**Last Game:** The Mobile BayBears hit three home runs and posted five runs in both the sixth and ninth innings in a 13-3 win that halted the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp's three-game winning streak before 10,254 saw the season's first Saturday Fireworks – a series that will continue through June 16 – at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Mobile (4-5) began the scoring in the first inning against Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Merandy Gonzalez (0-1). With two outs, BayBears third baseman Taylor Ward walked, and designated hitter Hutton Moyer hit his Southern League-leading fourth home run for a 2-0 Mobile lead. BayBears right-hander Jose Rodriguez held Jacksonville (4-5) scoreless until the bottom of the fourth inning. Jumbo Shrimp designated hitter Eric Jagielo grounded an infield single down the third-base line, and left fielder Austin Dean singled to left field. Both runners advanced on first baseman Colby Lusk's groundout to first base, before third baseman Brian Schaales hit a two-out, two-run double to right-center field for the only runs in Rodriguez's 4 2/3 innings. The Jumbo Shrimp took their only lead in the fifth inning against Mobile right-hander Jake Jewell (1-0). Center fielder Monte Harrison bounced a double over Ward at third base and scored when BayBears second baseman Connor Justus made a throwing error on right fielder John Norwood's infield single. Jewell did not allow a run for the rest of his 2 1/3 innings. In the pivotal sixth inning, Gonzalez allowed first baseman Matt Thaiss's single, Ward's two-run home run to left field, and Moyer's single before being removed for right-hander Esmerling De La Rosa. The BayBears drew three more walks, and center fielder Brennon Lund's two-run single capped the five-run frame. Left-hander Jose Quijada allowed a seventh-inning run, and right-hander Jorgan Cavanerio surrendered Thaiss's three-run home run in a five-run ninth inning.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**A Dean Streak:** Left fielder Austin Dean carries an eight game hitting streak into tonight's game against the BayBears. Dean is hitting .548 (17-for-31) in his streak with six runs batted in and three doubles. His hitting streak is the second longest streak in the Southern League, just behind Mobile's Zach Gibbons who has hit safely in the first nine games of the season. Dean leads the Southern League with his .548 average, 48 points better than Jackson's Juniel Querecuto and Mobile's Taylor Ward. Dean also has the most hits in the league (17), top on-base percentage (.588), and is third in the league in total bases (20). Dean especially has been solid in this series against Mobile, hitting .733 (11-for-15), with 3 RBI and he's had a multi-hit game in each game of the series and in six this season.

**We Just Want to Play Baseball:** Rain postponed Sunday's game at the Baseball Grounds between the Jumbo Shrimp and the BayBears (also robbed Max Duval a chance to make his Duval County debut on his birthday), then yesterday unplayable field conditions in Chattanooga postponed the Jumbo Shrimp and the Lookouts in the start of their five-game set. Yesterday's game will be made up as part of a doubleheader on Wednesday evening at 5:15 p.m.

**Brigham S.L. Pitcher of the Week:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-handed starting pitcher Jeff Brigham has been named the Southern League Pitcher of the Week for April 5-16, announced by the league office on Monday morning. Brigham in two starts to begin the season is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA with 18 strikeouts compared to two walks and six hits allowed in 10 scoreless innings to begin the season. Brigham leads the Southern League in ERA (0.00), strikeouts (18), second in WHIP (0.80),

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the Opening Day roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who are listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (2), Isan Diaz (8), RHP Nick Neidert (10), RHP Merandy Gonzalez (16), and RHP Pablo Lopez (24), who is currently on Jacksonville's disabled list. All five of these prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

**LAST START:** Poteet had a no decision (was one out shy of qualifying for a win) in his start on Wednesday April 11 at the Baseball Grounds against the Mobile BayBears. In front of an Opening Night crowd of 6,960 fans, Poteet worked four and two-third innings while allowing two runs (both earned) on three hits with four walks and seven strikeouts as Jacksonville won 9-5.

**GENERALS LOSS:** Poteet suffered a loss in his Double-A debut on Thursday April 5 against the Jackson Generals at The Ballpark at Jackson. As Jacksonville's Opening Night starter, Poteet worked five and a third innings where he allowed five runs (all earned) on eight hits with two walks and six strikeouts, as well as two home runs allowed. Poteet left the game in the bottom of the fifth with the Jumbo Shrimp trailing 5-1, and Jacksonville would lose the game 7-3.

**2017 WITH JUPITER:** Poteet had success in 2017 with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. With Jupiter Poteet was a 2017 League Midseason All-Star and Marlins Organizational All-Star. Poteet with the Hammerheads was 2-3 with a 2.53 ERA in seven starts in the first half of the season, eventually going 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in his 14 starts. Poteet was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. In home games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, Poteet was 2-4 with a 3.30 ERA in eight appearances and six starts, while on the road Poteet was 1-3 with a 5.20 ERA in his eight starts away from Jupiter.

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA.

**2017 Highlights:** Poteet had success in 2017 with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. With Jupiter Poteet was a 2017 League Midseason All-Star and Marlins Organizational All-Star. Poteet with the Hammerheads was 2-3 with a 2.53 ERA in seven starts in the first half of the season, eventually going 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in his 14 starts. Poteet was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. In home games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, Poteet was 2-4 with a 3.30 ERA in eight appearances and six starts, while on the road Poteet was 1-3 with a 5.20 ERA in his eight starts away from Jupiter.

**2016 Highlights:** Poteet spent all of 2016 with the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. With Greensboro he was 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in 16 appearances and 14 starts. He was 3-5 with a 2.43 ERA in 13 starts in the first half of the year, while going 1-4 with a 3.48 ERA in 11 starts in the second half of the season.

**2015 Highlights:** After he was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the draft out of UCLA, Poteet spent time at rookie level Batavia in the New York-Penn League. With the Muckdogs he was 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

**College:** Poteet was part of a strong pitching staff at UCLA that included Yankees first rounder James Kaprielian and closer David Berg, a second round pick by the Cubs in 2015. In 2015 Poteet was 7-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 27 appearances and 13 starts as he transitioned to being a mid-week starter for the Bruins. Honorable Mention Pac-12 All-Academic selection in 2015. Sunday starter in 2014, going 3-5 with a 4.46 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts. In 2013 as a freshman was a midweek starter, going 4-6 with a 4.84 ERA in 29 appearances and 11 starts. In summer of 2014 pitched in the Cape Cod League for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox, going 4-0 with a 3.09 ERA in seven starts. In summer of 2013 pitched in the West Coast League for the Walla Walla Sweets, going 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA with 27 strikeouts in 38 innings pitched.

**Personal:** Three-year varsity baseball letterwinner at Christian High School (El Cajon, Calif.) under head coach Michael Mitchell...selected in the 27th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. Batted .509 with 55 hits, 13 doubles, 20 stolen bases, 23 RBI and 45 runs as a junior in 2011, pitching 17.2 innings that season...broke school records with 55 hits and a .509 batting average in 2011...did not play for Christian in 2012, instead competing for club team ABD Bulldogs ... went 10-1 with a 2.10 ERA and 112 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched for the Bulldogs in 2012.
