**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (12-16) fell to the Tennessee Smokies (17-11) by a 7-4 score in a 7-inning game Smokies Stadium on a cold Saturday night. The game was delayed by an hour and 34 minutes due to rain, and then midgame it was decided that the second game of tonight's scheduled doubleheader would be postponed due to the cold weather and late start caused by the rain delay. Jacksonville starting pitcher Joe Gunkel (0-1) took the loss, allowing four runs (one earned) on five hits with two walks and one strikeout in his four innings of work. Tennessee starter Duane Underwood, Jr. (2-1) earned the win, and he allowed four runs (three earned) on four hits with three strikeouts in his five innings. The game was scoreless until the bottom of the fourth inning. After loading the bases, Yasiel Balaguert's RBI single brought in the first run to give Tennessee a 1-0 lead. It became a 4-0 Smokies advantage two batters later with Ian Rice hitting a two-run homer to left field. Jacksonville responded with a pair of runs in the top of the fifth. When Austin Nola reached on a fielding error by the Tennessee first baseman, David Vidal scored to make it 4-1. Later that inning with the bases loaded Jeremias Pineda was hit by an Underwood pitch to score Nola to put the score at 4-2. Raudel Lazo took over on the mound for Jacksonville and walked four batters, including Jason Vosler with the bases loaded to grow Tennessee's lead to 5-2. Kyle Lobstein took over in relief, and he had a wild pitch during the Ian Rice at-bat that brought in another run to make it 6-2. Tennessee's last run of the night came on a Carlos Penalver sacrifice fly to put the lead at 7-2. Underwood walked the first two batters of the sixth inning before Brad Markey took over on the mound. Jacksonville scored a pair of runs in the inning, with a sacrifice fly from Taylor Ard before Austin Nola's RBI double put the score at 7-4, which would be the final.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Bencomo Marlins MiLB Pitcher of the Month for April:** Bencomo has been named the Miami Marlins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April, announced by the Marlins front office on Friday morning. Bencomo made five stats for the Jumbo Shrimp in April, going 4-0 with a 1.27 ERA. Over his 28 and one-third innings pitched, Bencomo held opponents to a .236 batting average, while striking out 33 batters compared to just five walks. The Jumbo Shrimp have also gone 4-1 in Bencomo's starts, and he hasn't allowed more than two earned runs in any outing this season.

**Roster Moves:** Left-handed relief pitcher Greg Nappo has been transferred from Jacksonville to Triple-A New Orleans. In a corresponding move, right-handed relief Hunter Adkins has been reinstated from Jacksonville's disabled list to the active roster. Adkins was placed on the disabled list on April 30 with a left foot contusion. Adkins has pitched in six games in relief for the Jumbo Shrimp this season, with no wins or losses, one save, and a 5.19 ERA.

**Attendance Kings of Double-A Baseball:** The Jumbo Shrimp have loved being at home, not only with a 7-3 record and series victories over Chattanooga and Mobile, but in terms of attendance as well. Through 10 games the Jumbo Shrimp not only lead the Southern League but also all of Double-A baseball with 70,180 total fans and an average of 7,018 fans. Also in Double-A, the Jumbo Shrimp were the only team to reach 70,000 fans through May 1. In April, Jacksonville ranked eighth in all of Minor League Baseball by bringing in an average of 7,534 fans, and Jacksonville was also 18<sup>th</sup> in total attendance. With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville.

**LAST START:** Bencomo earned his second straight victory by defeating the Mobile BayBears on Saturday April 29 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Bencomo worked five innings where he allowed a run on six hits with two walks and six strikeouts as the Shrimp won 4-2.

**MARLINS MiLB PITCHER OF THE MONTH FOR APRIL:** Bencomo has been named the Miami Marlins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April, announced by the Marlins front office on Friday morning. Bencomo made five stats for the Jumbo Shrimp in April, going 4-0 with a 1.27 ERA. Over his 28 and one-third innings pitched, Bencomo held opponents to a .236 batting average, while striking out 33 batters compared to just five walks. The Jumbo Shrimp have also gone 4-1 in Bencomo's starts, and he hasn't allowed more than two earned runs in any outing this season.

**BARONS WIN:** Bencomo earned his third win of the year on Monday April 24 against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field. Bencomo worked seven and a third innings where he allowed a run on four hits with a walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts. Bencomo's first seven innings were scoreless until he gave up a solo homer to Mason Robbins in the bottom of the eighth. Jacksonville won the game 4-1.

