**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (12-16) fell to the Biloxi Shuckers (19-10) by a 1-0 score in the fourth game of the five-game series at MGM Park on Saturday night. Jacksonville right-handed starting pitcher Cody Poteet (2-2) took the loss, allowing a run on four hits with four walks and six strikeouts. Biloxi right-handed relief pitcher Wulder Rodriguez (1-1) earned the win, tossing two scoreless innings with a walk and a strikeout. Biloxi left-handed relief pitcher Quintin Torres-Costa earned his second save of the season by working the final inning and a third in scoreless fashion to complete the shutout. Biloxi's lone run came in the bottom of the third with an RBI double by Corey Ray to take a 1-0 lead, which would be the final score. Biloxi right-handed starting pitcher Adrian Houser had a no decision, working the first four innings in scoreless fashion with two hits allowed and six strikeouts. Milwaukee Brewers pitchers Boone Logan and Corey Knebel both combined to work a scoreless inning and two-thirds in their major league rehab appearances with the Shuckers. The game marked the third time the season the Jumbo Shrimp were shut out in a game, with all shutout losses being 1-0 scores. Jacksonville only had three hits in the loss, and the Shrimp left six men on base in the game.

### NEWS AND NOTES

**Tight Games for Shrimp:** The last 12 games for the Jumbo Shrimp have been decided by two runs or less, a stretch that began on April 23 at Tennessee. In that stretch, Jacksonville is 6-6 in those games. Additionally, of the last 12 games, 9 of those have been one-run ballgames, with the Shrimp going 4-5 during those one run ballgames. The last game that Jacksonville won by more than two runs was April 22 at Tennessee, winning 11-5, and the last game that Jacksonville lost by more than two runs was at Chattanooga on April 18, falling in Game One of a doubleheader 12-4.

**DUUUVAL Starts for Shrimp:** Today is DUUUVAL Day, as Jumbo Shrimp fan favorite Max Duval starts the final game of the series in Biloxi. Duval earned his first Double-A victory in his "Duval County" debut on Monday April 30 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Duval turned in five innings where he allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts as Jacksonville won the final game of the series 5-3. Overall, Duval is 1-2 with a 6.30 ERA in his five starts for Jacksonville.

**Goodbye for Now, Shuckers:** Today's game wraps up the first of four series this season between Jacksonville and Biloxi. The next two meetings will be in Jacksonville from June 8-12 and in the second half from July 12-16. The Jumbo Shrimp will not make a return trip to Biloxi until August 6-12. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp and Shuckers played five series, with Jacksonville going 9-15 in those games. That included a 6-9 record in Biloxi, and the Shrimp were 3-6 against the Shuckers in Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp did win their last series here in late August, including a key doubleheader sweep on August 30 that shrunk Jacksonville's magic number to clinch the second half South Division title from five to one, and the Shrimp clinched a playoff berth the next day with a win at home against the Blue Wahoos.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months. Today Neidert starts for the Jumbo Shrimp against the Shuckers in Biloxi, and he carries a 2-1 record with a 4.12 ERA into his fifth start of the season.

**LAST START:** Duval earned his first Double-A victory in his "Duval County" debut on Monday April 30 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Duval turned in five innings where he allowed two runs (one earned) on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts as Jacksonville won the final game of the series 5-3.

**SMOKIES LOSS:** Duval suffered his second straight loss in his start on Monday April 23 at Tennessee against the Smokies. Duval turned in six innings where he allowed two runs (all earned) on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts. The only runs allowed were on a first inning two-run home run by Jeffrey Baez, and the final five innings for Duval were scoreless, as Jacksonville lost 2-1.

**LOOKOUTS LOSS:** Duval suffered a loss in his start on Wednesday April 18 in Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader at Chattanooga. Duval worked four innings, allowing nine runs on 11 hits with a walk, three homers allowed, and three strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 12-4

**#43 MAX DUVAL RHP | 6-5, 235 lbs | Born: April. 15, 1991 in San Luis Obispo, California. 27 years old.**

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on July 28, 2017.

**2017 Highlights:** Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League. With Evansville, Duval went 8-2 with a 2.28 ERA in 14 starts, striking out 113 batters in 87 innings of work and he won the 2017 Frontier League Brian Tollberg Award for Most Valuable Pitcher, and he was also a Frontier League All-Star. After he signed with the Marlins on July 28, he went 4-0 with a 2.09 ERA in six starts for the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. Came within two outs of a seven inning perfect game on August 9, 2017. He retired the first 19 batters he faced before ultimately allowing a run on two hits with seven strikeouts in a complete game win.

**2016 Highlights:** Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League, where he was 4-1 with a 4.40 ERA in seven starts. Signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks as a minor league free agent on June 23, 2016. Pitched at four different levels of the Diamondbacks organization, making one relief outing with High-A Visalia where he was 1-0 with a 9.64 ERA, going 2-6 with a 3.02 ERA in 10 starts for the Single-A Kane County Cougars, then with Short Season Class A Hillsboro had no wins or losses and a 7.36 ERA in two appearances and one start, then also two appearances and a start for the AZL Diamondbacks, going 1-1 with a 1.13 ERA in two appearances and one start. All of his moving around different affiliates mainly happened in a 14-day span in late June and early July.

**2015 Highlights:** Split the season pitching in the Frontier League, making four appearances with the Schaumburg Boomers where he had no wins or losses and a 13.50 ERA. He also pitched for the Frontier Greys, where he was 1-3 with a 3.51 ERA in 15 appearances and eight starts. The Greys were a team that played strictly road games in the Frontier League, hence the name Greys after the traditional road jersey color.

**2014 Highlights:** Duval made his professional baseball debut pitching for the Schaumburg Boomers in the independent Frontier League, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA in three relief outings.

**College:** Started college career at Cuesta College before transferring to Hawaii for his junior season. At Hawaii in 2012 he hit .186 with one home run and 18 RBI as an infielder. At the plate in 2013, Duval hit .192 with no homers and 3 RBI. He also pitched that season, with no wins or losses and a 6.48 ERA in six games in relief. After college considered quitting baseball but mom encouraged him to keep playing, which landed him in independent baseball to give pitching a real chance.
