**Road Trip Continues In Lake Elsinore...** The San Jose Giants continue their Southern California road trip with the opener of a three-game series against the Lake Elsinore Storm this evening at The Diamond. The Giants dropped two out of three games in Rancho Cucamonga to begin the trip. The Quakes posted victories of 15-6 on Wednesday and 7-6 on Thursday to open the series before San Jose avoided the sweep with a 4-2 win yesterday. Joey Marciano (0-1, 13.50 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants tonight.

**Game #100...** This evening marks San Jose's 100th game of the season. The Giants are 45-54 overall. San Jose is looking to avoid a sub-.500 season for the third consecutive year. The San Jose Giants have never had three straight losing seasons in their team history (1988-2018). The Giants were a league-worst 62-78 last year following a 68-72 record in 2016 (did reach playoffs as a Wild Card team). San Jose's record after 100 games the last two seasons: 42-58 in 2017, 52-48 in 2016.

**The Long Ball...** San Jose leads all North Division clubs and ranks third in the California League with 84 home runs this season. The Giants have hit 33 home runs in 29 second half games. San Jose's 24 homers in July are second in the California League (Rancho Cucamonga 27). Conversely, the Giants have allowed 27 home runs this month – tops in the league.

**Versus The South...** The current road trip marked the beginning of a stretch for the Giants playing 24 out of 30 games against South Division opponents (July 18-August 19). San Jose is 12-20 versus the South this season. The Giants are 2-4 against Lake Elsinore, including an 0-3 record at The Diamond.

**Inside The Record...** The Giants are 11-18 in the second half: 2-10 versus South Division-leading Rancho Cucamonga and 9-8 against all other opponents. Last night's victory snapped a 10-game losing streak to the Quakes. Since June 1, San Jose is only 16-29 – tied with Modesto for the worst record in the league during that stretch.

**League Leaderboard...** Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is second in the league in hits (105), fourth in doubles (26), tied for sixth in runs scored (54), seventh in RBI's (53) and tenth in slugging (.457). Gio Brusa is tied for fifth in the league in home runs (14), tied for eighth in RBI's (51) and sixth in slugging (.477). Wander Franco is third in doubles (27) and fourth in hits (103) while Johneshwy Fargas is second in stolen bases (30).

**On The Road...** The Giants are 22-29 (.431) on the road this season, the second-lowest winning percentage in the California League, ahead of only Modesto (20-31, .392). San Jose is 9-18 in their last 27 road games dating back to May 24 after starting the year 13-11 away from home. The Giants last won a road series June 8-10 at Modesto. San Jose's team ERA on the road this season is 4.83 compared to 3.62 at home.

**Pitching Struggles...** The Giants own a league-worst 6.19 team ERA in July (next-closest: Inland Empire 4.80). San Jose starting pitchers have completed five innings only seven times in 19 games this month and six innings just once. The Giants' month-by-month ERA's: April 3.34, May 3.60, June 4.37, July 6.19. San Jose pitchers have issued 406 walks this season to lead the league (4.1 per game). The Giants have also blown a league-high 18 saves.

**Heath Quinn...** Heath Quinn enters tonight's contest with a .321 batting average in 58 games played this season. Quinn, who was on the DL from May 9-June 9, would rank third in the California League in batting average if he had enough plate appearances to qualify. Quinn's AVG is 93 points higher than his final mark of .228 with San Jose last year (75 games).

\* Most recent start came on July 15 against Visalia ... Pitched 3 2/3 innings with five runs (all earned) allowed ... Gave up four hits, including three home runs ... Surrendered one run in the first, one run in the second, two runs in the third and one run in the fourth ... Received a no-decision ... Giants eventually won 6-5.

\* Was tagged for a career-high seven runs (all earned) over 4 1/3 innings on July 10 at Stockton in his California League debut ... Gave up eight hits, including three home runs ... Began his start with three scoreless innings before allowing four runs in the fourth and three runs in the fifth ... Suffered the loss.

\* Had allowed only four home runs in 109 career innings prior to joining San Jose (6 HR in 8 innings with SJ Giants).

\* Earned midseason South Atlantic League honors with Augusta this year ... Was 4-3 with a 2.58 ERA in 15 games (14 starts) ... Ranked tenth in the league in ERA at the time of his promotion ... Struck out 71 and walked 22 over 80 1/3 innings ... Allowed two runs or fewer in 10 out of his 14 starts ... Walked more than two batters in a start only twice ... Surrendered only three home runs.

\* Struck out a career-high 11 batters over six innings on April 20 at Rome (two runs allowed).

\* Pitched for the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2017 ... Was named to the postseason Arizona Rookie League All-Star team ... Was 4-1 with a 1.57 ERA in 15 games (three starts) ... Struck out 26 and walked 12 over 28 2/3 innings.

\* Attended John A. Logan Community College and Southern Illinois University.

- \* Infielder is in his fifth professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2013 at age 16.
