Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (24-30) defeated the Pensacola Blue Wahoos (30-24) by a 7-2 score in the fourth game of the five-game series at Blue Wahoos Stadium on Friday night. Jacksonville starting pitcher and reigning Southern League Pitcher of the Week Mike Kickham (2-3) earned the victory, as he worked seven innings allowing only one run on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts. Wahoos starter Deck McGuire (5-3) saw his four-start winning streak come to an end, allowing five runs on six hits with two walks and seven strikeouts. The Shrimp started the scoring with a pair of runs in the top of the second. John Norwood doubled to start the inning, and then was brought home on a sacrifice fly from Taylor Ard to put the score at 1-0. Yefri Perez added to the lead with an RBI triple to put the score at 2-0. Austin Nola grew the lead in the fourth inning with a solo home run over the left field wall to put the lead at 3-0. Two innings later Brian Anderson brought in two runs on his triple to grow the lead at 5-0 in the fifth. Anderson continued his great night in the seventh inning with a two-run homer to left, growing the lead to 7-0. The Wahoos started the bottom of the seventh with an Angelo Gumbs triple, and he was brought home on a groundout by Joe Hudson to put the score at 7-1. Pensacola added another run when Leon Landy scored while Blake Trahan hit into a double play to put the score at 7-2, which would be the final. Esmerling De La Rosa worked the final two innings in relief for Jacksonville to preserve the win. The victory evens the series at two games apiece, and tomorrow's matchup will be a rubber match as Jacksonville looks for its first road series victory in 2017

Road Series Victory: Today gives the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp an opportunity for their first road series victory in 2017. So far this year, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost their five previous road series, in trips to Mississippi, Pensacola, Birmingham, Tennessee, and Mobile. With this fifth game of the series a rubber match, the Jumbo Shrimp have been 0-3 in road rubber matches that could've given the Jumbo Shrimp a road series win. While Jacksonville is 0-5 in series on the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have enjoyed a home field advantage, going 4-1 in their five home series.

Anderson's Big Night: Last night was one of the most productive nights at the plate for a Jumbo Shrimp batter, as Brian Anderson went 3-for-5 with a home run, a triple, and he drove in four runs against the Blue Wahoos. Last year Anderson had just one four RBI game, on July 9 for Jacksonville against Birmingham where he was 3-for-5 with a home run. The four RBI night also matched a career high from 2015 when he had two four-RBI performances with the Jupiter Hammerheads. Anderson is now third in the league with 36 RBI, one behind Tennessee's Jason Vosler, and two behind Mississippi's Carlos Franco. Anderson is the Marlins No. 3 prospect according to MLB.com, and the 2016 Marlins Minor League Player of the Week.

Goodbye Wahoos, It Won't Be Long: Today wraps up the second series of the year between the Jumbo Shrimp and their in-state rivals, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. This is the second and final trip of the year to Pensacola, where in mid-April the Wahoos swept the Jumbo Shrimp. All of the losses were decided by three runs or less. The Wahoos will be in Jacksonville from June 14-18, and at the end of the year from August 31 to Sept. 4.



Signed by the Marlins as a Minor League Free Agent on August 4, 2015.

**2016 Highlights:** Mazza began the season in the bullpen for the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads in the Florida State League. Mazza was 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA in his seven relief outings, collecting eight strikeouts in his 15 innings of work. Mazza was called up to the Suns on May 1, and was the first player called up from High-A to Double-A for the Marlins in 2016. Mazza spent most of 2016 in Jacksonville after starting the season with High-A Jupiter, and he was the first player called up to Jacksonville that hadn't previously played at the Double-A level before. Mazza made his first professional start in an emergency start on May 15 when Jarlin Garcia was called up to the big leagues, and Mazza earned the victory with a five scoreless innings against the Montgomery Biscuits, and remained in the rotation until injury in mid-June. Following his win against the Shuckers on June 15, Mazza was placed on the disabled list on June 16 with right shoulder tendinitis. Mazza had a rehab assignment in early July with the GCL Marlins, where he was 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA in four appearances and 14 starts with Jacksonville.

2015 Highlights: Split the season between the Twins and the Marlins organizations. Mazza had five relief appearances with the GCL Twins with no record and a 0.00 ERA in six innings pitched. With the Cedar Rapids Kernels in the Midwest League, Mazza had no wins or losses and a 9.00 ERA in two games in relief and three innings pitched. Mazza was released by the Twins organization on July 22, 2015. The Miami Marlins signed him as minor league free agent on August 4, 2015, and assigned him to High-A Jupiter. With the Hammerheads, Mazza went 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA in 11 games in relief, striking out 11 batters in 15 innings pitched.

Hammerheads, Mazza went 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA in 11 games in relief, striking out 11 batters in 15 innings pitched. **2014 Highlights:** Mazza spent all of 2014 with Single-A Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League. With the Kernels, Mazza was 4-4 with a 279 ERA in 25 games pitched, and struck out 62 batters compared to 11 walks in 48 and a third innings pitched.

2013 Highlights: Mazza spent all of 2013 with Single-A Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League. With the Kernels, Mazza had no wins or losses and a 6.23 ERA in seven games pitched in relief with a pair of saves.

**2012 Highlights**: After he was drafted by the Twins, Mazza was 2-1 with a 0.60 ERA in nine relief outings for the GCL Twins. In the Appalachian League with Elizabethton, Mazza was 3-1 with a 3.45 ERA in nine games in relief, striking out 15 batters in his 15 and a third innings pitched.

College: Mazza pitched collegiately at Menlo College. Mazza is the program's all-time record holder in triples, saves, and is tied for home runs with an astounding 19. During the 2011 campaign, Mazza helped lead the Oaks to their first ever Conference Title with an impressive team leading .337 batting average, five home runs, and 41 RBIs while accumulating equally imposing stats on the mound, with a team low 2.37 ERA and nine saves. He was the first player ever drafted out of Menlo, although Gino Cimoli (1956-1965, All Star in 1957 with the Brooklyn Dodgers), and Bill Renna (1953-59) have played in the majors.

Personal: Mazza was originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 27th round of the 2011 draft out of Menlo College in Atherton, California. Mazza attended Clayton Valley HS in Concord, California, same alma mater as former major leaguers Clyde Mashore and Damon Mashore.
