ABOUT DUSTIN

-A late-bloomer, Beggs topped out at 86 miles per hour on his fastball as a senior at Centennial High School in Georgia. He opted to start his collegiate career at Georgia Perimeter College, where he compiled a 17-5 record, 1.86 ERA, 0.97 WHIP and 178 strikeouts in 150.1 innings over two seasons. Following his sophomore season in which he led his conference in both strikeouts (125) and ERA (1.65), he was drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 17th round of the 2014 draft. However, he decided to transfer to the University of Kentucky.

-Beggs posted a 3.65 ERA and 1.09 WHIP in 14 starts during his first season in Lexington and was drafted again, this time in the 32nd round of the 2015 draft by the New York Mets. He returned to school for his senior season and registered a 9-2 record, 3.01 ERA and 0.95 WHIP before being drafted by Miami in the 16th round of the 2016 draft.

-When Beggs was selected by the Marlins, he became the fifth of seven Kentucky hurlers the organization has drafted from 2012 through 2018.

2019 SEASON

-The first start of the 2019 season for Beggs was limited to just 0.2 innings because of the game getting suspended by rain. Four days later, Beggs came out of the bullpen and allowed one run in three innings on April 10 at Pensacola.

2018 SEASON

-Beggs began the 2018 campaign with Low-A Greensboro before earning a promotion to High-A Jupiter on June 27. He closed the season with Double-A Jacksonville following an August 15 promotion.

-Among Southern League pitchers with at least 20 innings pitched, Beggs had the second-lowest line drive percentage (9.4 percent) and 25th-highest ground ball percentage (53.1 percent).

2017 SEASON

-Beggs went 5-4 with a 3.09 ERA in 13 first-half starts (75.2 IP, 72 H, 14 BB, 53 K). However, in 13 starts in the second half, he slipped to 5-2 with a 4.64 ERA (73.2 IP, 78 H, 17 BB, 54 K).

-In 213 plate appearances with runners in scoring position, Beggs yielded an .865 OPS. However, in 151 plate appearances with the bases empty, his opposing OPS was .601.

2016 SEASON

-After posting a 3.60 ERA in the first half of the campaign (15.0 IP, 17 H, 5 BB, 10 K) with Short Season Class A Batavia, Beggs surrendered a 6.75 mark in the second half (16.0 IP, 25 H, 0 BB, 10 K).

-Beggs came out of the bullpen for each of first 13 outings with Batavia but made starts for his first three appearances of the season. He was 0-2 with a 6.55 ERA as a starter (11 IP, 19 H, 0 BB, 5 K) and 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (20.0 IP, 23 H, 5 BB, 15 K) as a reliever.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Beggs became the first player in Kentucky history to win his first seven starts of a season. His 16 career victories in his two years with the Wildcats are the second-most wins ever by a two-year player. His career winning percentage of .727 ranks third in school history and his 3.32 ERA places seventh.

-Honored on the SEC All-Defensive Team as a senior in 2016, Beggs did not yield a stolen base all season and picked off nine baserunners, leading the SEC in that category.

-Dustin's father Rick played junior college baseball in California and Dustin's grandfather was drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates.
