**TODAY'S GAME:** The M-Braves continue an 11-game homestand at Trustmark Park in ten days, and play game three of a five-game series against the Birmingham Barons (1-1) on Thursday night. The M-Braves went 2-3 against the Barons in a five-game set in Birmingham, May 16-20. The M-Braves will host Pensacola for six games in five days on the back end of the homestand, Sunday Aug. 18 through Thursday, Aug. 22.

**M:** All-time the M-Braves are 114-103 vs. Birmingham since 2005, and 60-42 in games played at Trustmark Park.

**SWEET HOME TRUSTMARK PARK:** The M-Braves close out the season with 16 of their final 21 games at Trustmark Park. The 21-game stretch in 21 days will include five games with Birmingham, six with Pensacola, five at Biloxi and five back home with Chattanooga to close out the season. The M-Braves are 28-28 at home this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The M-Braves posted their 14th shutout of the season, 4-0, on Wednesday afternoon at Trustmark Park with RHP Jasseel De La Cruz leading the way with 5.0 one-hit innings and picking up the win. Trey Harris and C Jonathan Morales each collected two hits and DH William Contreras added a solo home run in the victory. RHP Kurt Hoekstra, RHP Bradley Roney and LHP Thomas Burrows helped combine for the two-hit shutout.

**THREE MILLION FANS:** The M-Braves celebrated the 3 millionth fan for Braves baseball at Trustmark Park on Wednesday. Clinton, MS native Matt Baker (and son Wyatt attending his first game) was the 3 millionth fan and was given a prize pack that included 2020 M-Braves Season Tickets and 2020 Atlanta Braves tickets.

**BULLPEN GETTING IT DONE:** With the loss of four starting pitchers since July 31, the M-Braves bullpen has been thrust into more action. The 'pen has answered the bell with a 1.91 ERA (12 ER/56.2 IP) so far in August with 45 strikeouts and 31 walks. The bullpen has recorded 56.2 innings this month and starters 47.1.

**M:** The M-Braves rank 2nd in the league this season with an overall 3.16 ERA and have allowed the fewest number of earned runs (362). The pitching staff also ranks 2nd in the league so far in August with a 2.51 ERA.

**DIDDER SETTING THE TABLE:** INF/OF Ray-Patrick Didder has a .386 OBP and is 16-for-17 in SB opportunities so far in 43 games during the second-half of the season with six doubles, a home run, eight RBI and 20 walks. He now ranks 5th in the league with 23 stolen bases and 2nd in HBP (15). He has been HBP 114 times in his career and 102 times since the 2015 season.

**HARRIS ON A 13-GAME ON-BASE STREAK:** OF Trey Harris currently is on a 13-game on-base streak, hitting in 12 of them, beginning on July 29, batting .360 (18-for-50) with a home run, three doubles, two triples, three RBI, six runs and .396 OBP.

**CASTEEL CLEANING UP:** 28-year-old 1B Ryan Casteel has found a home in the cleanup spot and leads the club and ranks 3rd in the league with 19 home runs and three multi-homer games. His three-homer game on July 3 was the first in M-Braves history. He ranks among the league leaders in RBI (64, 3rd), slugging (.487, 4th), OPS (.831, 5th), HR (19, 3rd), RBI, XBH (37, T-7th) and TB (171, 6th). Casteel has already moved into 7th place on the M-Braves all-time home run list and with one more home run would become just the second M-Brave to record 20 homers in a season, joining Ernesto Mejia (26) who did it in 2011.

**NEW LOOK M-BRAVES:** The Mississippi Braves roster was overhauled on Aug. 4-5 by the Atlanta Braves with 14 roster moves. The Braves promoted No. 1 prospect OF Cristian Pache, No. 2 prospect OF Drew Waters, No. 3 prospect RHP Ian Anderson and No. 13 prospect LHP Tucker Davidson to Triple-A Gwinnett. LHP Thomas Burrows, OF Connor Lien, C Jonathan Morales and INF Riley Unroe were transferred to Mississippi from Triple-A Gwinnett. RHP Nolan Kingham was promoted to Mississippi from High-A Florida and INF Luis Valenzuela was released. The day prior, LHP Kyle Muller was placed on the 7-day injured list with a right calf strain, RHP Josh Rowen was transferred to Mississippi from Triple-A Gwinnett, RHP Jonathan Aro was transferred back to Mississippi from High-A Florida and RHP Brandon White was transferred to High-A Florida from Mississippi.

