Giants Conclude Series Against Rancho Cucamonga... The San Jose Giants look to avoid a series sweep when they conclude their five-game set against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes this evening at Municipal Stadium. The Quakes have won the first four games of the series claiming victories of 3-1 on Wednesday, 8-3 (in 10 innings) on Thursday, 4-0 on Friday and 14-6 yesterday. Raffi Vizcaino (5-5, 4.68 ERA) is slated to start on the mound for the Giants tonight.

Seven Straight Losses... The Giants enter tonight's contest on a season-high seven-game losing streak (last win: June 30 at Visalia). During the losing skid, San Jose is hitting .172, averaging 3.1 runs per game, has struck out 74 times (10.6 per game) and possesses a 6.86 team ERA. The Giants have been outscored by a 56-22 margin (-34 run differential) over the course of the seven-game losing streak. The longest losing streak in San Jose Giants team history is 12 games (2000).

Last Night... The 14 runs and 18 hits allowed by the Giants last night both matched season-high totals. The Quakes' eight-run top of the fifth yesterday also matched the most runs given up by San Jose in an inning this year.

Inside The Record... Last night's loss dropped the Giants (39-48) to a season-high nine games below .500 overall. San Jose won their 30th game of the season on June 1 (30-25), but have gone just 9-23 (.281) since. The Giants are also just 3-13 in their last 16 home games after starting the season with a 17-10 record at Municipal Stadium. San Jose hasn't won a series since taking two of three at Modesto from June 8-10.

Hitting Woes... San Jose has managed a total of just 19 hits and 10 runs over the first four games of the current series against Rancho Cucamonga. The Giants are batting .147 (19-for-129) during the last four games. San Jose is now last in the California League with a .248 team batting average this season.

Second Half Stats... The Giants are off to a 5-12 start in the second half. San Jose is batting only .201 as a team in the second half with a 4.96 ERA. The Giants have hit 19 home runs in 17 second half games.

League Leaderboard... Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is fourth in doubles (23), fifth in hits (93) and sixth in runs scored (49). Gio Brusa is tied for fourth in the league in home runs (13), tied for ninth in RBI's (46) and sixth in slugging (.496). Wander Franco is third in doubles (25) and tenth in hits (87) while Johneshwy Fargas is third in stolen bases (25).

Versus The Quakes... The Giants are 1-7 against the Quakes this season (0-4 at Municipal Stadium, 1-3 at LoanMart Field). San Jose is batting only .177 as a team while averaging 3.0 runs per game against Rancho Cucamonga this year. The Giants have also struck out 94 times in eight games versus Quakes pitching (11.8 per game). San Jose will play 18 games versus the Quakes in the second half (all during a 47-game stretch from June 21-August 8).

Sweeps... The Giants have been swept in a series twice this season: May 25-27 at Lake Elsinore and June 5-7 vs. Stockton. San Jose has not swept a series yet this year.

Power Surge... The Giants have hit 11 home runs over their last eight games. San Jose's 70 home runs this season lead all North Division clubs and rank third in the California League.

On Deck... The Giants next travel to Stockton for a four-game series beginning tomorrow night. San Jose is 8-10 against the Ports this season. The Giants return home on Friday to host the Visalia Rawhide in a four-game series.

* Most recent start came on July 3 at Visalia ... Pitched 4 2/3 innings with five runs (all earned) allowed ... Gave up six hits, walked four and struck out six ... Suffered the loss (Giants lost the game 7-0).

* Allowed two runs or fewer in four consecutive starts from June 12-28.

* Has pitched past the fifth inning only four times in 15 starts.

* Fired six scoreless innings with a season-high nine strikeouts in his May 11 start versus Lancaster.

* Has allowed a team-high 11 home runs, including eight over his last eight starts.

* Only previous start against Rancho Cucamonga came on June 23 at LoanMart Field ... Pitched four innings with two runs (both earned) allowed ... Surrendered four hits, walked four and struck out seven (no-decision).

* Has fared better against left-handed hitters (.230 AVG, 3 HR) compared to versus right-handed batters (.255 AVG, 8 HR) this season.

* Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2017 ... Was 5-7 with a 4.98 ERA in 16 games (12 starts) ... Struck out 74 and walked 28 over 77 2/3 innings ... Allowed three earned runs or fewer in 10 out of his 12 starts ... Began the year at Extended Spring Training before joining Augusta in mid-May.
