Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Pablo Lopez struck out a career-high 10 batters in 5 2/3 innings in Game 1 of Friday's doubleheader, but the Mobile BayBears rallied for a 4-2, seven-inning win, followed by a 3-1, seven-inning win before 4,850 saw NAPA Family Fireworks at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Lopez (0-2) kept Mobile (21-20) scoreless through the first five innings. Jacksonville (17-25) took the lead in the bottom of the fourth inning against Mobile right-hander Jose Rodriguez (3-4). Designated hitter Cade Gotta doubled down the third-base line and went to third base on first baseman Eric Jagielo's groundout. Right fielder John Norwood walked, and third baseman Brian Schales chopped an RBI single over BayBears second baseman Riley Unroe, sending Norwood to third base. Two batters later, catcher Rodrigo Vigil added an RBI infield single for a 2-0 lead. Rodriguez completed five innings. In the top of the sixth inning, BayBears third baseman Taylor Ward hit a leadoff single. Designated hitter Jose Rojas reached on Norwood's error, and catcher Michael Barash hit an RBI single to left field. A sacrifice and game-tying groundout preceded left fielder Zach Gibbons' go-ahead single to center field. All three runs were unearned against Lopez, who allowed three walks and five hits but lowered his ERA to 0.28 (one earned run in 31 2/3 innings). Mobile first baseman Matt Thaiss hit a seventh-inning home run off right-hander Marcus Crescentini, before right-hander Ryan Clark completed two scoreless innings for his second save. In Game 2, Mobile took a first-inning lead with four straight two-out singles off Jacksonville right-hander Kolton Mahoney (2-3). Ward, Rojas, first baseman Zach Houchins and shortstop Connor Justus each singled, with the last scoring Ward. On the same play, Gotta threw from right field to retire Rojas at home plate. In the second inning, former Jacksonville catcher Francisco Arcia singled with one out and later scored on an errant pickoff throw by Mahoney, who allowed two runs – one earned – on six hits and one walk with one strikeout in five innings. Rojas and Houchins singled against right-hander Zech Lemond in the sixth inning, and Rojas later scored when Gibbons' RBI fielder's choice. BayBears left-hander Greg Mahle pitched four scoreless innings, left-hander Adrian Almeida (1-0) allowed a run on three walks in 1 1/3 innings, and right-hander Matt Custed escaped a bases-loaded jam in the sixth inning before a scoreless seventh inning for his second save.

NEWS AND NOTES

Dugger Makes Double-A Debut: Tonight's Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Robert Dugger is making his Double-A debut as he starts for Jacksonville against the Mobile BayBears. Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seven walks in 41 and a third innings of work. Dugger is a newcomer to the Marlins organization, as he was acquired by Miami as part of the Dee Gordon trade with the Seattle Mariners in December 2017. Dugger is listed by Baseball America as the Marlins No. 23 prospect entering 2018.

Jumbo Shrimp Announce Roster Moves: The Miami Marlins announced a pair of transactions that impact their Double-A affiliate Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp roster prior to tonight game. Right-handed relief pitcher Kyle Keller has been transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville. Keller pitched in 15 games in relief for the Hammerheads with four saves, going 1-1 with a 1.59 ERA. In 17 innings he had 22 strikeouts compared to just one walk. At the time of his promotion, Keller is tied for first in the Florida State League in appearances (15), second in games finished (13), third in the league among relievers in lowest walks per nine innings ratio at 0.53, and second in the league among relievers in fewest baserunners per nine innings ratio at 6.88. In a corresponding move, right-handed pitcher Chris Mazza has been released by the Marlins organization. Mazza pitched in two games for the Jumbo Shrimp, with no wins or losses and a 4.26 ERA in his six and a third innings of work. Mazza also pitched for Jacksonville in parts of the past two seasons.

