TODAY'S GAME: Your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes go for the sweep against the Lake Elsinore Storm (San Diego Padres affiliate) of the South Division tonight in the final game of a three-game set. It's a Thirsty Thursday at LoanMart Field, thanks to Bernards, as fans can enjoy drink specials throughout the night, featuring \$2 Pepsi products, \$3 16-oz domestic drafts, \$4 16-oz premium drafts, wine, champagne and margaritas. This series marks the beginning of a seven-game home stand for the Quakes as they will play the Visalia Rawhide in four games from May 19th-22nd following the Lake Elsinore series. The Quakes just finished a seven-game road trip up north against San Jose and Visalia where they went 5-2 and won both series.

VS LAKE ELSINORE: The Quakes are 5-3 against Lake Elsinore this season following a win last night. After the Quakes swept the Storm at home during their first meeting (April 13th-15th), the Storm returned the favor by sweeping the Quakes in Lake Elsinore (May 1st-3rd). This is the ninth of 29 games between the two teams this season.

QUAKES' PITCHING CONTINUES DOMINANCE IN REHABBER-BACKED WIN: Dennis Santana led the Quakes to a fifth straight win with a stellar start in a 5-2 win last night. Santana (3-3) threw five innings, only surrendering one unearned run on four hits while striking out five and walking two. Andrew Istler earned his third save of the season with a scoreless ninth inning and ended the game by rolling a double-play ball. Dodger rehabber Adrian Gonzalez ripped a two-run double down the right field line in the third inning and scored from first with the bases loaded on DJ Peters' single that cleared the bags after an error in centerfield in the fifth. Rancho's eight hits marked the first time in their five-game winning streak that they had more than four hits on the offensive side.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: Today, both RHP Kevin Brown and RHP Dennis Santana were placed on the DL. The Quakes added RHP James Carter (who threw one and two-thirds innings of one-run baseball for the Quakes on April 9th) from Extended Spring Training in Arizona and LHP Jeremy Bleich from Triple-A Oklahoma City, where he made four appearances and went 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA. Yesterday, outfielder Ariel Sandoval was placed on the seven-day DL. Outfielder Logan Landon also rejoined the Quakes from Extended Spring Training via Triple-A Oklahoma City, where he went 1-for-5 with three walks and a run scored in two games.

QUAKES SAY GOODBYE TO TWO DODGER REHABBERS: Dodger infielders Logan Forsythe and Adrian Gonzalez made rehab starts for the Quakes again yesterday, brought to you by San Manuel Casino. Forsythe, who is coming off of an injured his right hamstring on May 3rd while on a rehab assignment with Rancho, went 1-for-3 yesterday, but Gonzalez stole the show. Gonzalez was put on the 10-day DL on May 5th with right elbow soreness and last night, he went 3-for-4 with two doubles, two RBIs and a run scored. Gonzalez was activated today by the Dodgers while Logan Forsythe still remains on the DL.

QUAKES STAFF CONTINUES TO EXCEL IN WINNING STREAK: The Quakes' pitching staff has been rather unbelievable over the last five games. The Quakes have an ERA of 1.40 over that span and in the last 10 games, where the team is 8-2, Rancho owns a 2.00 ERA.

QUAKES TAKE OVER IN THE CAL LEAGUE: With the current five-game winning streak for the Quakes and a slide by the Modesto Nuts, the Quakes now have the best record in the California League at 23-17. The Quakes have held first place for 37 consecutive days.

DEAN KREMER TAKES THE BALL FOR RANCHO: Dean Kremer, a native of Stockton, CA, will get the start for the Quakes in the final game of the series. Kremer looks to back up a strong, but brief start against Visalia to start the winning streak on May 13th. Kremer just lasted two and two-thirds scoreless innings, allowing one hit and striking out two while walking three and hitting a batter. Kremer was a 14th round selection of the Dodgers in last year's draft out of UNLV and split his time between Rookie-Level Ogden (where he was a starter) and Class-A Great Lakes (where he worked out of the bullpen). For the Loons, he was instrumental in their run to a Midwest League title. During the post-season, he threw 11 and a third innings out of the bullpen, only surrendering one run on eight hits while striking out six and only walking one. Kremer spent the early part of 2017 as a member of Israel's national team that competed in the World Baseball Classic. He was the youngest player on the team at 21 years old and pitched a scoreless ninth inning in the qualifying game against Great Britain.

OPPOSING PITCHER: Eric Lauer will take the hill for the Storm in game three. The left-hander has not received the run-support that he has needed to win games, but he has pitched well. In his last start, he threw five innings, only giving up one unearned run on five hits while striking out seven and walking one against Modesto on May 12th. In his six starts, the Storm are just averaging three runs-per-game on offense, but many of those runs have been scored late in the games. Lauer was the first round selection by the Padres out of Kent State in 2016. The Elyria, OH native is the number eight prospect in the Padres organization according to MLB Pipeline.com.
