RUBBER GAME: The Portland Sea Dogs and Hartford Yard Goats (Rockies affiliate) play the rubber match-up of their three-game set on Wednesday night at Hadlock Field...With a win tonight, the 'Dogs will clinch their second straight series win at home...Starting tomorrow night, the Sea Dogs open up a nine-game trip over eight days in Reading...RHP **Tanner Houck** makes his second start of the season against the Yard Goats.

GOATS SHUT DOWN THE 'DOGS: **Jack Wynkoop** (3-5) worked six scoreless frames on four hits and seven strikeouts, leading Hartford to an 8-0 win on Tuesday night...Hartford scored three times in the second inning against losing pitcher **Denyi Reyes** (0-5)...**Manny Melendez** led the charge, going 3-for-6, 3 RBI...**Alan Trejo** led off the fifth inning with his fifth homer of the season...Portland had five hits, receiving doubles from **Bobby Dalbec** and **Tate Matheny**.

EXTRA, EXTRA: **Brett Netzer** went 2-for-4 in the series opener with an RBI triple (first in Double) and a double in the eighth...Netzer's last four hits are extra-base hits: 2 doubles, homer, and a triple.

MORE ON DALBEC: Dalbec hit three homers last Saturday night in Trenton, the first three-homer game in team history as a Red Sox affiliate...On Monday, Dalbec was named the Eastern League Player of the Week, hitting .500 (8-for-16) with four homers and 7 RBI.

CAREER HIGH, PART TWO: **Durbin Feltman** has pitched two innings in back-to-back starts, closing the game out on Tuesday night...Feltman yielded three hits, one run, and fanned three.

ICYMI: On April 25th in Binghamton, the Sea Dogs threw their fourth no-hitter in team history...The 9-inning no-hitter was the first as a Red Sox affiliate...Hart (6.2 IP), McGrath (1.1 IP), and RHP **Adam Lau** (1 IP) accomplished the feat.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland has lost all three season-series to the Hartford Yard Goats...Hartford joined the Eastern League in 2016 after moving from New Britain.

LOOK BACK AT 2018: Spent the entire season with High-A Salem...Ranked among club leaders with 111 SO (2nd), 119.0 IP (2nd), 23 starts (T-2nd), and 7 wins (3rd)...Limited opponents to a .203 AVG with RISP during the campaign...Posted a 2.86 ERA (22 ER/69.1 IP) over his final 12 starts (6/14-8/14)...Logged 5.0+ IP in each of his last 8 starts, 6.0+ IP in 6, and 7.0+ IP in 2...Placed on the DL on 8/18 with left chest/ back/spine/ribcage inflammation and missed the rest of the season.

CAREER/PERSONAL NOTES: Was named by Baseball America as the No. 8 college prospect available in the 2017 June Draft...Received American Baseball Coaches Association All-Region honors in 2016 and was selected to the All-SEC Freshman Team in 2015...Was drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays out of high school in 2014 but elected to attend the University of Missouri...Ranked 2nd among 3-year players in school history with 292 SO, trailing Kyle Gibson (304 from 2007-09)...Became the 2nd pitcher to throw at least 300 innings in 3 seasons at Missouri...Graduated from Collinsville (IL) High School.
