### SNAPPER SNIPPETS

**EASTERN SWING:** Beloit continues their 12-game interdivision schedule for the second half at the Dow Diamond before returning home to face West Michigan & South Bend. The Snappers have taken 2 out of 3 in each road series at Eastern Division ballparks. They have outscored their Eastern opponents 80-64 overall & 57-36 in 9 road games.

**CLOSE GAMES:** 5 of Beloit's last 6 games have been decided by 3 runs or less for a total of 59 games with finals of 3 runs or fewer. The Snappers are 28-31 in those contests. Beloit also matches Kane County for the most one-run games in the Midwest League with 33 & an identical 18-15 record.

**HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL:** Beloit scored 23 runs over their first 10 games in July, but they have tallied up 21 runs in their last 3 ballgames. The Snappers are 29-7 this season when they score at least 5 runs in a game. Beloit is 10-7 in ballgames that both teams reach 5 runs.

**LEADOFF LOEHR:** Trace Loehr has had a successful transition to the leadoff spot since the promotion of Luis Barrera. Loehr began the road trip with back-to-back 4-hit games in Lansing where he missed the cycle by a home run in each game. He is now batting .330 from the leadoff spot with 5 of his 6 total triples & his only homer of the year. Trace had 7 triples last season with the Snappers to put him just 3 triples from matching the franchise career record of 16 by Brian Finley between 1982-84.

**CATCH ME IF YOU CAN:** Mike Martin's 5 stolen bases in the month of July are 3rd-most in the Midwest League behind Taylor Trammell of Dayton (7) & Fort Wayne's Fernando Tatis Jr. (6). Beloit has 13 stolen bases this month are 2nd among Western Division teams despite sitting last in that half of the league.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Beloit's defense has turned 94 double plays this season to lead the Midwest League & are on pace to snap the team record of 134 set in 2007. The Snappers 94 twin killers are the 2nd-most across Class-A (San Jose=100) & 12th across all of Minor League Baseball.

**THE NEW GUYS:** The newest of the 2017 Snappers, Jesus Lopez & Josh Vidales, are making an impact. They are a combined 9-for-17 with 5 runs in 2 games.

**NOW-LIN LATER:** Kyle Nowlin continues to rack up the RBIs in big moments for the Snappers. Over the team's last 5 wins, he has either tied the game or driven home the go-ahead run. He is batting .357 over his last 8 starts. Nowlin is 5-for-his-last-13 & collected 6 RBIs in his 4 games. He leads all Beloit batters with 11 multi-RBI games. He has also showed a great deal of plate discipline this year with 43 walks, 5th-most in the Midwest League.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** Xavier Altamirano takes the ball for his 5th start of the year. The right-hander will look to bounce back after his rockiest outing as a pro with a career-high 7 runs allowed against Kane County on July 9. Altamirano began the year in the Snappers bullpen where he had a scoreless streak of 27.1 IP over his last 8 relief outings. Altamirano did not pitch against the Loons in 2016 & has faced a Dodgers affiliate just once in his pro career (August 12, 2015 vs. AZL Dodgers).

**FACING THE LOONS:** Beloit swept Great Lakes last season including a May 1 doubleheader at Pohlman Field. Jesus Lopez went 4-for-10 with 2 doubles & 3 RBI as the only position player on the active roster today & during the 2016 series. The Loons currently have 7 of the Dodgers top-30 prospects on their roster. The Snappers are visiting Dow Diamond for the first time since 2015. Beloit has won 4 of 5 total series in Midland & are 9-5 all-time at Dow Diamond. Those include pitchers Jordan Sheffield (#8), Imani Abdullah (#14), Dustin May (#22), & A.J. Alexy (#28) along with batters Gavin Lux (#6), Oneil Cruz (#20), & 2017 Midwest League Home Run Derby champ Carlos Rincon (#23).
