TV: None Giants Continue Series At Inland Empire Tonight... The San Jose Giants play the second game of their season-opening four-game series against the Inland Empire 66ers this evening at San Manuel Stadium. Logan Webb (0-0, ---) is slated to make the start on the mound for San Jose tonight.

Yesterday's Opener... The Giants suffered a 3-2 loss to the 66ers last night to open the 2018 season. San Jose finished the contest 2-for-15 with runners in scoring position. The #3 through #6 hitters in the Giants lineup (De La Rosa, Quinn, Brusa, Fabian) were a combined 1-for-13 with eight strikeouts. Tyler Beede started on the mound and surrendered just one hit and one run over five innings. It was Beede's first appearance with San Jose since his 2015 All-Star season in the California League. Yesterday marked the second straight year that the Giants lost at Inland Empire on opening night (4-3, 16-inning loss in 2017).

San Francisco Affiliation... This year marks San Jose's 31st season as an affiliate of the San Francisco Giants - the longest current partnership in the California League. Since their inception in 1988, the San Jose Giants have won six league championships (1998, 2001, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2010), 11 North Division titles and qualified for the playoffs 22 times (in 30 seasons). San Jose has reached the playoffs in 12 out of the last 14 seasons.

Returning Players... 11 players on the opening day roster have prior experience with the San Jose Giants: C Jeff Arnold (2012-13, 2015 in San Jose), 1B Gio Brusa (2016-17), RHP Michael Cederoth (2017), LHP Carlos Diaz (2015-17), OF Johneshwy Fargas (2016-17), RHP Rodolfo Martinez (2016-17), LHP Conner Menez (2016-17), 2B Jalen Miller (2017), OF Heath Quinn (2016-17), RHP Dylan Rheault (2017) and C Matt Winn (2017).

Versus The South... The Giants open the regular season with a seven-game road trip against South Division opponents. Following the current series versus the 66ers, San Jose travels to Lancaster for a threegame set. The Giants will play 53 games against the South Division this year (87 games vs. North Division).

Top Prospects... MLB.com currently ranks three players on San Jose's opening day roster among the top 30 prospects in the San Francisco Giants organization: #6 Sandro Fabian (OF), #12 Heath Quinn (OF) and #19 Melvin Adon (RHP).

Lipso Nava... Lipso Nava has returned as manager of the San Jose Giants. Nava previously managed the Giants in 2016 following a three-year stint as the San Jose hitting coach from 2013-15. Nava directed the Giants to a 68-72 overall record and a Wild Card berth in the North Division two seasons ago (lost in Mini Series to Bakersfield). Nava served as the hitting coach for Double-A Richmond last year. He's in his 11th season in the Giants organization, including fourth year as a manager (Augusta 2011-12, SJ 2016, 2018).

2017 Review... The Giants finished the 2017 season with a 62-78 overall record (30-40 first half, 32-38 second half). It was the first time since 2003 that San Jose ended the year with the worst record in the league (58-82). The Giants went 29-41 at home last season and 33-37 on the road. San Jose was sixth in the league in batting average (.256), sixth in runs scored (4.5 per game) and sixth in ERA (4.52). Catcher Aramis Garcia, shortstop Ryan Howard and relief pitcher Dylan Rheault were named to the postseason California League All-Star team.
