Giants Begin Four-Game Series In Stockton... The San Jose Giants open a four-game series against the Stockton Ports this evening at Banner Island Ballpark. Tonight is the 19th meeting of the season between the Giants and Ports. San Jose is 8-10 versus Stockton this year.

Mazza's First Start... Tonight marks Domenic Mazza's first start of the season after two relief appearances with the Giants this year. Mazza becomes the 16th different pitcher to make a start for the San Jose Giants in 2018.

Eight Straight Losses... The Giants enter tonight's contest on a season-high eight-game losing streak. During the losing skid, San Jose is hitting .185, averaging 3.4 runs per game, has struck out 86 times (10.8 per game) and possesses a 6.75 team ERA. The Giants have been outscored by a 62-27 margin (-35 run differential) over the course of the eight-game losing streak. The longest losing streak in San Jose Giants team history is 12 games (2000).

O-fer July... The Giants are 0-8 in July. Their last win came on June 30 at Visalia. San Jose lost the final three games of their series to the Rawhide (July 1-3) before getting swept in a five-game set at home against Rancho Cucamonga (July 4-8).

Inside The Record... Last night's loss dropped the Giants (39-49) to a season-high 10 games below .500 overall. San Jose won their 30th game of the season on June 1 (30-25), but have gone just 9-24 (.273) since. The Giants are also just 3-14 in their last 17 home games after starting the season with a 17-10 record at Municipal Stadium. San Jose hasn't won a series since taking two of three at Modesto from June 8-10.

At The Plate... San Jose is now last in the California League with a .248 team batting average this season. The Giants are also last in the league in on-base percentage (.307) and are second in strikeouts (847, 9.6 per game). San Jose's 71 home runs this season lead all North Division clubs and rank third in the league. The Giants have hit 12 home runs over their last nine games. San Jose is batting .236 with runners in scoring position this year (seventh in the league) and .190 w/RISP and two outs (also seventh). The Giants are 5-for-40 (.125 AVG) with runners in scoring position over their last six games.

Van Horn's Power Surge... Brandon Van Horn went deep again last night and has now homered in his last three games played. Van Horn is the first Giants player to homer in three consecutive games this season. His eight homers this season (6 HR last 20 games) are a career-high and rank tied for third on the team.

Second Half Stats... The Giants are off to a 5-13 start in the second half. San Jose is batting only .205 as a team in the second half with a 5.02 ERA. The Giants have hit 20 home runs in 18 second half games.

League Leaderboard... Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is fourth in doubles (23), tied for sixth in hits (93) and sixth in runs scored (49). Gio Brusa is tied for fourth in the league in home runs (13), tenth in RBI's (46) and sixth in slugging (.496). Wander Franco is third in doubles (25) and tenth in hits (89) while Johneshwy Fargas is tied for second in stolen bases (26).

Dobson Returns... Dillon Dobson was added to the Giants roster from Richmond (AA) last Friday. Dobson spent the entire 2017 season in San Jose and ranked second on the team in RBI's (68), third in home runs (15) and fifth in doubles (21). Dobson was batting .185 in 130 at-bats with Richmond this year (5 HR, 12 RBI's).

Close Calls... Last night was the Giants' league-high tying 29th one-run game this season (12-17 record).