**WAHOOS START:** Bencomo had a no decision in his start on Wednesday April 19 at Pensacola. He worked five innings where he allowed a two runs on eight hits with a walk and seven strikeouts. He left the game with Jacksonville trailing 2-1, and the Wahoos went onto win 7-5 thanks to a four-run bottom of the eighth inning.

**LOOKOUTS WIN:** Bencomo won in his first start in Jacksonville in 2017 on Friday April 14 over the Chattanooga Lookouts at the Baseball Grounds. Bencomo worked six scoreless innings where he only allowed four hits with a walk and six strikeouts in a game that the Jumbo Shrimp won 4-0.

**BRAVES WIN:** Bencomo won his 2017 and Marlins organization debut with a victory on Saturday April 8 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Bencomo turned in five scoreless innings where he allowed three hits on a walk and four strikeouts in a game the Jumbo Shrimp won 6-1.

**VENEZUELAN WINTER LEAGUE:** Following the 2016 season, Bencomo pitched in the Venezuelan Winter League for Bravos de Margarita from October to November. There he was 4-3 with a 4.21 ERA in his 14 starts, with 48 strikeouts in his 68 and a third innings of work.

## #40 OMAR BENCOMO RHP | 6-1,170 lbs | Born: Valencia, Venezuela. Age: 28

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on Feb. 10, 2017

**2016 Highlights:** Bencomo began the 2017 season in the Southern League with the Chattanooga Lookouts, the Double-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. Bencomo went 406 with a 3.86 ERA in 19 appearances and seven starts. That included time against Jacksonville last year, where he earned a save with two scoreless innings on June 7, and a win in a start on August 8 where he pitched five scoreless innings at the Baseball Grounds. Bencomo closed out 2016 with the Rochester Red Wings in the Triple-A International League. With the Red Wings he was 3-1 with a 3.49 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

**2015 Highlights:** Following time in the Tampa Bay Rays system from 2007-2011, Bencomo did not pitch professionally in the United States from 2012-14. In 2015 he pitched for the Wichita Wignuts and the Laredo Lemurs in the independent American Association. With Laredo he went 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA in four starts while with Wichita he was 4-1 with a 3.81 ERA in his nine starts for the Wignuts. He was later signed that season by the Minnesota Twins and closed out the year at High-A Fort Myers. With the Miracle, he was 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in three starts in the Florida State League.

**2011 Highlights:** 2011 was Bencomo's last year in the Tampa Bay organization. With Single-A Bowling Green, he was 4-5 with a 3.97 ERA in 38 games in relief.

**2010 Highlights:** Bencomo spent the 2010 season with Hudson Valley in the New York-Penn League. With the Renegades he was 1-3 with a 4.60 ERA in 15 appearances and three starts.

**2009 Highlights:** Bencomo spent his first season in the United States with the Princeton Rays in the Appalachian League. With Princeton he was 2-1 with a 3.47 ERA in nine starts.

**2008 Highlights:** With the Venezuelan Summer League Rays he was 1-6 with a 4.45 ERA in 15 appearances and eight starts.

**2007 Highlights:** With the Venezuelan Summer League Devil Rays/Reds, Bencomo was 2-3 with a 2.89 ERA in 12 appearances and eight starts.

**TODAY – BACK IN ROTATION:** Jumbo Shrimp right-handed pitcher Chris Mazza returns to Jacksonville's pitching rotation after being in the bullpen during the last series against Mobile. Mazza as a starter is 0-1 with a 3.68 ERA in four starts, compared to being 0-0 with an 18.00 ERA (4 ER/2.0 IP) as a relief pitcher.

**BARONS START:** Mazza took a no decision in his start on Wednesday April 26 at Birmingham. Mazza worked four innings allowing four runs on six hits with three walks and a strikeout. He left with the game with Jacksonville trailing 4-3, and the Shrimp would lose 5-4 thanks to a bottom of the eighth run for Birmingham.

**WAHOOS START:** Mazza had his second straight scoreless outing with a no decision against Pensacola on Friday April 21. Mazza worked seven scoreless innings allowing just three hits with a walk and six strikeouts. After he left the game with the score 0-0, Pensacola scored a pair of runs in the bottom of the eighth to win 2-0.