BayBears are Back: Tonight's game starts the second of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the Mobile BayBears, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. Earlier this season the Jumbo Shrimp won three out of four games played in the first home series of the year from April 11-14. The game on Sunday April 15 was postponed due to rain, creating the need for a doubleheader on Friday May 18. This is the last trip for the BayBears to Jacksonville, and the two Jumbo Shrimp visits to Hank Aaron Stadium in Mobile will be in the second half from July 4-7 and July 28-August 1. Last year Jacksonville had a winning record against Mobile, going 14-7 overall. The clubs split the two series at Hank Aaron Stadium 5-5, while the Jumbo Shrimp were 9-2 against the BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville last season.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

TONIGHT – DOUBLE-A DEBUT: Tonight's Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Robert Dugger is making his Double-A debut as he starts for Jacksonville against the Mobile BayBears. Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seven walks in 41 and a third innings of work. Dugger is a newcomer to the Marlins organization, as he was acquired by Miami as part of the Dee Gordon trade with the Seattle Mariners in December 2017. Dugger is listed by Baseball America as the Marlins No. 23 prospect entering 2018.

2018 WITH JUPITER: Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads starting rotation. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seven walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, Dugger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

ACQUIRED BY THE MARLINS: Dugger was acquired by the Marlins from the Seattle Mariners along with right-handed pitcher and Jacksonville rotation mate Nick Neidert, infielder Chris Torres and future considerations in exchange for infielder/outfielder Dee Gordon on December 7, 2017. Dugger was originally selected by the Mariners in 18th round of the 2016 draft out of Texas Tech.

PROSPECT: While Dugger is not regarded as a Top 30 Marlins prospect according to MLB.com, he does appear in Baseball America's Top 30 Marlins prospect rankings entering 2018, checking in as Miami's No. 23 prospect.

2018 Highlights: In Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads starting rotation. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seven walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, Dugger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

2017 Highlights: Split the season between Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League and High-A Modesto in the California League. With the Clinton Lumberkings, Dugger was 4-1 with a 2.00 ERA in 22 appearances and nine starts. As a starter, went 3-0 with a 1.18 ERA in nine starts after starting the season in the bullpen. With Clinton, he was honored as a 2017 Midwest League Midseason All-Star. Finished the season with the Modesto Nuts, going 2-5 with a 3.94 ERA in nine starts.

2016 Highlights: After he was selected by the Mariners in the 18th round of the 2016 draft out of Texas Tech, Dugger spent time at three different levels of the Mariners system. He started with the AZL Mariners where he made four appearances in relief, with no wins or losses and a 1.04 ERA. In late July he was sent to Triple-A Tacoma, where he worked two games in relief, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA. He finished the season with the Everett AquaSox in the Short Season Class A Northwest League, where he was 2-1 with a 5.47 ERA in six starts.

College: Spent the 2016 season at Texas Tech, where he was 6-1 with a 2.67 ERA in 30 relief appearances with three saves. Struck out 54 batters in 60 and two-third innings of work. Dugger spent the 2015 and 2014 seasons at Cisco Junior College. In 2015, finished 3-2 overall with a 4.37 ERA ... struck out 55 hitters while issuing just 18 walks over 70.0 complete innings. In 2014 he was one of Cisco's top starting pitchers ... appeared in 12 games, finishing 5-5 overall with a 5.40 ERA ... led the team with 63.1 innings pitched ... tossed three complete games which ranked second on the team.

Personal: Helped lead Tomball High School to the Texas Class 4A state title as a senior ... played under head coach Doug Rush ... Tomball closed the 2013 season with an impressive 35-4 overall record ... marked the first state championship for any team sport in Tomball history ... team also finished the year ranked among the top 10 programs in the country ... was a first team All-District honoree as a senior ... first team All-State selection by the Texas Sports Writers Association ... also honored on the All-Houston area team and the All-State Tournament team ... recognized for work in the classroom as an academic All-State honoree ... member of the school's National Honors Society. Son of Ronnie and Anna Dugger ... has a younger brother, Cody ... mother is a teacher and University of Arizona graduate ... father works for Centerpoint Energy ... kinesiology major with a minor in nutrition ... hopes to one day become a physical therapist or nutritionist.
