

THUNDER Frequently Asked Questions

When is Thunder Over Louisville?

Saturday, April 22. The Bats game is scheduled to start at 2:05 p.m. and fans with tickets are invited to stay at Slugger Field for all the Thunder activities.

What time do gates open?

Noon

How much are single game Thunder tickets?

Reserved seats are \$30 - \$35. Bleachers are \$30. Lawn Tickets are available for \$20.

Can I leave the stadium and come back on Thunder Day?

Yes, your Thunder Day ticket allows you to come and go from Louisville Slugger Field throughout the day and enjoy all the Waterfront activities. You will receive a wristband that allows you to leave and re-enter from noon until 9:30 p.m.

Are food and drink allowed to be brought into the stadium?

The only outside food and drink allowed into the stadium is one clear plastic bottle of water per person. There are many food options in the stadium or you can exit and re-enter for additional options on the Waterfront or at the local restaurants.

Who is the concert?

The post-game concert this year is Hello Weekend. Unlike any other Chicago cover band, Hello Weekend takes audiences to a whole new level. Not only with their incomparable style and sound but also by performing today's biggest chart topping hits and recreating them flawlessly.

What is a Field Access Pass?

Fans that have an admission ticket for Thunder Day may also purchase a \$5 Field Access Pass. This pass allows fans to sit on the outfield grass of Slugger Field to enjoy the concert, air show and fireworks. Blankets are allowed on the field. Chairs are not allowed on the field or in the stadium. Field access may not be available in the case of inclement weather. In this case, the fee paid for the Field Access Pass will be refunded.

Are backpacks or duffle bags allowed?

Backpacks and small duffle bags are allowed, subject to search upon entry. Blankets, jackets, outerwear, etc. are permitted to be brought into the stadium in backpacks and small duffle bags. Outside food and beverages, with the exception of one clear, sealed bottle of water per person, are not permitted at any time.

Are strollers or wagons allowed?

Strollers are allowed as long as they are left at the top of the seating bowl so as not to block stairways and exits. Wagons are not allowed.

Are chairs or coolers allowed?

No, chairs may not be brought into Louisville Slugger Field. Blankets are allowed for use on the lawn or field. Coolers are prohibited.

Where are the best seats for viewing the fireworks?

The fireworks can be seen best from the first base side of the stadium (Sections 102 – 109) and bleachers, or from the outfield grass by purchasing a Field Access Pass for \$5.

Where is the best parking?

Parking on Thunder Day is a challenge for everyone. Fans arriving early may be able to find street parking, but most fans utilize one of the paid lots (\$15-\$30) operated by the City in the surrounding area.

The season ticket holder lot adjacent to Slugger Field is strictly reserved for Bats FULL season tickets holders holding a valid ticket for the Thunder day game. The lot is scheduled to open at 11:30, but if the line waiting to enter causes any intersections to be blocked, LMPD may dictate that we allow early entry to clear the intersections. All tickets will be checked prior to entry and the lot will fill very quickly.