**LOOKOUTS START:** Mazza had a no decision in his start on Sunday April 16 at the Baseball Grounds against the Chattanooga Lookouts. Mazza turned in six scoreless innings where he only allowed two hits with no walks and six strikeouts. The game was scoreless when he left, and the difference in the game came on a Jonathan Rodriguez solo homer off Tayron Guerrero in the top of the seventh as the Lookouts won 1-0.

**M-BRAVES LOSS:** Mazza took the loss in his first start of the season on Monday April 10 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Mazza worked five innings, allowing five runs on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts as he also allowed two homers. The M-Braves won the rubber match of the series by a 7-4 score.

**2016 with JACKSONVILLE:** Mazza spent most of 2016 in Jacksonville after starting the season with High-A Jupiter, and he was the first Hammerhead to be called up to Jacksonville that hadn't previously played at the Double-A level before. Mazza made his first professional start in an emergency start on May 15 when Jarlin Garcia was called up to the big leagues, and Mazza earned the victory with a five scoreless innings against the Montgomery Biscuits, and remained in the rotation until injury in mid-June.

Signed by the Marlins as a Minor League Free Agent on August 4, 2015.

**2016 Highlights:** Mazza began the season in the bullpen for the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads in the Florida State League. Mazza was 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA in his seven relief outings, collecting eight strikeouts in his 15 innings of work. Mazza was called up to the Suns on May 1, and was the first player called up from High-A to Double-A for the Marlins in 2016. Mazza spent most of 2016 in Jacksonville after starting the season with High-A Jupiter, and he was the first Hammerhead to be called up to Jacksonville that hadn't previously played at the Double-A level before. Mazza made his first professional start in an emergency start on May 15 when Jarlin Garcia was called up to the big leagues, and Mazza earned the victory with a five scoreless innings against the Montgomery Biscuits, and remained in the rotation until injury in mid-June. Following his win against the Shuckers on June 15, Mazza was placed on the disabled list on June 16 with right shoulder tendinitis. Mazza had a rehab assignment in early July with the GCL Marlins, where he was 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA in four appearances and three starts. Mazza returned to the Suns on July 23. All told, Mazza was 6-5 with a 4.16 ERA in 19 appearances and 14 starts with Jacksonville.

**2015 Highlights:** Split the season between the Twins and the Marlins organizations. Mazza had five relief appearances with the GCL Twins with no record and a 0.00 ERA in six innings pitched. With the Cedar Rapids Kernels in the Midwest League, Mazza had no wins or losses and a 9.00 ERA in two games in relief and three innings pitched. Mazza was released by the Twins organization on July 22, 2015. The Miami Marlins signed him as minor league free agent on August 4, 2015, and assigned him to High-A Jupiter. With the Hammerheads, Mazza went 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA in 11 games in relief, striking out 11 batters in 15 innings pitched.

**2014 Highlights:** Mazza spent all of 2014 with Single-A Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League. With the Kernels, Mazza was 4-4 with a 2.79 ERA in 25 games pitched, and struck out 62 batters compared to 11 walks in 48 and a third innings pitched.

**2013 Highlights:** Mazza spent all of 2013 with Single-A Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League. With the Kernels, Mazza had no wins or losses and a 6.23 ERA in seven games pitched in relief with a pair of saves.

**2012 Highlights:** After he was drafted by the Twins, Mazza was 2-1 with a 0.60 ERA in nine relief outings for the GCL Twins. In the Appalachian League with Elizabethton, Mazza was 3-1 with a 3.45 ERA in nine games in relief, striking out 15 batters in his 15 and a third innings pitched.

**College:** Mazza pitched collegiately at Menlo College. Mazza is the program's all-time record holder in triples, saves, and is tied for home runs with an astounding 19. During the 2011 campaign, Mazza helped lead the Oaks to their first ever Conference Title with an impressive team leading .337 batting average, five home runs, and 41 RBIs while accumulating equally imposing stats on the mound, with a team low 2.37 ERA and nine saves. He was the first player ever drafted out of Menlo, although Gino Cimoli (1956-1965, All Star in 1957 with the Brooklyn Dodgers), and Bill Renna (1953-59) have played in the majors.

**Personal:** Mazza was originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 27th round of the 2011 draft out of Menlo College in Atherton, California. Mazza attended Clayton Valley HS in Concord, California, same alma mater as former major leaguers Clyde Mashore and Damon Mashore.
