FAMILIAR FRIEND IN TOWN: Lefty **Brian Johnson**, a member of the 2014 team, makes a Major League Rehab in tonight's game against the Trenton Thunder at Arm & Hammer Park...LHP **Darwinzon Hernandez**, who was scheduled to start tonight, follows Johnson...The Sea Dogs have lost eight straight and 10 in a row on the road... Following this series, the 'Dogs return home on Friday night to open up a four-game series against the Altoona Curve (Pirates affiliate).

DROPPED A PAIR: Trenton grabbed a twinbill from Portland on Monday, 6-2 and 4-3...In the opener, **Jhon Nunez** went 2-for-2 with a homer, triple, walk, and two runs scored...Thunder RF **Ben Ruta's** three-run homer off LHP **Dominic LoBrutto** (L, 0-1) proved to be the game-winning hit...In game two, **Jeremy Rivera** and **Josh Tobias** each went 2-for-4 with an RBI double...**Deivi Garcia** (W, 2-2) tossed six strong innings on five hits and two runs.

TOUGH STRETCH: The 'Dogs have lost 11 of their last 12 games and three straight series...The previous 14 starting pitchers against Portland have gone a combined: 8-1, 1.55 ERA (13 ER/75.2 IP), 58 H, 13 R, 13 ER, 20 BB, 73 SO.

BASHIN' BOBBY: **Bobby Dalbec** went 1-for-6, RBI and a walk in Monday's doubleheader and has hit safely in 12 of his previous 16 games: 18-for-58, 5 HR, 14 RBI...Dalbec hit three homers on May 11th in Trenton.

HISTORY BOOKS: Johnson joins **Dustin Pedroia** to rehab with Portland this season... Johnson is the 54th Major League rehab in team history (47th as a Red Sox affiliate)... In 2014, the lefty posted a 1.75 ERA which still stands as the best ERA in a single season for Portland.

ICYMI: On April 25th in Binghamton, the Sea Dogs threw their fourth no-hitter in team history...The 9-inning no-hitter was the first as a Red Sox affiliate...**Kyle Hart** (6.2 IP), **Daniel McGrath** (1.1 IP), and RHP **Adam Lau** (1 IP) accomplished the feat.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland has lost all nine games to Trenton this year, including five at Arm & Hammer Park...The Sea Dogs are 7-13-15 in season series All-Time against the Thunder.

FACING TRENTON: Third career start...0-0, 3.00 ERA (3 ER/9.0)

DID YOU KNOW: Posted a franchise single-season best 1.75 ERA with Portland in 2014...Went 10-2, 1.75 ERA in 20 games/20 starts with the 'Dogs in '14...Teammates with current Sea Dog **Josh Tobias** at Florida.

LOOK BACK AT 2018: Made his 1st career Opening Day roster and spent the entire season with Boston...Over 38 appearances (13 starts), went 4-5 with a 4.17 ERA (46 ER/99.1 IP)... Earned the Unsung Hero Award from the Boston Baseball Writers... Became the 1st Sox pitcher to make 13+ starts and 25+ relief appearances in a season since Tim Wakefield did so in each season from 1999-2002... Following the season, pitched for the MLB team in the 6-game Japan All-Star Series in November...Pitched in relief in Game 2 on 11/10 and started Game 6 on 11/15.

CAREER/PERSONAL NOTES: Went 22-12 with a 3.85 ERA (104 ER/243.1 IP) and 196 strikeouts in 49 games (46 GS) over 3 seasons at Florida, and hit .324 AVG (155-for-478) with 29 doubles, 3 triples, 15 homers, and 91 RBI... Selected as a 2nd-Team Louisville Slugger All-American, earned his 2nd straight 1st-Team All-SEC selection...Member of USA Collegiate National Team in 2010 and 2011, while playing with Yarmouth-Dennis of the Cape Cod League in 2011... Named Florida Today Player of the Year and Brevard County Player of the Year as a junior in 2008 at Cocoa Beach High School.
