### SNAPPER SNIPPETS

**SNAPPERS ON THE 4TH OF JULY:** Beloit will play on the road on the 4th of July for the 6th year in a row with a visit to Dozer Park. The Snappers are 3-9 on the 4th of July since 2005 through the Twins & Athletics affiliations. Beloit has fallen in their last 3 Independence Day games, but their last win on America's birthday occurred in Peoria with a 3-2 win at Dozer Park in 2013. Two of the Snappers last 3 wins on the 4th of July have come on the road against the Chiefs.

**.500 DAYS OF SUMMER:** With a strong 8-4 start to the Second Half of the season, the Snappers have pulled to within 1 game of .500 on their overall record. Beloit has had the same amount of wins & losses 14 times this season, but they have not been at that point since June 9 when they were 30-30.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Snappers recorded a double play in their 6th straight ballgame & 12th in 12 games of the Second Half on Monday. Their 87 twin killers the 8th-most across all of Minor League Baseball. The Midland RockHounds, the Athletics Double-A affiliate, lead the minors with 106 double plays.

**HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL:** Beloit went through their 4-game series with Wisconsin without reaching 5 runs. The Snappers offense has plated 7 runs or more in 5 games to start the Second Half. Beloit is 27-6 this season when they score at least 5 runs in a game. When both the Snappers & their opponent score 5 runs, Beloit is 9-6.

**GETTING ON BASE:** Kyle Nowlin has delivered 2 crucial hits in the Snappers last 2 games with a game-tying home run on Sunday & the go-ahead RBI double on Monday. He has also walked in 6 of his last 7 games to boost him up to 3rd in the Midwest League in walks. His 18 walks in June were 2nd-most in the league behind 19 by Clinton's Joe Rizzo.

**MARTIN LEADING OFF:** Mike Martin has collected a hit in his last 4 games since returning to the Snappers lineup. Martin now has a hit in his last 10 MWL games is the 5th Beloit batter to have a streak reach double digits, joining Eric Marinez, Edwin Diaz, Nate Mondou, & Miguel Mercedes.

**CLEAN DEFENSE:** The Snappers have not committed an error in their last 2 games, but have not gone 3 straight contests without an error this season.

**CLOSE GAMES:** Beloit's 2-1 win on Monday was their 28th one-run ballgame this season, the tied with Kane County for the most in the Midwest League.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** Xavier Altamirano will take his 3rd trip through the rotation on the 4th of July. Altamirano has received the winning decision in his last 2 starts. Matt Milburn's win last night made him the first Snappers pitcher to win 3 consecutive starts this year.

**FACING THE CHIEFS:** Beloit & Peoria have had 8 of their 11 matchups this season separated by 3 runs or fewer. Snappers hitters Miguel Mercedes & JaVon Shelby each have 3 homers against Chiefs pitching while Snappers pitching struck out 23 batters on May 26 at Dozer Park, the most in a single game during the Athletics era. Peoria carries 4 of the Cardinals top-30 prospects with pitchers Jordan Hicks (#18) & Ronnie Williams (#24) in addition to hitters Dylan Carlson (#16) & Nick Plummer (#22).