**MULTI-HOMER GAMES:** Wednesday's multi-homer games from Ryan Casteel and C.J. Alexander marked the first time in team history that two M-Braves recorded multi-homers in the same game. Casteel leads the M-Braves with three multi-homer games this season. Overall this season, Mississippi has notched a club record eight multi-homer games this season.

**JULY PLAYERS OF THE MONTH:** M-Braves OF Greyson Jenista and LHP Tucker Davidson were named the Mississippi Braves Players of the Month for July. Jenista hit .333 (27-for-81) over his first full month at the Double-A level with three doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, 10 runs, nine walks, two stolen bases and a .402 OBP. Davidson was 3-1 with a 2.57 ERA (8 ER/28.0 IP), seven walks, 33 strikeouts and a .232 opponents' AVG.

**HISTORY MADE ON JUNE 28:** Ian Anderson and Jeremy Walker's combined nine-inning no-hitter on Friday, June 28 vs. Jackson was the third no-hitter in team history. The last was a combined no-hitter from Julio Teheran and Tyrelle Harris on Aug. 2, 2010 vs. Mobile. The first, and only individual no-hitter came from the late Tommy Hanson on June 25, 2008, vs. Birmingham. Anderson's 14 strikeouts over 7.0 innings in the game matched Hanson's single-game team record set in the same game.

**MADE IN MISSISSIPPI:** OF Travis Demeritte made his MLB debut for the Detroit Tigers on August 2 at Texas becoming with 146th M-Braves alum to move to make their Major League debut. LHP Jeremy Walker 7/26/19, RHP Huascar Ynoa (6/16/19), OF Austin Riley (5/15/19), C Alex Jackson (4/7/19) and RHP Jacob Webb (4/16/19) have all made MLB debuts this season.

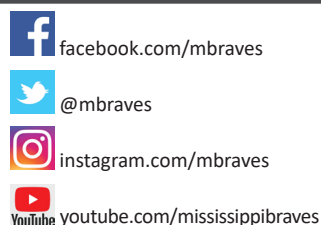

TODAY'S GAME

• Pfeifer makes his third M-Braves start and 10th appearance for the M-Braves tonight in game three of the series against Birmingham. Pfeifer was 4-6 with a 3.23 ERA over 16 games and 14 starts, 110 strikeouts, 23 walks for Florida before returning to Mississippi on Aug. 1.

• This is Pfeifer's 61st appearance and third start over parts of four seasons with the M-Braves. He is 3-5 with a 3.52 ERA, 108 strikeouts, 64 walks and three saves.

• vs. Birmingham: Pfeifer has appeared in one game against Birmingham each of the past three seasons, posting no record and a 9.00 ERA, allowing two earned runs in 2.0 innings with four strikeouts and three walks.

LAST TIME OUT

• Pfeifer suffered the loss in Mississippi's 2-1 setback at Jacksonville last Friday, allowing two runs on two hits, including a Bryson Brigman second-inning home run, walking four and striking out six over 5.0 innings.

ACQUIRED

• Acquired by the Braves along with RHP Caleb Dirks from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for RHP Bud Norris, OF Dian Toscano, a player to be named later (RHP Alex Grosser) and cash considerations on June 30, 2016.

2019 SEASON

• Began the 2019 season on the M-Braves roster, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP) with 10 walks and 7 strikeouts over 7 games between April 6 and April 27.

• Transferred to High-A Florida on April 29 and pitched for the FireFrogs from May 3 to July 30, going 4-6 with a 3.23 ERA (33 ER/92.0 IP), 110 strikeouts and 23 walks, posting a 1.13 WHIP and 10.8 SO/9IP.

• Set a Fire Frogs record and posted a career high 17 strikeouts on July 18 at Palm Beach, walking none over 8.0 innings of three-hit, shutout baseball, throwing just 94 pitches.

• Went 3-0 with a 1.13 ERA (4 ER/32.0 IP) in 5 games, 4 starts in July, striking out 44 and walking just 4.

• Transferred back to Mississippi on August 1.

• Has appeared in 58 games over parts of four seasons in Mississippi.

• Earned first win on 4/17 at Chattanooga with 2.1 innings of one-run baseball.

• Split his second consecutive season between Triple-A Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi, posting a 2-3 record and a 5.73 ERA (35 ER/55.0 IP) in 39 games between the two clubs...Made one start.
