T-Bones in the American Association. There he went 3-5 with a 2.83 ERA in 14 starts to close out the season.

BIG LEAGUE TIME: Kickham pitched in the major leagues with the San Francisco Giants in 2013 and 2014. He made his big league debut on May 28, 2013 in Oakland against the Athletics, where he allowed four runs on four hits in his two and a third innings of work, taking the loss in the game. He had more call-ups to the big leagues in June, July, August, and then finished September in a Giants uniform. All together, in 2013 he was 0-3 with a 10.16 ERA in his 12 appearances and three starts. In 2014 he was a September call-up to the Giants, and had no wins or losses and a 22.50 ERA in two relief appearances for a club that went on to win the World Series. In parts of two big league seasons, Kickham is 0-3 with a 10.98 ERA in 14 games and three starts.

2016 Highlights: Kickham's time in affiliated baseball last season was spent with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he went 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA in six relief appearances before he was released by the Giants on May 20, 2016. Kickham spent time in independent baseball last year with the Kansas City T-Bones in the American Association. There he went 3-5 with a 2.83 ERA in 14 starts to close out the season.

2015 Highlights: Kickham split the 2015 season between the Seattle Mariners and Texas Rangers organizations, pitching exclusively in the Triple-A Pacific Coast League. He started the year with Triple-A Tacoma, where he was 0-2 with a 7.29 ERA in five starts before he was designated for assignment by the Mariners on May 4. He then was claimed off waivers by the Texas Rangers a day later, and then pitched for Triple-A Round Rock where he was 1-0 with a 6.00 ERA in seven relief appearances before he was released on June 11.

2014 Highlights: Kickham spent most of 2014 with Triple-A Fresno where he was 8-8 with a 4.43 ERA in 27 starts in the Pacific Coast League. In 2014 he was a September call-up to the Giants, and had no wins or losses and a 22.50 ERA in two relief appearances for a club that went on to win the World Series

2013 Highlights: Kickham split the 2013 season between Triple-A Fresno and the major leagues with the Giants. With Fresno he was 7-7 with a 4.31 ERA in 20 starts. He made his big league debut on May 28, 2013 in Oakland against the Athletics, where he allowed four runs on four hits in his two and a third innings of work, taking the loss in the game. He had more call-ups to the big leagues in June, July, August, and then finished September in a Giants uniform. All together, in 2013 he was 0-3 with a 10.16 ERA in his 12 appearances and three starts.

2012 Highlights: Kickham spent all of 2012 in Double-A with the Richmond Flying Squirrels in the Eastern League. There he was 11-10 with a 3.05 ERA in 28 appearances and 27 starts.

2011 Highlights: Kickham spent all of 2011 with the Single-A Augusta Greenjackets in the South Atlantic League. There he was 5-10 with a 4.11 ERA in 21 starts.

2010 Highlights: After he was drafted by the Giants, he made three relief appearances with the AZL Giants where he had no wins or losses and an 11.57 ERA.

Personal: Originally selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2010 draft out of Missouri State. Kickham played for Missouri State in 2010. He struck out 103 batters in 96.0 innings and won MSU's Dave Dickensheet Outstanding Pitcher Award.
