Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (24-36, 52-76) defeated the Chattanooga Lookouts (25-34, 61-66) by a 5-4 score in the second game of the five-game series at AT&T Field on Saturday night. Trailing 4-1 going to the top of the ninth, the Shrimp used a four-run rally to move past the Lookouts to even the series at one game apiece, with Brian Miller bringing in the go-ahead run in the top of the ninth with an RBI double. Jacksonville left-handed relief pitcher Miguel Del Pozo (5-0) earned the victory by getting the last out in the eighth, while Chattanooga left-handed relief pitcher Anthony Marzi took the loss by allowing the go-ahead run to score in the ninth. Tommy Eveld struck out the side in order in the bottom of the ninth to pick up his fourth save of the season in the Southern League. The first seven innings were scoreless, and then John Norwood blasted a solo home run to a light tower beyond left-center field to give Jacksonville a 1-0 lead. The home run was his first since July 11 when he also homered off Lookouts left-handed reliever Tyler Jay, the man he homered off of in this game. Jumbo Shrimp right-handed starter Nick Neidert's first seven innings were scoreless until the Lookouts tied the game in the bottom of the eighth on a sacrifice fly by Mitchell Kranson to put the score at 1-1. Two batters later, Andy Wilkins hit a three-run homer to right to put the Lookouts on top 4-1. The Jumbo Shrimp loaded the bases with one out to begin the ninth inning, then Sharif Othman got Jacksonville closer with a two-run single to cut Chattanooga's lead to 4-3. Anfernee Seymour then reached on a fielder's choice and drove in Norwood from third to tie the game at 4-4. With two outs, Miller hit a deep fly ball to right to score Seymour from first base, and his RBI double was the difference in the game. Chattanooga right-handed starting pitcher Tyler Wells worked the first six innings ins scoreless fashion with three hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts. Neidert went seven and two-thirds innings for Jacksonville, allowing four runs on eight hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in his no decision.

NEWS AND NOTES

Dugger Brings in Scoreless Streak: Today's Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Robert Dugger brings a 15 inning scoreless streak into today's start against the Chattanooga Lookouts at AT&T Field. Dugger has had back-to-back starts where he has worked seven innings without allowing a run, and in that time he's struck out 19 batters compared to just five walks and eight hits allowed. Against Birmingham at the Baseball Grounds, Dugger worked seven scoreless innings where he allowed three hits, walked just two, and struck out a career-high 10 batters as Jacksonville won 3-1. This has been a great month of August for Dugger, who is 3-0 with a 1.65 ERA in his four starts, and overall he has won four of his last five starts. Dugger is regarded by MLB.com as the Marlins No. 22 prospect for the 2018 season.

Lookout Norwood: John Norwood has enjoyed facing the Chattanooga Lookouts in 2018. This season in 10 games, Norwood is hitting .371 (13-for-35) against Chattanooga with four home runs and seven RBI. He had a multi-homer game against the Lookouts on July 11 at the Baseball Grounds, then went 25 games without a home run before he homered off the same reliever Tyler Jay on Saturday night against the Lookouts.

Dunand SL Player of the Week: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp shortstop Joe Dunand has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for August 13 -19, announced by the league office on Monday. Over the past week, Dunand led the Southern League with seven RBI, also hitting .374 (9-for-24) with three home runs and was also tied for the Double-A lead with six extra-base hits. He also led Double-A baseball with 21 total bases, and his .875 slugging percentage was also second-best in the league. Dunand's hottest stretch at the plate came in games on Tuesday and Wednesday at Pensacola. On Tuesday Dunand was 4-for-5 at the plate with a pair of home runs, his first multi-homer game, as he tied a career-high with 4 runs batted in and set a career-high with four hits. He followed that up with a 3-for-5 performance on Wednesday with two runs batted in. All seven of his hits came in consecutive order between the two games, coming just four hits shy of the Southern League record for most consecutive hits.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have six players who were listed by MLB.com as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), RHP Nick Neidert (3), OF Brian Miller (11), Joe Dunand (22), Robert Dugger (23), and McKenzie Mills (30). Three of these players came in offseason trades (Harrison, Neidert, Dugger), while Miller and Dunand were two of the first three players selected by the Marlins in the 2017 draft.

LAST START: Dugger had his second straight dominant start on Tuesday August 21 against the Birmingham Barons at the Baseball Grounds. Dugger worked seven scoreless innings where he allowed three hits, walked just two, and struck out a career-high 10 batters as Jacksonville won 3-1.

WAHOOS WIN: Dugger was dominant in his win on Thursday August 16 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Dugger turned in seven scoreless innings where he allowed just five hits with three walks and he tied a career-high with nine strikeouts as Jacksonville won 9-1.

LAST LOOKOUTS START: Dugger earned a win in his start on Tuesday July 10 against the Chattanooga Lookouts at the Baseball Grounds. Dugger worked a season-long seven innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts as Jacksonville won 7-2.

PROSPECT: Dugger is regarded by MLB.com as the Marlins No. 24 prospect for the 2018 season.

2018 WITH JUPITER: Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Florida State League with the Jupiter Hammerheads where he was a 2018 Florida State League Midseason All-Star. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seen walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, DUGger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walks per nine innings ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

#12 ROBERT DUGGER | 6-2, 180 lbs | Born: July 3, 1995 in Tucson, Arizona. 23 Years Old.

From Mariners with RHP Nick Neidert, INF Chris Torres and future considerations in exchange for IF/OF Dee Gordon on Dec. 7, 2017.

2017 Highlights: Split the season between Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League and High-A Modesto in the California League. With the Clinton Lumberkings, Dugger was 4-1 with a 2.00 ERA in 22 appearances and nine starts. As a starter, went 3-0 with a 1.18 ERA in nine starts after starting the season in the bullpen. With Clinton, he was honored as a 2017 Midwest League Midseason All-Star. Finished the season with the Modesto Nuts, going 2-5 with a 3.94 ERA in nine starts.

2016 Highlights: After he was selected by the Mariners in the 18th round of the 2016 draft out of Texas Tech, Dugger spent time at three different levels of the Mariners system. He started with the AZL Mariners where he made four appearances in relief, with no wins or losses and a 1.04 ERA. In late July he was sent to Triple-A Tacoma, where he worked two games in relief, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA. He finished the season with the Everett AquaSox in the Short Season Class A Northwest League, where he was 2-1 with a 5.47 ERA in six starts.

College: Spent the 2016 season at Texas Tech, where he was 6-1 with a 2.67 ERA in 30 relief appearances with three saves. Struck out 54 batters in 60 and twothird innings of work. Dugger spent the 2015 and 2014 seasons at Cisco Junior College. In 2015, finished 3-2 overall with a 4.37 ERA ... struck out 55 hitters while issuing just 18 walks over 70.0 complete innings. In 2014 he was one of Cisco's top starting pitchers ... appeared in 12 games, finishing 5-5 overall with a 5.40 ERA ... led the team with 63.1 innings pitched ... tossed three complete games which ranked second on the team.

Personal: Helped lead Tomball High School to the Texas Class 4A state title as a senior ... played under head coach Doug Rush ... Tomball closed the 2013 season with an impressive 35-4 overall record ... marked the first state championship for any team sport in Tomball history ... team also finished the year ranked among the top 10 programs in the country ... was a first team All-District honoree as a senior ... first team All-State selection by the Texas Sports Writers Association ... also honored on the All-Houston area team and the All-State Tournament team ... recognized for work in the classroom as an academic All-State honoree ... member of the school's National Honors Society. Son of Ronnie and Anna Dugger ... has a younger brother, Cody ... mother is a teacher and University of Arizona alum.
