SNAPPER SNIPPETS **HOT OFF THE BUS:** The Snappers embark on their 5th road trip of the season in Peoria on Thursday. In road trip opening games, Beloit is 3-1. The Snappers have won their last 2 road series by taking 2 of 3 both in Lake County & Fort Wayne.

.500 DAYS OF SUMMER: Wednesday's win gave Beloit the same amount of wins & losses for the 7th time this season. The last time the Snappers were above the .500 mark was after the 3rd game of the season & they were 2-1 after winning their first road game of the season at Cedar Rapids.

START FAST: Beloit played their first 17 games of the season without scoring in the first inning. After a 4 run first frame on Wednesday, the Snappers have now scored in the first inning in 5 of their last 6 contests. Beloit has a record of 6-4 on the year when they put up at least 1 run in the first.

HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL: After racking up 7 more runs on Wednesday, Beloit is now 16-2 when they score 5 runs or more. The 7-6 win on Wednesday was the 4th game Beloit has played this season with that final score & the most common score for a Snappers game this year. The Snappers are 6-10 in games that they allow 5 runs or more & are 6-2 in contests that both teams reach 5 runs.

TWO BIRDS, ONE STONE: The Snappers have turned a Midwest League-best 45 double plays this season. That total is the 3rd-highest total in all of Minor League Baseball. The Athletics Double-A affiliate in Midland (Texas League) has turned the most with 52, the San Jose Giants (California League) have converted 46, & the Rome Braves (South Atlantic League) have also executed 45 twin killers in 2017. On the flip side, the Snappers have grounded into the most double plays in the Midwest League.

.300 HITTERS: Two of the Snappers most consistent hitters this season have been Nate Mondou & Luke Persico. They sit 2nd & 4th in the A's organization in batting average respectively with 11 multi-hit games each after Persico had 3 knocks on Wednesday. Persico is batting .361 since April 20 after starting the season with an .045 average over his first 6 games with Beloit. Mondou has been on base in all but 2 games this season & has gotten aboard in his last 11 after a 20-game on-base streak earlier in the year.

TODAY'S PITCHERS: Beloit will use the piggy-back duo of Brandon Bailey & Matt Milburn. This tandem has been used 6 times before Thursday's contest. Bailey moved off the Snappers DL today & has allowed just 2 runs over his previous 18 IP before landing on the DL. Milburn is coming off his finest outing of the season on Friday in Fort Wayne. The Dallas native threw 4 scoreless innings & fanned a career-high 6 TinCaps.

FACING THE CHIEFS: The Snappers head to Peoria for the first of 3 consecutive visits in their season series with the Chiefs. Earlier this season at Pohlman Field, Beloit won their first series of the season over Peoria including their most lopsided win of the year on April 15. The Chiefs roster currently carries 5 of the Cardinals Top-30 prospects according to MLB. com. Two pitchers Jordan Hicks (#18) & Ronnie Williams (#25) are listed with 3 outfielders Dylan Carlson (#16), Nick Plummer (#23), & Bryce Denton
